western culture after the revolutionary orgy of the 1960s

originally published between 1968 and 2009 this collection of 25 pieces includes six interviews translated into english for the first time and a new transcription of a q a session with baudrillard following a lecture he gave in london in 1994 the guiding theme of the collection is baudrillard s engagement with culture the implications of the implosion of western culture are dissected and documented in the rich range of material included here

jean baudrillard is characterized as the last prophet of europe not just because he was a prominent thinker french philosopher and author of more than 50 works and essays that examine modern consumer society in depth events and phenomena described by baudrillard in his works 20 30 years ago are taking place today by means of his writings he described his view of the world and explained why people and society are the way they are he encrypted in his works a system that allows for making accurate prognosis there was no book until this that could have demonstrated the integral system of baudrillard s philosophy baudrillard did not share it with anybody and did not describe it explicitly as a whole figuratively speaking he deconstructed his system into bricks his writings then built a building out of them numbered each brick and dismantled the building and burned the schemes in the book baudrillard maestro the last prophet of europe oleg maltsev thoroughly analyzes each brick and constructs baudrillard s system presenting to readers for the first time a complete model the tools used by baudrillard and his philosophy throughout the 16 chapters of this book the author looks into all kinds of subjects raised by baudrillard with practical examples among which the masses the kingdom of the blind the silent majority perfect crime european mysticism the symbolic system and many other phenomena are examined from the viewpoint of the scholar the author also shares his research results based on the philosophy and sociology of baudrillard dr maltsev then examines jean baudrillard s works some of which had been translated into russian for the first time his photographic pieces and interviews people who personally knew baudrillard his critics and fellow researchers this work is a practical book for modern people who want to have an objective view of the current state of affairs and take responsibility for their present and future it provides an idea for the use of the philosophy sociology and radical anthropology of baudrillard as the foundation of personal achievement efficiency and safety in such unstable and uncertain conditions of a constantly changing environment

this first full length study of the works of best selling victorian novelist ouida pen name for marie louise rame examines the evolution of social political and gender issues in ouida s fiction from her high society romances of the 1860s to her satirical exposes of contemporary society in the 1880s and 1890s this study places ouida in the context of nineteenth century debates over gender by exploring the contradictions between the vehement critiques of marriage in her fiction and the equally vehement anti feminist sentiments of her journalism examining ouida s revision of gender stereotypes such as the domestic angel the adventuress and the dandy schroeder and holt establish ouida as a significant predecessor of the 1890s new woman book jacket

german popular cinema and the rialto krimi phenomenon dark eyes of london examines the kriminalfilme or krimis based on the novels of english author edgar wallace released by rialto film between 1959 and 1972 as part of the post world war ii era of german popular cinema that enjoyed extraordinary popularity with the german public nicholas g schlegel analyzes how this group of west german thrillers not only nurtured a convalescing film industry but also provided unequaled national entertainment while canonizing rialto s krimi productions in terms of their historical genesis aesthetic characteristics and social reception schlegel surveys the krimi s enduring legacy calculable global influence inevitable decline and eventual migration to television in the 1970s where it thrived but ultimately took on a more somber tone scholars of film television history and german culture will find this book particularly useful

how do digital media technologies affect society and our lives through the cultural theory hypotheses of hyper modernism hyperreality and posthumanism alan n shapiro investigates the social impact of virtual augmented reality ai social media platforms robots and the brain computer interface his examination of concepts of jean baudrillard and katherine hayles as well as films such as blade runner 2049 ghost in the shell ex machina and the tv series black mirror suggests that the boundary between science fiction narratives and the real world has become indistinct science fictional thinking should be advanced as a principal mode of knowledge for grasping the world and digitalization

hizbullah is not only a leading political actor in lebanon and a dynamic force in the middle east but it is also distinguished by a sophisticated communication strategy from relatively humble beginnings in the 1980s hizbullah's political clout and

its public perception have followed an upward trajectory thanks to a political programme that blends military social economic and religious elements and adapts to changes in its environment its communication strategy is similarly adaptive supporting the group's political objectives hizbullah's target audience has expanded to a regional and global viewership its projected identity too shifted from an islamist resistance party opposed to israel's presence in lebanon to a key player within the lebanese state at the same time hizbullah's image has retained fixed features including its image as an ally of iran its role as a resistance group to israel and its original base as a religious party representative of the lebanese shiites the authors of this book address how hizbullah uses image language and its charismatic leader hassan nasrallah to legitimise its political aims and ideology and appeal to different target groups

the trash phenomenon looks at how writers of the late twentieth century not only have integrated the events artifacts and theories of popular culture into their works but also have used those works as windows into popular culture's role in the process of nation building taking her cue from donald barthelme's 1967 portrayal of popular culture as trash and don delillo's 1997 description of it as a subversive people's history stacey olster explores how literature recycles american popular culture so as to change the nationalistic imperative behind its inception the trash phenomenon begins with a look at the mass media's role in the united states emergence as the twentieth century's dominant power olster discusses the works of three authors who collectively span the century bounded by the spanish american war 1898 and the persian gulf war 1991 gore vidal's american chronicle series john updike's rabbit tetralogy and larry beinhart's american hero olster then turns her attention to three non american writers whose works explore the imperial sway of american popular culture on their nation's value systems hierarchical class structure in dennis potter's england peronism in manuel puig's argentina and nihonjinron consensus in haruki murakami's japan finally olster returns to american literature to look at the contemporary media spectacle and the representative figure as potential sources of national consolidation after november 1963 olster first focuses on autobiographical historical and fictional accounts of three spectacles in which the formulae of popular culture are shown to bypass differences of class gender and race the john f kennedy assassination the scarsdale diet doctor murder and the o j simpson trial she concludes with some thoughts about the nature of american consolidation after 9 11

heroes and heroic discourse have gained new visibility in the twenty first century this is noted in recent research on the heroic but it has been largely ignored that heroism is increasingly a global phenomenon both in terms of production and consumption this edited collection aims to bridge this research void and brings together case studies by scholars from different parts of the world and diverse fields they explore how transnational and transcultural processes of translation

jordan peterson a modern phenomenon with legions of fans and an equally substantial number of detractors has appeared as if from nowhere and achieved such polarizing prominence that he is clearly riding the cultural wave it is vital to understand the cultural circumstances underlying the rise to fame of such people this book is neither for nor against peterson although it advances a degree of critical appraisal his precise views are not the central subject of this book nor

are his biographical details instead this book concerns the historical forces that are now at play which for the conservative wing of the political spectrum peterson crystallizes perhaps better than anyone else with the single exception of donald trump where trump is an active executive agent of the spirit of the times actually taking critical decisions and directly shaping events peterson may be viewed in more passive terms as providing an intellectual justification for trump and his base

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
