now in paperback a timeless classic includes 8 200 songs in 818 lists for nine voice classifications indexed by composer title vocal range and publisher the complete work represents the living song repertoire of today drawn from recital programs recordings broadcasts telecasts and other sources and is comprised of part i coloratura lyric and dramatic soprano part ii mezzo soprano and contralto part iii lyric and dramatic tenor and part iv baritone and bass

this collection of essays on the interpretation of twenty two unusual concert pieces was assembled partly with a view to more imaginative program planning there are many composers who may have written only one or two masterpieces yet failed to leave a worthy oeuvre these sadly are often forgotten or overlooked when conductors assemble programs this compilation spans a little over a hundred years from the 19th and 20th centuries and all the works are colorful and attractive once again norman del mar brings his expertise in handling the orchestra to a wide variety of styles his infectious enthusiasm and broad knowledge make him an invaluable guide to the aspiring conductor the expert and the music loving listener the essays range from russia to spain from schoenberg to kodaly

from wolf to poulenc with such established favorites as the overture to la forza del destino with its unexpected tricky moments and the four sea interludes and passacaglia from peter grimes for which del mar offers suggestions from britten himself with whom he worked for many years

looking at one of the twentieth century s most notorious musical masterpieces john cage s concert for piano and orchestra examines cage s compositional process its infamous performance history and its influence on philosophical ideas of what music actually is

john ireland 1879 1962 was one of the most distinctive and distinguished of a generation of exceptional british composers that included vaughan williams gustav holst frank bridge and arnold bax they emerged in the decade before the first world war and in the inter war years produced a remarkable body of music in ireland s case his was not only the most popular british piano concerto of its time but he also composed a splendid repertoire of songs piano music chamber music and orchestral and choral scores this richly illustrated companion will be essential for all admirers of the composer not only for the performer pianist singer conductor but for the wider musical public record collectors and music historians academics and anyone interested in british music of the earlier twentieth century the author has drawn on his extensive research into ireland s life and letters over many years and in association with the john ireland charitable trust has not only commissioned a wide range of chapters from leading performers and writers of today but has brought together in one convenient format ireland s own writings on music the memories of his friends and students including britten moeran and arnell and a selection of important earlier articles the companion also includes a complete list of works and the most comprehensive discography of ireland ever compiled the accompanying cd contains historical recordings featuring the voice of john ireland with two of his broadcast talks

as well as otherwise unobtainable performances of ireland s music from the composer himself and from other well known performers of the past

provides quick and accurate data for program making teaching and research new ideas for performance or study will be found in the complete listing of standard composers including both popular and less familiar titles with brief evaluations

this book first published in 2000 examines the bbc s campaign to raise cultural awareness of british mass audiences in the early days of radio as a specific case it focuses on policies and plans behind transmissions of music by composers associated with arnold schoenberg s circle between 1922 when the bbc was founded and spring 1936 when edward clark a former schoenberg pupil and central figure in bbc music resigned from the corporation this study traces and analyses the bbc s attempts to manipulate critical and public responses to this repertory the book investigates three interrelated aspects of early bbc history policy decisions relating to contemporary music transmissions are examined to determine why precious broadcast time was devoted to this repertory early personnel structures are reconstructed to investigate the responsibilities attitudes and interests of those who influenced music broadcasting finally broadcasts of second viennese school works are examined in detail

since the publication of the london pianoforte school ed nicholas temperley twenty years ago research has proliferated in the area of music for the piano during the late eighteenth and nineteenth centuries and into developments in the musical life of london for a time the centre of piano manufacturing publishing and performance but none has focused on the piano exclusively within britain the eleven chapters in this volume explore major issues surrounding the instrument its performers and music within an expanded geographical context created by the spread

