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excellent background research on site investigations of mysteries ranging from crop circles and lake monsters to spiritualist mediums and stigmata booklist as a former private investigator and forensic writer joe nickell has spent much of his career identifying forged documents working undercover to infiltrate theft rings and investigating questioned deaths now he turns his considerable investigative skill toward the paranormal researching the most well known and mysterious phenomena all over the world spontaneous human combustion ufo visitations auras electronic poltergeists and many many more with an eye toward solving these mysteries rather than promoting or dismissing them real life x files investigating the paranormal examines the cases of over forty paranormal mysteries using a hands on approach nickell visits the scene of the so called unexplainable activity whenever possible and attempts to physically duplicate the miraculous whether he s inflicting stigmata on himself or recreating the liquefying blood of saint januarius nickell does whatever necessary to eliminate the probable before considering the supernatural what is left is that much more fascinating nickell reports on familiar legends from american history such as the supernatural events surrounding abraham lincoln s death and the supposed crash landing of an alien spacecraft near roswell new mexico he closely examines claims of the miraculous from rose petals bearing the likeness of jesus to photographs of a golden door to heaven controversial mysteries such as clairvoyance and spirit painting haunted places and freaks of nature are just a few of the many topics covered suspenseful engrossing funny and grounded in scientific methodology real life x files provides real explanations for the paranormal activities that have intrigued human beings for centuries

ancient curses explores the historical prevalence of curses across cultures examining cursed objects places and figures it delves into historical accounts folklore and mythology to understand how societies have perceived and feared malevolent forces throughout time the book argues that beliefs in curses though often seen as superstition reflect a society s values fears and worldview for example the hope diamond s history is intertwined with tales of misfortune illustrating the perceived power of cursed objects the book progresses by categorizing curses starting with cursed objects and moving to cursed places like battlefields associated with tragic events and then examining cursed figures such as the kennedys it connects these beliefs to fields like folklore studies and anthropology providing a comprehensive view of how curses have shaped cultural history and belief the approach contextualizes these beliefs within broader historical narratives

recent theology has seen a renewed vigour in debates about the nature and character of god juan cruz turns to one of the prophetic books in the hebrew bible old testament micah to consider the metaphors it uses to portray the god of israel and what they reveal about the deity the book of micah contains two dominant types of metaphor for yahweh namely the legal metaphors in 1 2 16 and 6 1 16 and the pastoral metaphors in 2 12 13 4 6 7 5 1 4a and 7 14 20 the former type of metaphors presents yahweh in a courtroom setting where he accuses his people of their sins brings a lawsuit against them and pronounces their judgement the pastoral metaphors on the other hand describe yahweh as the shepherd of his people primarily concerned with the restoration and well being of israel the two sets of metaphors therefore respectively present yahweh in a positive and a negative light drawing on insights from philosophy and literary studies and making particular use of the theories of benjamin harshav juan cruz explores the divine metaphors by analysing the arguments they make within their respective literary units and in the context of the whole book as well as the significant tensions that develop between the metaphors the volume provides helpful tools to analyse metaphors for god which may be also used for analysis of non divine metaphors and should contribute to our theological understanding of god in the hebrew bible most especially in the book of micah a book whose title bears the meaning who is like yahweh
