look at all the problems that humanity faces today poverty hunger unemployment union busting racial oppression gender oppression homophobia endless war and long hours of work for stingy wages let s face it capitalism sucks capitalism sucks talks about these problems and what we can do to solve them wolf larsen has worked in both white collar and blue collar jobs in addition he s traveled to over 50 countries and seen firsthand the human misery that capitalism has created throughout the planet

mark zuehlke is an expert at narrating the history of life on the battlefield for the canadian army during world war ii in terrible victory he provides a soldiers eye view account of canada s bloody liberation of western holland readers are there as soldiers fight in the muddy quagmire enduring a battle that lasted three weeks and in which 6 000 soldiers perished terrible victory is a powerful story of courage survival and skill

as stefan ihrig shows in this first comprehensive study many germans sympathized with the ottomans longstanding repression of the armenians and with the turks program of extermination during

world war i in the nazis version of history the armenian genocide was justifiable because it had made possible the astonishing rise of the new turkey

in the modern greek city of thessaloniki the ruins of a vast jewish cemetery lie buried under the city s university nearby is the site of the childhood home of one of the founders of the modern turkish state these are tantalizing reminders of what was once the bustling cosmopolitan city of salonica home not just to greeks but to thousands of sephardic jews turks bulgarians and armenians living and working peacefully alongside one another thessaloniki is just one example among many of what used to be over the past two centuries ethnic cleansing has remade the map of central and eastern europe and the middle east transforming vast empires that embraced many ethnic groups into nearly homogenous nations towns and cities from germany to turkey still show traces of the vanished and nearly forgotten ethnic and religious communities that once called these places home in terrible fate benjamin lieberman describes the violent transformations that occurred in salonica and hundreds of other towns and cities as the ottoman russian austro hungarian and german empires collapsed to be reborn as the modern nation states we know today his book is the first comprehensive history of this process that has involved the murder and forced migration of tens of millions of people drawing upon eyewitness accounts contemporary journalism and diplomatic records lieberman s story sweeps across the continent taking the reader from ethnic cleansing s earliest beginnings in bulgaria greece and russia in the nineteenth century through the rise of nationalism both world wars the armenian genocide the holocaust and the rise and fall of the soviet empire up to the breakup of yugoslavia in the 1990s along the way he examines the decisive roles of political leaders not only monarchs and dictators but also those who were democratically elected as well as ordinary people who often required very little encouragement to rob and brutalize their neighbors or who were simply caught up in the tide of history

this book seeks to answer three vital questions about the worldwide response to hitler s final solution when did information about the genocide first become known to jews and non jews through what channels was this information transmitted what was the reaction of those who received word of the slaughter walter laqueur s quest focuses on the period between june 1941 when germany invaded the soviet union and december 1942 by which time the united nations had confirmed the news about the mass killings in a common declaration by the end of 1942 chelmno belzec auschwitz maidanek sobibor and treblinka were fully operational and two and a half million jews had already been killed according to laqueur word started to spread soon after extermination began but there is no easy straightforward answer to the wider question of why there was a failure to read and correctly interpret the signs in 1941 why so many individuals and governments actually chose to deny the reality of genocide when faced with incontrovertible evidence a probing and disturbing work the terrible secret explores one of the most perplexing aspects of the holocaust a political and psychological riddle of general significance to the understanding of the history of our times
