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the auto sector is north america s most iconic of industries since the north american free trade agreement came into existence in 1994 the sector has undergone tremendous change escalating concerns around climate change advances in electric and automated vehicles deindustrialization reindustrialization and the rise of low cost locations as hubs for manufacturing the north american auto industry since nafta examines the issues that have preoccupied the development of policy associated with the manufacture of automobiles in north america the collection addresses the punctuations that have afflicted the industry since nafta s implementation as well as the slower incremental evolutions that have also occurred several aspects of automobility and the industry are explored including but not limited to the canadian american and mexican automotive sectors and their evolution and interaction under evolving trade regimes the book analyses issues surrounding labour technology trade policy

regional development the environment and broader societal impacts of the automobile it also draws on the expertise of a wide cross section of industry experts and scholars to provide readers with a deeper understanding of the automotive industry and its central role in north america s economic business and political landscape

the origins of wright park date to 1886 when the tacoma land companythe real estate agency of the northern pacific railwaydonated 27 acres of land to the newly incorporated and booming young railroad town of tacoma on the condition that it become a city park a hilly logged and brambly parcel of land the acreage was nonetheless enthusiastically received by citizens of tacoma named in honor of charles barstow wright the president of the tacoma land company wright park and its surrounding streets and avenues soon became the early address of distinction for tacomas grand residences as well as many educational religious and medical institutions now more than a century later tacomas landmark wright park is the recipient of renewed citizen investment and appreciation as this photographic retrospective demonstrates

this book investigates the new urban geographies of smart metropolitan regionalism across the greater seattle area and examines the relationship between smart growth planning strategies and spaces of work home and mobility the book specifically explores seattle within the wider space economy and multi scaled policy regime of the puget sound region as a whole jumping up from questions of city politics to concerns with what the book interprets as the intercurrency of city regional ordering these theoretical terms capture the state progressive effort to promote smarter forms of regional development but also the societal institutional tensions and outright contradictions that such urban development invariably entails particularly around problems of social equity key organizing themes in the text include the historical path dependencies of uneven economic and social development particularly between tacoma pierce county and seattle king county current patterns of high wage medium wage and low wage jobs the emerging spatial and social structure of recent residential changes especially with respect to class and race composition and finally transit trends and new urban spaces associated with policy efforts to mitigate highway congestion and car dependency greater seattle then is mapped as a key us urban region inscribed spatially by the uneven search for a more sustainable order historically sensitive theoretically informed and empirically topical this book is of interest to scholars and students at all levels in regional planning urban geography political science sustainability studies urban sociology and public policy

over the past forty years state provincial and local governments in the united states and canada have provided foreign automakers with approximately 4 80 billion in incentives in order to lure light vehicles assembly plants to their areas this has included tax abatements infrastructure construction land giveaways job training programs and other subsidies as of early 2015 ten foreign vehicle makers operated 20 light vehicles in developed north america despite the fact that all ten of these automakers have pursued a similar pattern first exporting vehicles into the united states and canada before launching vehicle plants in developed north america each has followed its own specific historical development path and has created its own unique growth trajectory this book provides a unique historical and qualitative review of these ten vehicle makers from their early beginnings to their export entry into the united states and or canada through early 2015 in addition it chronicles the histories of more than a dozen former automakers and potential future foreign light motor vehicle assembly plants in the united states and canada this includes the first foreign automaker to build its cars in the united states de dion bouton of france in july 1900 the early 20th century endeavors of fiat mercedes and rolls royce and the present day hopes of chinese and indian automakers in the process the text also provides an assessment of the top competing states and sites for any future plants the possible incentives packages governments may offer to attract such facilities and an estimated incentive value for each automaker overall the goal of this book is to expand the knowledge of policymakers at all tiers of government in the united states and canada and to help them take a

more holistic look at the pros and cons of attracting automobile manufacturing fdi it is hoped that this will enable them to make more informed decisions when pursuing a new foreign motor vehicle assembly plant its findings should also prove informative to urban and regional planning political science sociology economics labor and international development scholars and students in north america and worldwide

this book details how manufacturing developed in america through the industrial revolution and labor movement analyzes the impact of outsourcing offshore and our nation s trade policies looks at what various organizations are doing to try to help save american manufacturing and what we can do as individuals from the perspective of business owners employees consumers and voters to save american manufacturing author michele nashhoff argues that we will not be able to save american manufacturing unless we develop a national manufacturing strategy and change our trade policies she supports a buy american policy recommends preventing the sale of strategic u s owned companies to foreign companies and enacting legislation to prevent corporations from avoiding income taxes by incorporating in a foreign country the 2012 edition also describes the reshoring initiative and considers the reasons why companies are returning manufacturing back to america from asia

the increasing demand for advanced manufacturing processes is making an impact on the earth s resources and its industrial practices are producing negative impacts on the environment such as carbon footprints energy resources waste etc the trend of advanced manufacturing coincides with the acceleration of innovations in sustainable techniques advanced manufacturing processes integration of sustainable approaches focuses on sustainability materials the 6 rs reuse recycle redesign remanufacture reduce and recover lifecycle engineering and life cycle assessment it discusses sustainability in manufacturing and the impact on plant performance while keeping in mind ir 4 0 and highlights issues related to materials recovery and a circular economy the book also presents the use of new sustainable materials in processes and their impact on the environment and plant performance case studies are offered to enable the reader to get a comparison of the manufacturing processes based on individual sustainability all aspects related to the implementation and adoption of sustainable advanced manufacturing approaches are encapsulated in this book along with their applications which makes this a useful book for industry academic teaching research scholars and experts dealing with sustainability related issues

semester long faculty led programs featuring examples of programs located in a wide variety of locations from investigations into history immigration culture and the environment through localities in the west and the lowcountry to exploring globalization in I a and new york section three highlights five short term faculty led programs while each includes an intensive immersive study away experience two illustrate how a 7 10 day study away experience can be effectively embedded into a regular course taught on campus the fourth section on consortium programs describes programs that are either sponsored by a college that makes its program available to consortium members and non members or is offered by an independent non for profit to which institutions send their students the final section on community engagement and domestic study away addresses the place of community based education in global learning and provides examples of academic programs that employ service learning as a tool for collaborative learning focusing on issues of pedagogy faculty development and the building long term reciprocal relationship with community partners to co create knowledge the book is intended for study abroad professionals multicultural educators student affairs professionals alternative spring break directors and higher education administrators concerned about affordably expanding global education opportunities
