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as humanity enters the anthropocene epoch the oceans are more at risk than ever before as a result of the increased exploitation of its resources the indian ocean is the third largest ocean in the world comprising 20 of the water on the earth s surface the sea lanes in the indian ocean are among the busiest in the world with more than 80 percent of global seaborne trade in oil transiting through the indian ocean and its vital chokepoints and an estimated 40 of the world s offshore oil production comes from the indian ocean the importance of this region cannot be underestimated and there is no doubt that there are many opportunities

for economic growth and job creation presented by the waters washing the shores of the indian ocean rim in order to ensure a desirable future for humanity it is necessary to make use of the ocean s resources in a sustainable and responsible manner climate change is affecting the indian ocean negatively placing a strain on the ability to ensure food security and damaging the economies of small island states that depend on fisheries and aquaculture for their livelihoods increasing ocean temperatures and ocean acidification are taking a toll on ecosystems this book is the first of its kind providing fresh insights into the various aspects and impacts of the blue economy in the indian ocean region from shifting paradigms to an accounting framework gender dynamics the law of the sea and renewable energy this handbook aims at increasing awareness of the blue economy in the indian ocean region and to provide evidence to policy makers in the region to make informed decisions the contributions are from a mixture of disciplines by scholars and experts from seven countries

this volume defines and analyzes the blue economy a system that encompasses all the economic activities which are happening in and around the ocean within a sustainable development framework with focus on countries in asia this work is timely as blue economy activities account for a significant share of gdp s in the island and coastal economies in the asia region sustaining the livelihoods of one of the largest sections of the world s population this book therefore assesses how the blue economy contributes to these livelihoods from economic and ecological perspectives and analyzes the various types of ecosystem services provided and how these services are regulated and maintained while most studies of the blue economy focus only on the economic aspects this book provides ample statistical data to demonstrate why ecosystem services should additionally be considered for the estimation and valuation of the blue economy the book is primarily meant for researchers students and teachers in the fields of environmental and ocean economics sustainable development and ecosystem services and will be of further interest to policymakers and government officials working in matters related to the blue economy and sustainability policy

a global blue economy is an economic arena that depends on the benefits and values realized from the coastal and marine environments this book explains the sustainable blue economy as a marine based economy that provides social and economic benefits for current and future generations it restores protects and maintains the diversity productivity and resilience of marine ecosystems and is based on clean technologies renewable energy and circular material flows

the ocean is a major source of income for many coastal nations particularly in the developing world economic benefits from the ocean in the long term depend on its wise science and technology based management the intersection of science technology and economy are most obvious in nations coastal zones this book highlights the need for the application of ocean science and technology for best economic outcomes it gives examples of ocean resources and the threats to them from climate change and other human interventions as well as provides information on the available ocean research and observation tools to monitor their impact as well as on the related internationally available opportunities for capacity development

this book presents state of the art perspectives on the blue economy it applies important geographical and sustainability transitions perspectives and underscores how blue economy dynamics are situated in regional contexts and shaped by the people

who live there the book highlights the blue economy concept as a potential driver of regionally sensitive ecologically embedded and community focused sustainability the scope for blue economy to form a core cog in our low carbon future is obvious from the potential for renewable energy production and coastal resilience building to possibilities for sustainable food production and the delivery of economic opportunities for peripheral communities however fundamental questions remain on how to meaningfully deliver these promises such as how to avoid embedding a model of damaging extractivism as per the terrestrial economy and how to deliver on the key social sustainability principles of human well being equity and justice when planning and developing blue economies as the un decade of ocean science for sustainable development opens this book provides a timely reminder of the richness diversity and potential of coastal and marine spaces it advances geographical and transdisciplinary understandings of the blue economy and sets a baseline for continued scholarly engagement with the blue economy from a variety of perspectives this timely contribution will be of interest to policy makers academics industry leaders decision makers and stakeholders working in or connected to the blue economy sphere and working in the fields of economic geography regional development public policy and planning environmental studies and coastal zone management

