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explores how young people from communities targeted in the war on terror engage with the political even while they are under constant scrutiny and surveillance since the attacks of 9 11 the banner of national security has led to intense monitoring of the politics of muslim and arab americans young people from these communities have come of age in a time when the question of political engagement is both urgent and fraught in the 9 11 generation sunaina marr maira uses extensive ethnography to understand the meaning of political subjecthood and mobilization for arab south asian and afghan american youth maira explores how young people from communities targeted in the war on terror engage with the political forging coalitions based on new racial and ethnic categories even while they are under constant scrutiny and surveillance and organizing around notions of civil rights and human rights the 9 11 generation explores the possibilities and pitfalls of rights based organizing at a moment when the vocabulary of rights and democracy has been used to justify imperial interventions such as the u s wars in iraq and afghanistan maira further reconsiders political solidarity in cross racial and interfaith alliances at a time when u s nationalism is understood as not just multicultural but also post racial throughout she weaves stories of post 9 11 youth activism through key debates about neoliberal democracy the radicalization of muslim youth gender and humanitarianism

any study of africa s multiparty elections reveals inherent institutional and systemic difficulties that raise questions about the electoral outcomes in the emerging democracies an assessment of electoral processes in africa poses methodological conceptual and theoretical challenges to scholars and practitioners the chapters of this volume address these issues through an assessment of the electoral processes and an examination of democratisation trends in africa with special focus on case studies the chapters on algeria cameroon ghana malawi mozambique and south africa analyse these complexities holistically they examine the potency and independence of electoral institutions adherence to electoral laws by those charged with the statutory powers as well as the participants in the elections the role of the media election monitors and observers civil society and political parties the authors also assess whether or not elections were conducted in a free and fair environment conducive for multiparty electoral

the idea for this book is derived from the scantiness of academic references on the european union s policies towards the black sea relative to this region s officially stated significance for the eu even though the eu plays a vital role in black sea political agendas the eu s cooperation with the region is not extensively covered by academic discussions and literature this is mostly due to the fact that the eu s focus on foreign affairs is mainly associated with the balkans as part the current and potential expansion and the middle east as a direct consequence of the upheaval of the arab spring the black sea region is crucially important for the eu because of the opportunities and challenges that the region presents both politically and socio economically contributions to this book mostly focus on specific issues of eu black sea cooperation from conflict to the environment to democracy and how these particular relationships are perceived within the region as well as through the lenses of stakeholders such as russia turkey and the usa overall the collection focuses on projecting a more efficient role and a holistic strategy for the eu in its approach towards the black sea region testifying to the need for a strong eu presence for this reason the black sea area remains the neighbourhood too close to yet still far from the european union this book was originally published as a special issue of the journal of balkan and near eastern studies

two sections the first section contains the biographical sketch of prof p chenna reddy his achievements and contribution to archaeology history and society

ten years after the 9 11 attacks this book reassesses the effectiveness of the war on terror considers how al qaeda and other jihadist movements are faring explores the impact of wider developments in the islamic world such as the arab spring and discusses whether all this suggests that a new approach to containing international especially jihadist terrorism is needed among the book s many richly argued conclusions are that the war on terror and the invasions of afghanistan and iraq have brutalised the united states that the jihadist threat is not one but rather a wide range of separate unconnected struggles and that al qaeda s ideology contains the seeds of its own destruction in that although many muslims are content to see the united states worsted they do not approve of al qaeda s violence and are not taken in by the jihadists empty promises of utopia

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
