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through an engagement with the philosophies of proust s contemporaries félix ravaillon henri bergson and georg simmel suzanne guerlac presents an original reading of remembrance of things past a la recherche du temps perdu challenging traditional interpretations she argues that proust s magnum opus is not a melancholic text but one that records the dynamic time of change and the complex vitality of the real situating proust s novel within a modernism of money and broadening the exploration through references to cultural events and visual technologies commercial photography photojournalism pornography the regulation of prostitution the panama scandal and the dreyfus affair this study reveals that proust s subject is not the esthetic recuperation of loss but rather the adventure of living in time on both the individual and the social level at a concrete historical moment

this book is a judicial military and political history of the period 1941 to 1954 as such it is also a united states legal history of both world war ii and the early cold war civil liberties mass conscription expanded military jurisdiction property rights labor relations and war crimes arising from the conflict were all issues to come before the federal judiciary during this period and well beyond since the supreme court and the lower courts heard appeals

from the government's wartime decisions well into the 1970s a detailed study of the judiciary during world war ii evidences that while the majority of the justices and judges determined appeals partly on the basis of enabling a large disciplined and reliable military to either deter or fight a third world war there was a recognition of the existence of a tension between civil rights and liberties on the one side and military necessity on the other while the majority of the judiciary tilted toward national security and deference to the military establishment the judiciary's recognition of this tension created a foundation for persons to challenge governmental narrowing of civil and individual rights after 1954 kastenberg and merriam present a clearer picture as to why the court and the lower courts determined the issues before them in terms of external influences from both national and world wide events this book is also a study of civil military relations in wartime so whilst legal scholars will find this study captivating so will military and political historians as well as political scientists and national security policy makers

this book explores the duality of openness and restriction in approaches to migrants in the nordic countries as borders have become less permeable to non europeans it presents research on civil society practices that oppose the existing border regimes and examine the values that they express the volume offers case studies from across the region that demonstrate opposition to increasingly restricted borders and which seek to offer hospitality to migrant one topic is whether these practices impact and transform the nordic protestant trajectory the book considers whether such actions are indicative of new sensibilities and values in which traditional categories and binaries are becoming less relevant it also discusses what these practices of hospitality indicate about the changing relationship between voluntary organizations and the nordic welfare states in the time of migration as such it will appeal to scholars of sociology anthropology and religious studies with interests in migration civil society resistance and social values

in time and death carol white articulates a vision of martin heidegger's work which grows out of a new understanding of what he was trying to address in his discussion of death acknowledging that the discussion of this issue in heidegger's major work *Being and Time* is often far from clear white presents a new interpretation of heidegger which short circuits many of the traditional criticisms white claims that we are all in a better position to understand heidegger's insights after fifty years because they have now become a part of the conventional wisdom of common opinion his view shows up in accounts of knowledge in the physical sciences in the assumptions of the social sciences in art and film even in popular culture in general but does so in ways ignorant of their origins now that these insights have filtered down into the culture at large we can make heidegger intelligible in a way that perhaps he himself could not white presents the best possible case for heidegger making him more intelligible to those people with a long acquaintance with his work those with a long aversion to it and in particular to those just starting to pursue an interest in it white places the problems with which heidegger is dealing in the context of issues in contemporary anglo american philosophy in order to better locate him for the more mainstream audience the language and approach of the book is able to accommodate the novice but also offers much food for thought for the heidegger scholar

this book is about urban terror its meaning its ramifications and its impact on city life written by a well known expert in the field cities in a time of terror draws on data from more

than a thousand cities across the globe and traces the evolution of urban terrorism between 1968 and 2006 it explains what kinds of cities have become prime targets why terrorism has become increasingly lethal and how its inspiration has changed from secular to religious the author describes urban terrorism as an attempt to use the city's own strength against itself forcing it to implode and delineates three basic logics of terrorist choices for targeting cities the book also includes a discussion of local resilience the city's capacity to bounce back from attack and suggests how that can be sustained examples from new york london jerusalem istanbul moscow paris and madrid illustrate the book's central themes