the blue economy comprising coastal and marine resources offers vast benefits for sub saharan africa of the 53 countries and territories in the region 32 are coastal states there are 13 million sq km of maritime zones more than 90 of the region s exports and imports come by sea and the african union hails the blue economy as the new frontier of african renaissance despite their importance the region s coastal and marine resources have been neither fully appreciated nor fully utilized they are only now being recognized as being key to africa s potential prosperity as the region grows it has in general not taken adequate safeguards to protect these valuable resources that is partly because some of the problems pollution for example are regional and know no borders all too often short term gains are made at the expense of the long term overfishing for example this book provides for the first time a study of the constraints and opportunities the blue economy offers for sub saharan africa it includes an introduction and overview sectoral analyses including tourism fisheries mineral resources culture shipping and maritime safety country case studies and analyses of regional and international efforts towards better coastal zone and marine management

the blue economy is a major driver of urban and regional development creating millions of local jobs in water dependent sectors such as fisheries tourism and shipping however it can also contribute to carbon emissions and ecosystem degradation while its reliance on freshwater coastal and marine ecosystems exposes it to the impacts of climate change as the places where the blue economy takes place creates value and provides jobs cities and regions play a key role in unlocking the potential of a resilient blue economy that preserves the ecosystems that sustain it building on a global survey of 80 cities regions and basins this report highlights the costs and benefits of the blue economy at subnational level shedding light on the link between the blue economy and water security this analysis provides an overview of the multi level governance of the blue economy and related gaps it calls on cities and regions to develop resilient inclusive sustainable and circular risk proof blue economies by establishing the right governance conditions related to policy making policy coherence and policy implementation the report concludes with a risk assessment framework that offers a self evaluation tool for subnational governments

in the last decade the concept of a blue economy has ignited a deep theoretical debate ranging from the integration of the triple bottom line of sustainability to the optimization of profit from ocean exploitation the meaning of the term blue economy differs considerably between epistemic communities and even more so among national and regional policies there is a general sense of the opportunity to realise enhanced social and economic benefits from the sustainable utilisation of their ocean and coastal resources under the umbrella framework of blue economy blue economy is gaining traction already as a significant component of national policies even in spite of a clear conceptualization of the term many countries are now preparing national policies towards realising their blue economy ambitions utilizing the concept as they see fit likewise multilateral and regional organisations are developing guidelines and providing investment in new research technologies and financing tools that promote blue economy critical challenges abound in particular in less privileged countries these include the gap in research capabilities governments prioritizing social wellbeing and economic profit in contrast to environmental protection the identification of new and emerging areas of ocean economic activity that are both socially and ecologically sustainable and holds viable business models that can attract private investment

blue economy emerged as a policy trend over the last decade and is an increasingly influential concept on global regional and national policy agendas while the blue economy concept inspires interdisciplinary and intersectoral policies and programmes no commonly accepted definition of the blue economy including its spatial or thematic scope exists this report reviews and analyses how stakeholders apply the blue economy strategically and operationally in their policy and programming with particular attention to the role of aquatic food systems which is established as a vital blue economy sector among all stakeholders regardless of their category or geographic scope aquatic food systems stakeholders are thus navigating a blue economy landscape irrespective of whether they are pursuing their own blue economy ambitions ultimately the report provides perspectives on the potential role of fao amid identified blue economy trends focusing on the role of its blue transformation roadmap to advance and strengthen the role of aquatic food systems in a blue economy context and its potential as a pathway for the transformation of aquatic food systems

the blue economy is a widely used concept in policy circles however people across a wide spectrum have a peripheral understanding of the phenomenon at the moment there are several conflicting understandings of the blue economy but no universally accepted definition and veritable measures considering the existential importance of the blue economy for the protection of marine environments and sustainability of businesses there is an urgent need for rigorous conceptual policy focused theoretical and empirical studies on the subject from multidisciplinary perspectives implications for entrepreneurship and enterprise development in the blue economy enriches existing definitions of a blue economy with inputs from a multidisciplinary lens and provides veritable measures for evaluating blue economy progression and compliance covering topics such as economics natural resource development social equity and sustainability this reference work is ideal for policymakers entrepreneurs managers oceanographers marine biologists scholars industry professionals government officials academicians researchers practitioners instructors and students
