

Bliss A Novel

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for thirty nine years harry joy has been the quintessential good guy but one morning harry has a heart attack on his suburban front lawn and for the space of nine minutes he becomes a dead guy and although he is resuscitated he will never be the same for as peter carey makes abundantly clear in this darkly funny novel death is sometimes a necessary prelude to real life part the wizard of oz part dante s inferno and part australian book of the dead bliss is a triumph of uninhibited storytelling from a writer of extravagan gifts

set in tel aviv and paris a powerful story of love friendship regret and war as current as today s headlines ronit matalon s fiction has been praised as haunting

inventive refreshingly daring now in a graceful illuminating second novel she tells a provocative story of two loves two partings two worlds two women ofra and sarah when ofra is called from tel aviv to france to attend the funeral of her beloved cousin michel she escapes a life lived vicariously through sarah her oldest friend a photographer and political activist in paris ofra enters the embrace of her french family and the intimate world of domestic life while sarah in tel aviv drifts even farther from her husband udi drawn to a palestinian nationalist she takes on the fight for a girl from gaza who has been injured by an israeli bullet and needs medical treatment that can only be had inside israel as sarah adopts the cause with near destructive zeal and pledges herself to the suffering of others her own child goes untended with dreadful consequences for all against a backdrop of national conflict bliss confronts the terrible dilemma of choosing between one s desires and one s beliefs between grand ideological commitment and the more mundane claims of family with vivid penetrating prose matalon has delivered a large and resonant work that is as artful as it is affecting

shay mitchell star of abc family s 1 rated show pretty little liars and best friend michaela blaney team up to write this sharp sexy and entertaining romp through the imperfect world of 21 year old bffs sophia demi and leandra sophia marcus 21 has already mapped out every aspect of her glamorous life as a hollywood actor on her vision board but her life right now in toronto is anything but exciting attending fruitless auditions during the day and working at a douche y club at night sophia is starting to feel like she s going nowhere slowly demi michael s sophia s best friend didn t go to college after high school short of ideas for her own future she puts her energy into building the perfect relationship with an older man and when that relationship crashes and burns demi is left to pick up the pieces sophia s friend and demi s frenemy leandra hunting doesn t give a crap about hard work or a loving relationship she has other plans for her future after college graduation leandra sets out to travel the world in the yachts planes and limos of ridiculously wealthy men will any of them be able to show her what love really means if she can take off her chanel sunglasses long enough to see it set in the exotic intoxicating worlds of hollywood thailand and london shay mitchell and michaela blaney s bliss paints a relatable portrait of life in your early twenties with equal parts optimism and fear hope and disappointment expectation and reality it s the age of uncertainty when you can count on nothing but if you re lucky enough to have one truly great friend you can survive just about anything

peter carey is one of australia s finest creative writers much admired by both literary critics and a worldwide reading public while academia has been quick to see his fictions as exemplars of postcolonial and postmodern writing strategies his general readership has been captivated by his deadpan sense of humour his quirky characters the outlandish settings and the grotesqueries of his intricate plots after three decades of prolific writing and multiple award winning carey stands out in the world of australian letters as designated heir to patrick white fabulating beauty pays tribute to carey s literary achievement it brings together the voices of many of the most renowned carey critics in twenty essays sixteen commissioned especially for this volume an interview with the author as well as the most extensive bibliography of carey criticism to date the studies represent a wide range of current perspectives on the writer s fictions contributors focus on issues as diverse as the writer s biography his use of architectural metaphors his interrogation of narrative structures such as myths and cultural master plots intertextual strategies concepts of sacredness and references to the christian tradition and his strategies of rewriting history amidst predictions of the imminent death of postist theory the essays all attest to the ongoing relevance of the critical parameters framed by postmodernism and postcolonialism

though often thought of as rivals ralph ellison james baldwin and amiri baraka shared a range of interests especially a passion for music jazz in particular was a decisive influence on their thinking and as the shadow and the act reveals they drew on their insights into the creative process of improvisation to analyze race and politics in the civil rights era in this inspired study walton m muyumba situates them as a jazz trio demonstrating how ellison baraka and baldwin s individual works form a series of calls and responses with each other muyumba connects their writings on jazz to the philosophical tradition of pragmatism particularly its support for more freedom for individuals and more democratic societies he examines the way they responded to and elaborated on that lineage showing how they significantly broadened it by addressing the african american experience especially its aesthetics ultimately muyumba contends the trio enacted pragmatist principles by effectively communicating the social and political benefits of african americans fully entering society thereby compelling america to move closer to its democratic ideals

winner of the a k ramanujan prize for annotated translation this is a translation of a historically important bengali novel published in 1882 chatterji s anandamath helped create the atmosphere and the symbolism for the nationalist movement leading to indian independence in 1947 it contains the famous hymn vande mataram i revere the mother which has become india s official national song set in bengal at the time of the famine of 1770 the novel reflects tensions and oppositions within indian culture between hindus and muslims ruler and ruled indigenous people and foreign overlords jungle and town aryan and non aryan celibacy and sexuality it is both a political and a religious work by recreating the past of bengal chatterji hoped to create a new present that involved a new interpretation of the past julius lipner not only provides the first complete and satisfactory english translation of this important work but supplies an extensive introduction contextualizing the novel and its cultural and political history also included are notes offering the bengali or sanskrit terms for certain words as well as explanatory notes for the specialized lay reader or scholar

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
