the best theatrical read of the year British Theatre Guide a book of selected theatre reviews from 1992 to 2020 from one of the foremost authorities on British theatre each chapter starts with a brief commentary on the developments of that era and the social political and cultural context within which British theatre was being produced key obituaries and letters in response to reviews written are also included providing a rich collection of curated archival material following on from his first collection one night stands Michael Billington's chronicle offers a rich authoritative insight into British theatre over the last 3 decades from his unique professional perspective it begins with Tony Kushner's UK premiere of *Angels in America* at the National Theatre in 1992 and culminates with Inua Ellams's celebrated adaptation of Chekhov's *Three Sisters* at the same venue almost 30 years later en route we're exposed to the fallibility of theatre criticism through his much regretted original criticism of Sarah Kane's *Blasted* and its role in identifying major talents at the first opportunity having recently retired from his 48 year position as the Guardian newspaper's drama critic during which time he wrote around 10 000 theatre reviews Michael Billington was Britain's longest serving theatre critic through his work he was present at an eye watering number of premieres during this time and witnessed first hand the exciting developments in British theatre over the past 30 years and the substantial pressures it faced never more so than today

Helen Edmundson's latest collaboration with shared experience

one of the longest novels in Western literature Tolstoy's *War and Peace* intertwines its epic account of Napoleon's invasion of Russia with the tale of three aristocratic families painted on a vast canvas of locations characters and experiences Helen Edmundson's stirring adaptation is an intricate saga of families love and friendship against a backdrop of war

an essential guide for writers of fiction poetry life writing and drama a creative writing handbook offers expert advice on structuring compelling narratives and cultivating distinctive voices writing research and editing activities combine with rich

and varied examples to help develop the skills and techniques a writer needs this hands on approach examines scriptwriting for different media and considers how skills and techniques from one form of writing might usefully cross over to others how does a short story become a film how are techniques from scriptwriting employed in novels and how might poets and life writers fruitfully engage with the strategies of dramatists and writers of prose fiction this second edition has been extensively updated with content that reflects current developments in forms such as life writing flash fiction and audio drama it includes examples of work by a wide range of writers using a variety of styles and approaches showcasing the diversity of contemporary writing for individual writers writing groups and courses and writers workshops a creative writing handbook provides creative techniques for developing short stories and novels detailed introductions to stage audio and film writing strategies for incorporating dramatic techniques in poetry thought provoking approaches to life writing practical guidance on layout and adaptation techniques for different media exciting activities to help writers discover new approaches strengthen their writing and develop their own practice and voice a creative writing handbook has been written by nine published authors and creative writing lecturers who have taught at institutions including the university of cambridge the university of east anglia and new york university it is edited by derek neale a fiction writer and dramatist who is emeritus professor of creative writing at the open university and heather richardson emma claire sweeney and siobhán campbell senior lecturers in creative writing at the open university who are variously novelists short story writers poets and authors of creative non fiction

writers from mustapha matura and alfred fagon to roy williams kwame kwei armah and bola agbaje irish plays ranging from bernard shaw s john bull s other island to brendan behan s the hostage its critically lauded political play cycles the bomb a partial history and the great game afghanistan the latter performed at the pentagon in 2011 the tricycle theatre has been both defiantly local and proudly international it has held a mirror up to british society and above all it has proved that political engagement is not incompatible with the highest artistic standards it has helped make my life as a critic worthwhile michael billington foreword

this exciting interdisciplinary volume featuring contributions from a group of leading international scholars reflects on the long history of representations of transatlantic slaves and slavery encompassing a broad chronological range from the eighteenth century to the present day

william boyce a tercentenary sourcebook and compendium is published in celebration of the three hundredth anniversary of the birth in 1711 of england s leading eighteenth century composer it is the first book to be devoted to a musician who more than any of his contemporaries carried the flag in the broadest sense for english music during a period that was inevitably dominated by the towering figure of handel who was then resident in london by the late 19th century however boyce had become generally known only as a composer of anthems and the national song hearts of oak and as the editor of a monumental historical anthology of english anthems cathedral music which was still in use at that time the emergent baroque revival led to a gradual broadening of awareness of boyce from the 1890s onwards yet it was only following the initiatives inspired by the bicentenary of his death in 1979 that a significantly wider public appreciation of the quality and

range of his achievements came about previously neglected works were revived new recordings made scholarly articles written and new editions of his music began to be published this book brings together diplomatic transcriptions of all the most significant contemporary documents relevant to boyce s personal and family life his career as a composer editor theorist teacher conductor master of the king s music and the reception history of his music they are accompanied by critical commentaries whenever necessary the range of sources drawn on includes memoirs histories diaries letters poems concert programmes and related press reports chapel royal court and parish archives prefaces to boyce s own publications of his music and those edited by others advertisements for performances of his works and related press reports details of his subscriptions to musical and literary works and materials that throw light on his character and professional relationships with the poets playwrights churchmen and other musicians with whom he collaborated within the vibrant burgeoning and sometimes colourful english musical culture of his time the book s catalogue of works constitutes the first comprehensive listing of boyce s musical output to have been published and the select historical discography is the first catalogue of recordings to have been devoted to the composer s works

shakespeare and the spanish comedia is a nearly unique transnational study of the theater performance traditions of early modern spain and england divided into three parts the book focuses first on translating for the stage examining diverse approaches to the topic it asks for example whether plays should be translated to sound as if they were originally written in the target language or if their foreignness should be maintained and even highlighted section ii deals with interpretation and

considers such issues as uses of polyphony the relationship between painting and theater and representations of women section iii highlights performance issues such as music in modern performances of classical theater and the construction of stage character written by a highly respected group of british and american scholars and theater practitioners this book challenges the traditional divide between the academy and stage practitioners and between one theatrical culture and another

from the tony award and laurence olivier award winning former director of london s national theatre this is a fascinating candid eloquent memoir about his career directing theater producing films and opera and working closely with some of the world s most celebrated actors the list of nicholas hytner s accomplishments is long and distinguished as artistic director of london s national theatre from 2003 2015 he directed and produced a great number of their most popular and memorable plays and musicals many of which have come to broadway carousell richard bean s one man two guvnors david hare s stuff happens among them he directed both the london and broadway productions of miss saigon each of which ran for ten years he directed alan bennett s the madness of george iii on both stage and screen in short he is one of today s most successful and admired theatrical impresarios in balancing acts hytner gives us a detailed behind the scenes look at his creative process from reviving classic musicals and mastering shakespeare to commissioning new plays he shows theater making to be a necessarily collaborative exercise and he writes insightfully about the actors and playwrights he s worked with derek jacobi richard griffiths helen mirren maggie smith michael gambon harold pinter and tom stoppard among them with a cultural range that spans from the mikado to the lady in the van balancing acts is not only a memoir but a gathering of illuminating notes on the art of directing and a thoughtful meditation on the purpose of theater
