discrimination this book redresses that exclusion by shining a light on the harms of hate
experienced by gypsies and travellers in the uk in doing so james explores how hate
permeates all aspects of their lives and identifies the hate crimes incidents and speech
that they are subject to it goes on to explore how hate against gypsies and travellers

occurs as discrimination social exclusion and criminalisation and how that hate is embedded within the language and practice of neoliberal capitalism this book provides new insights to critical criminology and ways of understanding hate by using the critical hate studies perspective to gain a full appreciation of the harms of hate as a consequence of this the book is able to do justice to gypsies and travellers experiences of hate by extrapolating how harms manifest and the impact they have on gypsies and travellers social and personal identities the book explains and acknowledges how hate harms imbue gypsies and travellers daily lives including common events of serious abuse and assault regular ill treatment in provision of services and everyday micro aggressions it argues hate experienced by gypsies and travellers can only be fully recognised through an analysis of the neoliberal capitalist context within which it occurs and the harmful subjective experience it engenders the author s expertise in this area having carried out research with gypsies and travellers for 25 years underpins the book with excellent empirical knowledge and research informed discussion

what happens when two deeply held american values freedom of expression and freedom from discrimination clash in any well established democratic society people have the right to free speech as well as the right to equal treatment and protection under the law but when one person s speech harms another person on the basis of race ethnicity religion gender or sexual orientation it may qualify as hate speech and be subject to restriction cortese argues that restricting hate speech does not violate the guiding principle behind the first amendment but he is not eager to see more lawsuits

effective restriction he asserts should not focus on litigation but on speech codes and moral education is there a limit to freedom of expression in a democracy and if so where should the line be drawn in attempting to answer that question cortese makes a solid case for paying attention to context and common sense some hate speech is more reprehensible than others not all discriminatory statements are equally serious there is a discernible difference between an offensive remark and an incitement to commit murder there is also a fundamental distinction between intentional and unintentional discrimination in this book cortese rethinks some of the issues that have been silenced in ways harmful to many especially those that have been brutalized oppressed manipulated dominated segregated and disadvantaged we should recognize the grave injuries inflicted by hate speech and the potential tensions between legal solutions to those injuries and the first amendment we must push for moral education educational speech codes and when necessary a formal legal structural response to hate speech in order to reinforce our commitment to tolerance as a value

this book presents both a new theoretical framework for the criminalisation of hate referred to as law as social justice liberalism and a comprehensive analysis of hate crime laws that have been enacted globally the book begins by reflecting back on 30 years of theorisation on hate crime laws arguing that there has been a failure to adequately capture the distinct harms of hate based criminal conduct within legal frameworks the book posits that liberal societies interested in advancing social equality ought to expand conventional paradigms of harm used in criminal law by comprehending hate based conduct as a form of social injustice drawing on the work of iris young the book sets out a comprehensive analysis of the harms of hate crime as a form of group based oppression and uses this to set out criteria for the inclusion of protected characteristics under legislation the second half of the book presents findings from a comparative study of hate crime laws enacted in 190 different legal jurisdictions this includes a new taxonomy of types models and legal tests used by legislatures to capture the myriad forms of hate based criminal conduct that occur globally further evaluation of case law and empirical research on the application of these diverging legislative approaches is used to provide recommendations on how legislators ought to construct hate crime laws the book completes its analysis of law as social justice liberalism by synthesising law punishment and restorative justice as a means of ensuring that liberal systems of justice are more firmly anchored to the advancement of social justice

this timely book critically addresses the intersection between power politics and emotions challenging traditional dichotomies which counterpose rationalist to non rationalist epistemologies it offers a sustained argument for a more complete and integrated rationalism and helps us understand emotions in contemporary social and

political life

hate speech has been a societal problem for many years and has seen a resurgence recently alongside political divisiveness and technologies that ease and accelerate the spread of messages methods to protect individuals and groups from hate speech have eluded lawmakers as the call for restrictions or bans on such speech are confronted by claims of first amendment protection problematic speech the argument goes should be confronted by more speech rather than by restriction debate over the extent of first amendment protection is based on two bodies of law the practical precedent determined by the supreme court and the theoretical framework of first amendment jurisprudence in hate speech is not free the case against constitutional protection w wat hopkins argues that the prevailing thought that hate is protected by both case law and theory is incorrect within the supreme court s established hierarchy of speech protection hate speech falls to the lowest level deserving no protection as it does not advance ideas containing social value ultimately the supreme court s cases addressing protected and unprotected speech set forth a clear rationale for excommunicating hate speech from first amendment protection
