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the sixteenth century hebrew book is a bibliographic work describing books printed with hebrew letters in that century covering the gamut of hebrew literature encompassing liturgical works bibles commentaries talmud mishnah halakhic codes kabbalistic works fables and belles lettres each of the 455 entries has a descriptive text page comprised of background on the author a description of the book s contents and physical makeup and is accompanied by a reproduction of the title or a sample page there is an extensive

introduction with an overview of hebrew printing and a discussion of aspects of the hebrew book in the sixteenth century as well as detailed back matter it is a necessary work for bibliographers historians and students of jewish literature the print edition is available as a set of two volumes 9789004129764

who should count as jewish in america what should be the relationship of american jews to israel can the american jewish community collectively sustain and pass on to the next generation a sufficient sense of jewish identity the situation of american jews today is deeply paradoxical jews have achieved unprecedented integration influence and esteem in virtually every facet of american life but this extraordinarily diverse community now also faces four critical and often divisive challenges rampant intermarriage weak religious observance diminished cohesion in the face of waning anti semitism and deeply conflicting views about israel can the american jewish community collectively sustain and pass on to the next generation a sufficient sense of jewish identity in light of these challenges who should count as jewish in america what should be the relationship of american jews to israel in this thoughtful and perceptive book robert h mnookin argues that the answers of the past no longer serve american jews today the book boldly promotes a radically inclusive american jewish community one where being jewish can depend on personal choice and public self identification not simply birth or formal religious conversion instead of preventing intermarriage or ostracizing those critical of israel he envisions a community that embraces diversity and debate and in so doing preserves and strengthens the jewish identity into the next generation and beyond

asks for more than piety and moral behavior jews must also endeavor to make the world a better place in a remarkably short time this seemingly benign and wholesome notion has permeated jewish teaching preaching scholarship and political engagement there is no corner of modern jewish life that has not been touched by it this idea has led to overwhelming jewish participation in the social justice movement as such actions are believed to be biblically mandated there s only one problem the bible says no such thing in this lively theological polemic neumann shows how tikkun olam an invention of the jewish left has diluted millennia of jewish practice and belief into a vague feel good religion of social justice neumann uses religious and political history to debunk this pernicious idea and shows how the bible was twisted by jewish liberals to support a radical left wing agenda in to heal the world neumann explains how the jewish renewal movement aligned itself with the new left of the 1960s and redirected the perspective of the jewish community toward liberalism and social justice he exposes the key figures responsible for this effort shows that it lacks any real biblical basis and outlines the debilitating effect it has had on judaism itself
