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in the last half of the twentieth century a once respectable and religious Britain became a seriously violent and dishonest society one in which person and property were at risk family breakdown was ubiquitous and drug and alcohol abuse was rising the strange death of moral Britain demonstrates in detail the roots of Britain's decline it also shows how a society strongly Protestant in both morality and identity became one of the most secular societies in the world the culture wars about abortion capital punishment and homosexuality which have convulsed the United States have little meaning in Britain where there is neither a moral majority nor any indigenous emphasis on rights in the period when Britain had a strong national and religious identity defense of this identity led to legal persecution of male homosexuals as Britain's identity crumbled homosexuality ceased to be an important issue for most people similarly all the pressing questions on abortion capital punishment and homosexuality were settled permanently on a purely utilitarian basis in Britain where all sources of moral argument are weak the ending of the death penalty marked the decline of the influence of the official hierarchies of church and state the Church of England the armed forces and their representative the Conservative Party the strange death of moral Britain is a study of moral change secularization loss of identity and the growth of deviant behavior in Britain in the twentieth century based on detailed scholarship it is tightly argued and clearly written with a minimum of jargon it will be of interest to scholars in religious studies and British social history and to a general reading public concerned with timely moral controversies Christie Davies was for eighteen years a professor at the University of Reading England and has been a visiting lecturer in the United States and India he is the author of several books including *The Mirth of Nations* available from Transaction and his articles have appeared in leading academic journals in sociology criminology social history and religious studies among others

awesome inside track from the diaries of gaston b means and his the department of justice investigations means asserts that harding was poisoned mrs harding employed gaston means as a private detective in 1921 teapot dome was breaking the scandal took its toll and by the spring of 1923 harding was visibly distraught at what he regarded as the betrayal of his friends who were taking advantage of his kindness and lax administration he sought escape from washington in mid june by taking a trip to alaska with his wife and a large entourage on his way home at the end of july the president complained of abdominal pain but he seemed to rally as he rested at a san francisco hotel on the evening of august 2 however as his wife read to him from a magazine harding suddenly died from either a heart attack or stroke this book is full of cool insider and conspiracy stuff for lack of a better word the appendix lists a number of deaths suicides investigation notes a request by mrs harding that no death mask be made a few details on the death of general sawyer died in the same mysterious manner as harding who may or may not have been in harding s death room etc the teapot dome scandal also called the oil reserves or elk hills scandal in american history was a scandal of the early 1920s surrounding the secret leasing of federal oil reserves by the secretary of the interior albert b fall after president warren g harding transferred supervision of the naval oil reserve lands from the navy to the department of the interior in 1921 fall secretly granted to harry f sinclair of the mammoth oil company exclusive rights to the teapot dome wyoming reserves april 7 1922 he granted similar rights to edward l doherty of pan american petroleum company for the elk hills and buena vista hills reserves in california 1921 22 in return for the leases fall received large cash gifts and no interest loans when the affair became known congress directed president harding to cancel the leases the supreme court declared the leases fraudulent and ruled illegal harding s transfer of authority to fall although the president himself was not implicated in the transactions that had followed the transfer the revelations of his associates misconduct took a severe toll on his health disillusioned and exhausted

he died before the full extent of the wrongdoing had been determined in 1920 harding won the presidency by the greatest popular vote margin to that time he died during his third year in office and was succeeded by vice president calvin coolidge his brief administration accomplished little of lasting value however and soon after his death a series of scandals doomed the harding presidency to be judged among the worst in american history

it s 1898 kismet brings about a chance reunion at a london club between dr watson and colonel maiwand mike fenlon former military comrades from their northwest frontier days and the desperate battle of maiwand a week later an urgent cable seeking sherlock holmes s help arrives from the bailiwick of guernsey a british crown dependency 30 miles off the coast of normandy a retired high ranking british indian army officer who commanded the troops at maiwand has dropped dead colonel fenlon is in a holding cell awaiting trial for his murder what role in the brigadier general s death was played by a phial of patent medicine developed in india to treat cholera why are colonel fenlon s forefinger and thumbprint on the neck of the phial when he swears he has never seen it before above all why is fenlon refusing to enter a plea or even to tell his defence counsel what took place the evening the brigadier general dropped dead

available for the first time in paperback the strange deaths of president harding challenges readers to reexamine warren g harding s rightful place in american history for nearly half a century the twenty ninth president of the united states has consistently finished last in polls ranking the presidents after harding s untimely death in 1923 a variety of attacks and unsubstantiated claims left the public with a tainted impression of him in this meticulously researched scrutiny of the mystery surrounding harding s death robert h ferrell distinguished presidential historian

examines the claims against this unpopular president and uses new material to counter those accusations at the time of harding s death there was talk of his similarity personally if not politically to abraham lincoln secretary of state charles evans hughes described harding as one of nature s noblemen truehearted and generous but soon after harding s death his reputation began to spiral downward rumors circulated of the president s death by poison either by his own hand or by that of his wife allegations of an illegitimate daughter were made and question were raised concerning the extent of harding s knowledge of the teapot dome scandal and of irregularities in the veterans bureau as well as his tolerance of a corrupt attorney general who was an ohio political fixer journalists and historians of the time added to his tarnished reputation by using sources that were easily available but not factually accurate in the strange deaths of president harding ferrell lays out the facts behind these allegations for the reader to ponder making the most of the recently opened papers of assistant white house physician dr joel t boone ferrell shows that for years harding suffered from high blood pressure was under a great deal of stress and overexerted himself it was a heart attack that caused his death not poison there was no proof of an illegitimate child and harding did not know much about the scandals intensifying in the white house at the time of his death in fact these events were not as scandalous as they have since been made to seem in this meticulously researched and eminently readable scrutiny of the mystery surrounding harding s death as well as the deathblows dealt his reputation by journalists ferrell asks for a reexamination of harding s place in american history
