this tribute to professor detlev vagts of the harvard law school brings together his colleagues at harvard and the american society of international law as well as academics judges and practitioners many of them his former students their essays span the entire spectrum of modern transnational law international law in general transnational economic law and transnational lawyering and dispute resolution the contributors evaluate established fields of transnational law such as the protection of property and investment and explore new areas of law which are in the process of detaching themselves from the nation state such as global administrative law and the regulation of cross border lawyering the implications of decentralised norm making the proliferation of dispute settlement mechanisms and the rising backlash against global legal interdependence in the form of demands for preserving state legal autonomy are also examined

this book explores the importance of entrepreneurs in driving economic growth as the world economy grows and becomes more integrated and more challenging it examines the situation in both advanced and developing countries and shows how the entrepreneurial orientation of the founders of small and medium sized enterprises has resulted in phenomenal growth often fuelled by innovation and new technologies it contrasts the experiences of chinese family business in china and among the overseas chinese with the experiences of family businesses in the united states and europe one important conclusion is that there has been a noticeable fall in entrepreneurial proclivity in the advanced economies in contrast to the position in emerging economies

in this revised second edition hans jansson develops and applies an international business strategy framework to contemporary complex global markets this cutting edge textbook explores the major challenges associated with doing business in complex and turbulent emerging markets and how mncs in mature markets execute strategies to meet these challenges

contemporary debates about the changing nature of law engage theories of legal pluralism political economy social systems international relations or regime theory global constitutionalism and public international law such debates reveal a variety of emerging responses to distributional issues which arise beyond the western welfare state and new conceptions of private transnational authority however private international law tends to stand aloof claiming process based neutrality or the apolitical nature of private law technique and refusing to recognize frontiers beyond those of the nation state as a result the discipline is paradoxically ill equipped to deal with the most significant cross border legal difficulties from immigration to private financial regulation which might have been expected to fall within its remit

contributing little to the governance of transnational non state power it is largely complicit in its unhampered expansion this is all the more a paradox given that the new thinking from other fields which seek to fill the void theories of legal pluralism peer networks transnational substantive rules privatized dispute resolution and regime collision have long been part of the daily fare of the conflict of laws the crucial issue now is whether private international law can or indeed should survive as a discipline this volume lays the foundations for a critical approach to private international law in the global era while the governance of global issues such as health climate and finance clearly implicates the law and particularly international law its private law dimension is generally invisible this book develops the idea that the liberal divide between public and private international law has enabled the unregulated expansion of transnational private power in these various fields it explores the potential of private international law to reassert a significant governance function in respect of new forms of authority beyond the state to do so it must shed a number of assumptions entrenched in the culture of the nation state but this will permit the discipline to expand its potential to confront major issues in global governance

although negotiation still lies at the heart of international commercial agreements much of the detail has migrated to the internet and has become part of electronic commerce this incomparable one volume work now in its sixth edition with its deeply informed emphasis on both the face to face and electronic components of setting up and performing an international commercial agreement stands alone among contract drafting guides and has proven its enduring worth following its established highly practical format the book s much appreciated precise information on a wide variety of issues including those pertaining to intellectual property alternative dispute resolution and regional differences is of course still here in this new edition there is new and updated material on such matters as the following the need for contract drafters to understand and to use the concepts of standardization i e the work of the international organization for standardization iso as a contract drafting tool new developments and technical progress in e commerce new developments in artificial intelligence in contract drafting the possible use of electronic currencies such as bitcoin as a payment device foreign direct investment special considerations inherent in drafting licensing agreements online dispute resolution including the innovations referred to as the robot arbitrator changes in the arbitration rules of major international organizations and assessment of possible future trends in international commercial arrangements each chapter provides numerous references to additional sources including a large number of websites materials from and citations to appropriate literature in languages other than english are also included in its recognition that a business executive entering into an international commercial transaction is mainly interested in drafting an agreement that satisfies all of the parties and that will be performed as promised this superb guide will immeasurably assist any lawyer or business executive to plan and carry out individual transactions even when that person is not interested in a full blown understanding of the entire landscape of international contracts business executives who are not lawyers will find that this book gives them the understanding and perspective necessary to work effectively with the legal experts
