authority the screening effort can be expedited by pre planning including the training of screeners and careful overall management of the process completion of the data collection form in the field begins with identifying the primary structural lateral load resisting system and structural materials of the building basic structural hazard scores for various building types are provided on the form and the screener circles the appropriate one for many buildings viewed only from the exterior this important decision requires the screener to be trained and experienced in building construction the procedure presented in this handbook is meant to be the preliminary screening phase of a multi phase procedure for identifying potentially hazardous buildings buildings identified by this procedure must be analyzed in more detail by an experienced seismic design professional because rapid visual screening is designed to be performed from the street with interior inspection not always possible hazardous details will not always be visible and seismically hazardous buildings may not be identified as such conversely buildings initially identified as potentially hazardous by rvs may prove to be adequate
