teaching interpreting and live subtitling contexts modes and technologies provides a cross section of multinational perspectives on teaching various dimensions of interpreting and live subtitling both within dedicated programmes and as part of individual modules on interpreting and or live subtitling adjacent programmes interpreting training and live subtitling training have been undergoing rapid and far reaching transformations in recent years because of technological advances and the sweeping shifts in the contexts within which they seek to mediate ultimately bringing about new modes this volume covers the broad spectrum of interpreting and live subtitling trainings and discusses the possibility of how a more unified approach to training for live subtitlers and interpreters could lead to a future where the topics merge to become a single complementary specialised stream of training that brings live subtitling equally into the forefront of the translation teaching field the book provides an overview of the role played by technology in interpreting in general and uses up to date perspectives and research to ensure that interpreting and live subtitling training remains robust and resilient far into the 21st century it will be of particular interest to professionals scholars and teachers of translation studies and interpreting studies

this handbook offers a broad ranging overview of the study of translating and interpreting in conflict and crisis settings and takes the field in new directions covering a wide selection of multimodal contexts that build on the fundamentals of translation interpreting and their in between hybrid forms of mediation the handbook is divided into four parts the opening part covers perspectives on policy and practices whether contemporary or historical and cases truly span the globe from peru and brazil over belgium and sierra leone to australia japan and hong kong international developments require profound considerations about the professionalisation of access to language in times of crises not least in contexts of humanitarian negotiation or conflict zone interpreting these form the second part the subsequent part deals with spheres of community in which language needs are positioned within frames of agency positionality and trust and the challenges that these face the contributions build on cases where interpreters act as catalysts for translation needs in settings of humanitarian aid and beyond the final part considers language strategies and solutions in crises this handbook is the essential guide to translation and interpreting in conflict and crisis settings for advanced students and researchers of translation and interpreting studies and will be of wide interest in peace studies political science and beyond

interpreters who work with signed languages and those who work strictly with spoken languages share many of the same issues regarding their training skill sets and fundamentals of practice yet interpreting into and from signed languages presents unique challenges for the interpreter who works with language that must be seen rather than heard the contributions in this volume focus on topics of interest to both students of signed language interpreting and practitioners working in community conference and education settings signed languages dealt with include american sign language langue des signes qu  b  coise and irish sign language although interpreters internationally will find the discussion in each chapter relevant to their own language context topics concern theoretical and practical components of the interpreter s work

including interpreters approaches to language and meaning their role on the job and in the communities within which they work dealing with language variation and consumer preferences and deaf interpreters as professionals in the field

professor riccardo moratto and professor hyang ok lim bring together the most authoritative voices on korean interpreting the first graduate school of interpretation and translation was established in 1979 in south korea since then not only has the interpretation and translation market grown exponentially but so too has research in translation studies though the major portion of research focuses on translation interpretation has not only managed to hold its own but interpretation studies in korea have been a pioneer in this field in asia this handbook highlights the main interpretation research trends in south korea today including case studies of remote interpreting during the covid 19 pandemic korean interpreting for conferences events and diplomacy and research into educating interpreters effectively an essential resource for researchers in korean interpreting this handbook will also be very valuable to those working with other east asian languages

of study and illustrates overlapping aspects of research authored by a range of practicing interpreters and academics from across five continents this is the essential guide to interpreting and technology for both advanced students and researchers of interpreting and professional interpreters

as politicians and judges argue over the original intent of our country's founding fathers the american founding itself continues to inspire a prodigious amount of research and commentary reflecting a bewildering array of methods and interpretations alan gibson now offers readers an insightful and convenient guide through this daunting and sprawling body of scholarship comprehensive and judicious interpreting the founding provides summaries and analyses of the leading interpretive frameworks that have guided the study of the founding since the publication of charles beard's an economic interpretation of the constitution in 1913 gibson argues that scholarship on the founding is no longer steered by a single dominant approach or even by a set of questions that control its direction he also examines the challenges posed to founding scholarship by this diversity and complexity and the possibilities opened by new avenues of inquiry that have recently emerged scholars of the founding including louis hartz bernard bailyn gordon wood and garry wills that best exemplify different schools of interpretation gibson focuses on six approaches that have dominated the modern study of the founding progressive lockean liberal republican scottish enlightenment multicultural and multiple traditions approaches for each approach he traces its fundamental assumptions revealing deeper ideological and methodological differences between schools of thought that on the surface seem to differ only about the interpretation of historical facts while previous accounts have treated the study of the founding as the sequential replacement of one paradigm by another gibson argues that all of these interpretations survive as alternative and still viable approaches each has simultaneously illuminated and masked core truths about the american founding he renders a balanced account of the current debate over the origins and foundations of the american republic and offers solid footing on the path

to understanding the vast literature devoted to this important subject
