format focuses on learner modifiability and most significantly links the assessment with educational interventions detailing the implementation of an actual dynamic assessment procedure that is linked with educational interventions this book is a valuable guide for diagnostic assessors from a wide variety of backgrounds including school clinical and counseling psychology as well as special and regular education and speech and language pathology practitioner s guide to dynamic assessment also serves as a text for advanced graduate courses in assessment

children's display of unacceptable behavior in the school setting school violence academic underachievement and school failure represent a cluster of problems that touches all aspects of society children with learning and behavior problems are much more likely to be unemployed exhibit significant emotional and behavior disorders in adulthood as well as become incarcerated for example by adolescence children with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder are more likely to be retained a grade drop out of school have contact with the law or fair worse along a number of dimensions than their unaffected siblings Barkley 1998 identification assessment and treatment of children with externalizing behavior problems and learning disabilities is critical to optimizing development and prevention of relatively tractable behavioral and emotional problems in adulthood for example poor interpersonal problem solving and social skills excesses and deficits are strongly associated with poor outcome in adolescence and adulthood the school is where children learn essential academic social and impulse control skills that allow them to function effectively in later years school is where problems in these areas can be most easily identified and addressed the purpose of this book is to provide an overview of assessment practices for evaluating children's externalizing behavior problems exhibited in the school environment reviews of approximately 100 assessment devices for measuring children's externalizing problems are included instruments include structured interviews rating scales and observational methods

dsm 5 casebook and treatment guide for child mental health offers trainees and clinicians who provide mental health services to children and adolescents a concise but conceptually and clinically rich guide to the types of disorders commonly found in practice the cases are either new or updated from the previous publication which was designed as a child mental health casebook for dsm iv tr and were chosen to illustrate advances in diagnosis and evidence based assessment and treatment with dsm 5 in mind for each case commentaries are included from a child and adolescent psychiatrist and child psychologist or another mental health professional who review each vignette and address diagnostic formulation and treatment from both psychotherapeutic and psychopharmacologic perspectives with attention to other modalities that might be important for clinical management this panel approach allows for a diversity of perspectives and provides valuable complementary insights into each case the book is structured in a logical user friendly way with many features that facilitate and enhance learning cases are divided into four sections each with an introduction by the editors

who summarize and contextualize the information presented in that part providing a framework for understanding and building bridges to the other sections the 29 case vignettes are fascinating instructive and diverse the cases range from fairly clear diagnoses to more complex presentations such as when patients with comorbid conditions to the most difficult cases when the diagnosis is unclear the patient has not responded to previous treatment only limited evidence is available on the correct means of treatment and or the patient's psychopathology occurs in the context of extreme psychosocial stressors the book's final part addresses diagnostic and treatment decision making and includes two chapters on clinical and research issues in the diagnosis and treatment of child psychopathology the book's cross disciplinary approach makes it appropriate for clinicians and trainees from all disciplines who are involved in treating children and adolescents with mental health problems dsm 5 casebook and treatment guide for child mental health is unparalleled in its engaging style up to date information and expert evidence based guidance in conceptualizing diagnosis and treatment

one of the most important practical problems in child psychology and psychiatry is the differential diagnosis of emotional disorders until recently the general mode of assessment had been to apply to children the characteristics of psychopathology that were evident in adults in addition there had been few assessment tools available for use with children aside from modified versions of adult instruments understandably this approach was controversial and dissatisfaction with it led to the more recent knowledge that adult and child problems may be manifested quite differently the third edition of the diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders takes these factors into account much more extensively than previous editions furthermore a great deal of research on methodology in child assessment procedures has emerged recently yet in spite of these advances practicing clinicians are still frequently at a loss in moving from the characteristics of the disturbed child before them to the final assignment of a psychiatric diagnosis the focus of this book is to outline the various methods of viewing and categorizing the wide range childhood psychopathology with special emphasis on the end product of making a differential diagnosis our goal was to make this book unique in

several ways first we attempted to cover a wider range of disorders than is typical in currently available hand books

the increasing focus on children s welfare has given rise to tremendous growth in the field of child psychology and the past decade has witnessed significant advances in research in this area

the movements toward cultural sensitivity and evidence based practice are watershed developments in clinical psychology as a population with a long history of substandard treatment from mental health systems african americans have especially benefitted from these improvements but as with other racial and ethnic minorities finding relevant test measures in most psychological domains presents clinicians with an ongoing challenge the guide to psychological assessment with african americans aims to close the evaluation therapy gap by giving practitioners the tools to choose appropriate instruments while respecting client individuality expert contributors analyze scarce and far flung data identify strengths and limitations of measures and norms in their use with african american clients and advise on avoiding biases in interpreting results the editors advocate for a theory based hypothesis testing approach to assessment when empirical evidence is lacking and offer guidelines for decision making that is effective as well as ethnically aware the guide s findings insights and practical information cover the gamut of test and diagnostic areas including iq and personality generalized anxiety disorder panic and phobias neuropsychological assessment cognitive decline and dementia mood disorders and suicidality forensic assessment risk and recidivism measures specific to children and adolescents plus ptsd substance disorders eating pathology and more expertly complementing cross cultural treatment texts the guide to psychological assessment with african americans stands out as a trustworthy resource for treatment planning useful to clinical psychologists neuropsychologists and clinical social workers

information this book aims to do this for practitioners professionals in health welfare and education and interested laypersons including parents this is no easy task since the levels of technical knowledge vary from that of the special education teacher seeking information about the drugs that many such pupils will be receiving to that of the modern young child and adolescent psychiatrist whose grasp of the difficult fields of pharmacokinetics how drugs are absorbed distributed and eliminated and neurotransmitter physiology via which most psychoactive drugs work is daunting to the editors who grew up in the bucolic clinical empirical era inevitably there are sections of the book that will prove too technical for any except the medically qualified but considerable effort has been applied to make much of the

text especially that discussing the clinical uses and side effects of the drugs comprehensible to anyone used to getting information by reading we also take comfort in the fact that many of the major contributions in pediatric psychopharmacology have been made by nonmedical professionals notably psychologists suggesting that an audience beyond the medically qualified is practicable one other problem confronted us whether to organize the book by psycho pathological symptoms e g hyperactivity and disorders e g autism or by drugs

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
