

# Aztec

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food historian emma kay tells the story of our centuries old relationship with herbs from herbalists of old to contemporary cooking this book reveals the magical and medicinal properties of your favourite plants in colorful compelling detail at one time every village in britain had a herbalist a history of herbalism investigates the lives of women and men who used herbs to administer treatment and knew the benefit of each meet dr richard shephard of preston who cultivated angelica on his estate in the eighteenth century for the sick and injured or nicholas culpeper a botanist who catalogued the pharmaceutical benefits of herbs for early literary society but herbs were not only medicinal countless cultures and beliefs as far back as prehistoric times incorporated herbs into their practices paganism witchcraft religion and even astrology take a walk through a medieval physick garden or early britain and learn the ancient rituals to fend off evil powers protect or bewitch or even attract a lover the wake of modern medicine saw a shift away from herbal treatments with rituals and spells shrouded with

superstition as the years wore on the author reveals how herbs became more culinary rather than medicinal including accounts of recent trends for herbal remedies as lockdown and the pandemic leads us to focus more on our health and wellbeing

mexico of five centuries ago was witness to one of the most momentous encounters between human societies when a group of spaniards led by hernando cort s joined forces with tens of thousands of mesoamerican allies to topple the mighty aztec empire it served as a template for the forging of much of latin america and began the globalized world we inhabit today this violent encounter and the new colonial order it created a new spain was millennia in the making with independent cultural developments on both sides of the atlantic and their fateful entanglement during the pivotal aztec spanish war of 1519 1521 collision of worlds provides a deep history of this encounter with an archaeological lens one that considers depth in the richly layered cultures of mexico and spain like the depths that archaeologists reveal through excavation to chart early layers of human history it offers a unique perspective on the encounter through its temporal depth and focus on the physical world of places and things their similarities and differences in trans atlantic perspective and their interweaving in an encounter characterized by conquest and colonialism but also active agency and resilience on the part of native peoples

this very short introduction employs the disciplines of history religious studies and anthropology as it illuminates the complexities of aztec life readers meet a people highly skilled in sculpture astronomy city planning poetry and philosophy who were also profoundly committed to cosmic regeneration through the thrust of the ceremonial knife and through warfare david carrasco looks beyond spanish accounts that have colored much of the western narrative to let aztec voices speak about their origin stories the cosmic significance of their capital city their methods of child rearing and the contributions women made to daily life and the empire carrasco discusses the arrival of the spaniards contrasts aztec mythical traditions about the origins of their city with actual urban life in mesoamerica and outlines the rise of the aztec empire he also explores aztec religion which provided both justification for and alternatives to warfare sacrifice and imperialism and he sheds light on aztec poetry philosophy painting and especially monumental sculpture and architecture he concludes by looking at how the aztecs have been portrayed in western thought art film and literature as well as in latino culture and arts
