turkey has always been a crossroads and therefore offers an ideal location to study interaction between individuals and human communities and societies through time interaction has always necessarily involved movement which in turn did not occur randomly in the landscape but was instead focused on routes and roads that secured faster and easier

connections there is substantial evidence that exchange networks already existed in anatolia at least since the neolithic period with goods traveling over long distances from the second millennium bc onwards textual evidence has improved understanding of traveling routes the roman long distance road network has been a focus of research over decades but local roads and pathways around individual sites are still mostly unknown byzantine roads have also received attention whereas the seljuk road and routes system is less well known it is likely that the younger roads and routes are overlying older ones at least partially but these palimpsests of older roads are hardly researched in this volume experts from different disciplines using a variety of methods and approaches aim to transcend the present fragmentation of knowledge and create a new level of understanding of connecting road and route systems in anatolia throughout time for the first time

archaeologists have focused a great deal of attention on explaining the evolution of village societies and the transition to a neolithic way of life considerable interest has also concentrated on urbanism and the rise of the earliest cities between these two landmarks in human cultural development lies a critical stage in social and political evolution throughout world at various points in time people living in small dispersed village communities have come together into larger and more complex social formations these community aggregates were essentially middle range situated between the earliest villages and emergent chiefdoms and states this volume explores the social processes involved in the creation and maintenance of aggregated communities and how they brought about revolutionary transformations that affected virtually every aspect of a society and its culture while there have been a number of studies that address coalescence from a regional perspective less is understood about how aggregated communities functioned internally the key premise explored in this volume is that large scale long term cultural transformations were ultimately enacted in the context of daily practices interactions and what might be otherwise considered the mundane aspects of everyday life how did these processes play out on the ground in diverse and historically contingent settings what are the strategies and mechanisms that people adopt in order to facilitate living in larger social formations what changes in social relations occur when people come together this volume employs a broadly cross cultural approach to interrogating these questions employing case studies which span four continents and more than 10 000 years of human history

the japanese economy is currently at a crossroads and the embarrassing situation the country faces today is even worse than the meiji restoration of 1868 the defeat after world war ii in 1945 and the yen appreciation after the plaza agreements of 1985 indeed the traditional japanese model is doomed to failure mainly due to economic and industrial structures that are inappropriate towards increasing globalization liberalization and deregulation however japanese style industrial capitalism is in this work compared to the economic and social models of other developed countries and this enables us to point out the path the japanese economy may take in the 21st century in order to survive

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
