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mental health professionals face many complex questions in the course of their work with clients and patients among the most difficult are dilemmas that involve ethical issues this book presents a forthright exploration of these dilemmas and the ethical considerations they raise drawing on extensive interviews the author identifies common ethical problems that practitioners encounter what happens for example when personal interests intrude into therapy how can the therapist make an accurate assessment of his or her appropriateness as a care provider for a particular patient what about confidentiality how are problematic financial arrangements best addressed the author goes on to show how these dilemmas may be intensified by the unique assumptions of different therapeutic orientations individual group family marital and organizational and how professionals can learn from such experiences to better understand and apply their particular approach this analysis and the words of the therapists themselves provide both a guide to practice and a unique store of experience for the growing number of researchers and students concerned with ethical problems in psychotherapy

this book addresses the ethical problems that physicians have to face every day while caring for critically ill patients advances in medical technology ageing societies worldwide and their increased demands on health care systems have on the one hand led to better care and remarkable longevity in many parts of the world on the other hand however improved treatments in many medical fields amongst others in emergency and critical care have resulted in more patients surviving with reduced quality of life this entails tradeoffs for many patients their families and the teams caring for them at the same time health care expenditures have risen dramatically and have to be balanced against costs for other public goods finally the humane aspects of care have often failed to keep pace with the remarkable technological strides made in recent

years in this book experts in their respective fields describe compelling ethical challenges resulting from these discrepancies and discuss potential solutions the book is primarily intended for clinicians who care for two of the most vulnerable patient subpopulations those being treated in ambulances or emergency rooms and those being treated at intensive care units due in part to the fact that they may be temporarily or permanently incapacitated core medical skills such as diagnosis and predicting outcomes as well as implementing treatment remain challenging however without adequate communication and collaboration both within the inter professional treatment teams and between the teams and the patients their families delivering excellent care is difficult at best therefore the so called soft skills are given the attention they deserve in order to overcome the gap between technological progress and interpersonal standstill

over the last quarter of a century the fields of medical ethics and of legal issues related to medical practice have rapidly developed for a number of reasons firstly the provision of healthcare nowadays is based on a complicated partnership between healthcare providers patients administrators and organizations responsible for providing finance this complicated partnership frequently results in clashes of views opinions and priorities which have a major ethical and legal dimension secondly a major event of the 21st century is the development of multicultural societies healthcare related decisions thus have to be made on the background of so many different ethnicities religions cultures and languages resulting in a great spectrum of ethical and legal implications thirdly in the modern world people are more mobile and can easily and cost effectively seek treatment outside of their country of origin or residence which raises many ethical and legal issues lastly the development of new medical specialties modern and advanced treatments for very challenging patients and the introduction of new technologies in medical practice have dramatically broadened the spectrum of ethical and legal issues related to medical practice this book will therefore aim to cover in detail general principles and specific issues related to the ethical and legal dimensions of modern surgical practice

toward assessing business ethics education edited by diane l swanson and dann g fisher of kansas state university is a sequel to their book advancing business ethics education in the ethics in practice iap book series the focus on assessment in this second book is a timely response to the urgent search among business schools for ways to teach and assess ethics at a time when the public s faith in corporations and business schools has been undermined greatly by the failure of both to respond to widespread corruption and scandals in the business sector although no one expects business education alone to resolve these problems the distinguished scholars represented in this book advocate that business schools should at least do their part by exposing their students to decision models that incorporate ethical dimensions on behalf of corporate stakeholders and society at large as the book s title conveys it is then important to assess key learning objectives to insure that business students graduate knowing ethics fundamentals and armed with the ability to recognize ethical dilemmas and possible solutions during the course of their careers this book will speak to all who are interested in accountability for business ethics education especially business school deans university administrators faculty members students and prospective employers this audience will find that the enterprise of assessing business ethics education is advanced in three ways first the book functions as a venue for distinguished scholars to share the innovative ways that they are assessing ethics coverage in courses and degree programs second these authors identify what needs to be assessed and the means for doing so third the book serves not only as a guide to assessment but also as a platform for expanding and improving ethics coverage in business schools moreover an important take away for readers is the provision of a simple formula first advocated by diane l swanson and william c frederick university of pittsburgh in 2005 for delivering ethics education that minimizes assessment errors by following this formula business schools can provide assurances that ethics will not be assessed as being sufficient when it is woefully inadequate or even missing in the curriculum and that it cannot be distorted diluted or trivialized by uninformed coverage and still pass inspection avoiding these assessment errors is critical in an educational environment in which weak accrediting standards for ethics go hand in hand with spotty uniformed coverage that would not be tolerated for other business disciplines

pediatricians in the unites states and around the world continue to face a myriad of

global health threats affecting child and adolescent health including 1 infectious diseases of poverty e g human immunodeficiency virus hiv tuberculosis malaria and neglected tropical diseases in low and middle income countries Imic especially in sub saharan africa 2 emerging and reemerging infectious diseases such as ebola 3 rise of non communicable diseases e g common mental disorders 4 unintentional injuries and 5 environmental health hazards e g climate change despite the promising news about rapid declines in maternal and child mortality in the era of millennium development goals mdgs which originated from the united nation un millennium declaration in 2000 only 20 and 7 of Imic are currently on track to attain the maternal and child mortality targets for example 44 of deaths in children younger than 5 years occur in neonates besides discovery of life saving interventions e g development of new and improved vaccines for maternal and child health we also need to do a better job at bridging the knowledge implementation gap and increase the effectiveness of proven interventions for example despite the availability of effective vaccines to prevent pneumococcal pneumonia rotavirus gastroenteritis and human papilloma virus related diseases e g cervical cancer use of these vaccines remain suboptimal in Imic we need to recognize that global health is also local public health for example improving access equity and quality of care for orphans and vulnerable children immigrant and newly arrived refugee children in the u s remains a challenge timely access to psychiatric care for children and adolescents with mental illness is a major concern the explosion of new age technology such as the internet also poses a considerable risk to children and adolescents pediatricians also need to be aware of diverse socio cultural determinants of health and ethical issues in global health service and delivery this issue of pediatric clinics of north america aims to address the above crucial global health challenges affecting children and adolescents as practicing pediatricians we have the unique opportunity to influence local and global public health in the post mdg era beyond 2015 collaborative partnerships between various disciplines and across research education and service is vital to reduce health inequities in children worldwide