of the instrument and the growth of concert touring topics covered include the piano trade and how piano manufacturing affected a major provincial town the reception of bach s well tempered clavier and clementi s gradus ad parnassum during the nineteenth century the shift from composer pianists to pianist interpreters in the first half of the century that triggered crucial changes in piano performance and concert structure the growth of musical life in the peripheries outside major musical centres the pianist as advocate for contemporary composers as well as for historical repertory the status of british pianists both in relation to foreigners on tour in britain and as welcomed star performers in outposts of the empire marketing forces that had an impact on piano sales concerts and piano careers leading virtuosos writers and critics the important role played by women pianists and the development of the recording industry bringing the volume into the early twentieth century

filling a significant gap in current scholarship the fourteen original essays that make up this volume individually and collectively reflect on the relationship between music and orientalism in the british empire over the course of the long nineteenth century the book is in four themed sections portrayal of the east traces the routes from encounter to representation and restores the orient to its rightful place in histories of orientalism interpreting concert music looks at one of the principal forms in which orientalism could be brought to an eager and largely receptive yet

sometimes resistant mass market words and music investigates the confluence of musical and orientalist themes in different genres of writing including criticism fiction and travel writing finally the orientalist stage discusses crucial sites of orientalist representation music theatre and opera as well as tracing similar phenomena in twentieth century hindi cinema these final chapters examine the rendering of the east as unachievable and unrecognizable for the consuming gaze of the western spectator

performing arts in changing societies is a detailed exploration of genre development within the fields of dance theatre and opera in selected european countries during the decades before and after 1800 an introductory chapter outlines the theoretical and ideological background of genre thinking in europe starting from antiquity a further fourteen chapters cover the performing genres as they developed in england france germany and austria and follow the dissemination and adaptation of the corresponding genres in minor and major cities in the nordic countries with a strong emphasis on the role that pragmatic and contextual factors had in defining genres the book examines such subjects as the dancing masters in christiania oslo circa 1800 the repertory and travels of an itinerant acrobat and his wife in norway in the 1760s and the influence of enlightenment ideas on bourgeois drama in denmark including detailed analyses in the light of material political and social factors this is a valuable resource for scholars and researchers in the fields of musicology opera studies and theatre and performance studies

following their entry into austria and the sudetenland in the late 1930s the germans attempted to impose a policy of cultural imperialism on the countries they went on to occupy during world war ii almost all music institutions in the occupied lands came under direct german control or were subject to severe scrutiny and censorship the prime objective being to change the musical fabric of these nations and force them to submit to the strictures of nazi ideology this pioneering collection of essays is the first in the english language to look in more detail at the musical consequences of german occupation during a dark period in european history it embraces a wide range of issues presenting case studies involving musical activity in a number of occupied european cities as well as in countries that were part of the axis or had established close diplomatic relations with germany the wartime careers and creative outputs of individual musicians who were faced with the dilemma of either complying with or resisting the impositions of the occupiers are explored in addition there is some reflection on the post war implications of german occupation for the musical environment in europe music under german occupation is written for all music lovers students professionals and academics who have particular interests in 20th century music and or the vicissitudes of european cultural life during world war ii

cathy berberian 1925 1983 was a vocal performance artist singer and composer who pioneered a way of composing with the voice in the musical worlds of europe north america and beyond as a modernist muse for many avant garde composers cathy berberian went on to embody the principles of postmodern thinking in her work through vocality she re defined the limits of composition and challenged theories of the authorship of the musical score this volume celebrates her unorthodox path through musical landscapes including her approach to performance practice gender performativity vocal pedagogy and the culturally determined borders of art music the concert stage the popular lp and the opera industry of her times the collection features primary documentation some published in english for the first time of berberian s engagement with the philosophy of voice new music early music pop jazz vocal experimentation and technology that has come to influence the next generation of singers such as theo bleckmann susan botti joan la barbara rinde eckert meredith monk carol plantamura candace smith and pamela z hence this timely anthology marks an end to the long period of silence about cathy berberian s championing of a radical rethinking of the musical past through a reclaiming of the voice as a multifaceted phenomenon with a foreword by susan mcclary
