the victim's voice in the sexual misconduct crisis investigates how a victim's voice identity credibility and proof are challenged or established in the current sexual misconduct crisis using communication and rhetorical analysis gender studies and law and society perspectives mary schuster examines concerns such as victim impact statements offered in sentencing hearings of convicted offenders due process and title ix requirements in campus sexual assault investigations and laws and title vii standards governing workplace sexual harassment complaints schuster also analyzes the testimony offered in the 1991 and 2018 u s senate judiciary hearings regarding the supreme court nominations of clarence thomas and brett kavanaugh social movements such as me too and global activists efforts to challenge gender stereotypes and hierarchies this book argues that we cannot outlaw or legislate away sexual misconduct but must instead focus on cultural social and systemic changes in order to change the current climate moreover the author argues for zero tolerance for sexual misconduct but recommends a gradation of punishment or sanctions for offenders offering examples of successful educational and therapeutic efforts to alter misconceptions regarding sexual misconduct scholars

of gender studies communication legal studies and rhetoric will find this book particularly useful

while sexual harassment of women in the workplace has been discussed for decades it is still a pervasive problem this book looks at the history of that harassment from the 1600s to the early 1990s from long forgotten domestic servants in england of the 1600s to abused japanese textile workers of 1900 to anita hill in 1991 america coverage is worldwide with emphasis on the united states and the period 1800 to the present harassment affects women from all walks of life from unskilled to professional those in traditionally female jobs those in traditionally male jobs and all the rest harassment occurs in factories coal mines construction sites law offices dental offices government offices capitol hill and at every other work site so bad was it in some factories that women took to carrying knives for self protection women have put their economic existence on the line by striking over sexual harassment

the topic of sexual harassment is a real threat to society in spite of its downplaying by a large segment of society including the 42nd president of the united states this book presents analyses designed to help shed light on it and a bibliography sorted for ease of use

In 1964 as part of its landmark Civil Rights Act, Congress outlawed workplace discrimination on the basis of such personal attributes as sex, race, and religion. This provision, known as Title VII, laid a new legal foundation for women's rights at work. Though President Kennedy and other lawmakers expressed high hopes for Title VII, early attempts to enforce it were inconsistent in the absence of a consensus definition of sex equality in the law or society. Title VII's practical meaning was far from certain. The first history to foreground Title VII's sex provision, *Equality on Trial*, examines how the law's initial promise inspired a generation of Americans to dispatch expansive notions of sex equality, imagining new solidarities and building a broad class politics. These workers and activists engaged Title VII to generate a pivotal battle over the terms of democracy and the role of the state in all labor relationships. But the law's ambiguity also allowed for narrow conceptions of sex equality to take hold. Conservatives found ways to bend Title VII's possible meanings to their benefit, discovering that a narrow definition of sex equality allowed businesses to comply with the law without transforming basic workplace structures or ceding power to workers. These contests to fix the meaning of sex equality ultimately laid the legal and cultural foundation for the neoliberal work regimes that enabled some women to break the glass ceiling as employers lowered the floor for everyone else. Synthesizing the histories of work, social movements, and civil rights in the postwar United States, *Equality on Trial* recovers the range of protagonists whose struggles forged the contemporary meanings of feminism, fairness, and labor rights.
