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globalization is often discussed in terms of its ecological ramifications yet while ecological imbalance is today one of the greatest threats to mankind globalization is also a reality that is here to stay the volume therefore seeks to address how globalizing and environmental interests can be reconciled the essays in this volume state that globalization can work both in favour of and against the environment the major issues discussed in this topical volume are how globalization can be used to promote environmental reforms the role of individuals private organizations and governments in keeping environmental degradation in check and in promoting environmental reform globalization and ecological inequality women the environment and globalization changing nature of environmental movements overpopulation and the ecology the relation between the ecology and the economy and the effects of global climate changes

politically the world is composed of states environmentally the world is made up of ecosystems this disconnection between ecological and political systems makes addressing environmental issues at the global level both more difficult and more necessary this volume examines how we should set about addressing the problems that face the environment internationally the field of international environmental politics draws on a variety of academic traditions it uses international relations theory to look at the concerns and actions of states but it also uses variety of new perspectives to explain issues that are unique to the study of the environment elizabeth desombre explores four important approaches to the field international environmental cooperation the relationship between the environment and security the issues of science uncertainty and risk and the role of non state actors she explores these approaches with the help of case studies on specific problems facing the global environment focusing in particular on ozone depletion and global climate change the politics of whaling the protection of amazonian biodiversity and acid rain in europe and north america

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proponents of globalization argue that it protects the global environment from degradation and promotes worldwide sustainable economic growth while opponents argue the exact opposite examining the local national and international impacts of globalization the handbook of globalization and the environment explores strategies and solutions that support healthy economic growth protect the environment and create a more equitable world the book sets the stage with coverage of global environmental issues and policies it explores international sustainable development the evolution of global warming policy transborder air pollution desertification space and the global environment and human right to water building on this foundation the editors discuss global environmental organizations and institutions with coverage of the un s role in globalization the trade environment nexus the emergence of ngos and an analysis of the state of global environmental knowledge and awareness from an international and comparative perspective emphasizing the effects of increasingly integrated global economy on the environment and society the book examines environmental management and accountability it addresses green procurement provides an overview of u s environmental regulation and the current range of voluntary and mandatory pollution prevention mechanisms in use explores a two pronged approach to establishing a sustainable procurement model and examines a collaborative community based approach to environmental regulatory compliance the book concludes with an analysis of controversial issues such as eco terrorism north south disputes environmental justice the promotion of economic growth through globalization in less developed countries and the ability of scientists to communicate ideas so that policy makers can use science in decision making

as a result of global dynamics the increasing interconnection of people and places innovations in global environmental governance have altered the role of cities in shaping the future of the planet this book is a timely study of the importance of these social transformations in our increasingly global and increasingly urban world through analysis of transnational municipal networks such as metropolis and the c40 cities climate leadership group sofie bouteligier s innovative study examines theories of the network society and global cities from a global ecology perspective

through direct observation and interviews and using two types of city networks that have been treated separately in the literature she discovers the structure and logic pertaining to office networks of environmental non governmental organizations and environmental consultancy firms in doing so she incisively demonstrates the ways in which cities fulfill the role of strategic sites of global environmental governance concentrating knowledge infrastructure and institutions vital to the function of transnational actors

this volume provides a comprehensive overview of the interactions and feedbacks between urbanization and global environmental change a key focus is the examination of how urbanization influences global environmental change and how global environmental change in turn influences urbanization processes it has four thematic foci theme 1 addresses the pathways through which urbanization drives global environmental change theme 2 addresses the pathways through which global environmental change affects the urban system theme 3 addresses the interactions and responses within the urban system in response to global environmental change theme 4 centers on critical emerging research

nation states are failing to resolve global problems that transcend the abilities of single governments or even groups of governments to address this book argues that this dilemma is not as new as is sometimes claimed it offers crucial context and even lessons for present day debates about resolving the most urgent environmental problems

all serious environmental threats are now international in scope and more than one thousand international environmental agreements already exist yet the prospects for international cooperation leading to the management of impacts on the planet remain grim the global environment meets the need for an authoritative assessment of the state of international environmental institutions laws and policies at the end of the 20th century the book examines disagreements over the meaning of sustainable development problems inherent in implementing environmental policies and the conflict over the exclusion of developing countries from the kyoto protocol it discusses the profound trade offs that may be required the role of international financial interests in promoting incompatible forms of development and analyses international environmental institutions law and policy and sustainable development

emerging economies have fundamentally transformed global environmental politics led by china and india they increasingly make or break international negotiations which now require agreement among a large number of governments with widely varied preferences emerging economies which still suffer from widespread poverty and frequently struggle with policy implementation often feel that western led initiatives neglect their needs what does the global environmental policy landscape look like in the age of a rising global south this book explains why emerging economies have come to dominate global environmental politics and examines the implications for future international cooperation johannes urpelainen shows that emerging economies continue to prioritize economic growth and often have limited institutional capacity to contain the environmental destruction that it causes however he argues despite barriers to cooperation innovative bargaining and institutional design offer a way forward bottom up agreements that respect national sovereignty and invest in capacity building hold more promise than traditional top down treaties with binding commitments the book features detailed discussions of attempts to address hazardous chemicals loss of biodiversity and climate change a comparative analysis of china and india and case studies of nine other emerging economies around the world global environmental politics is an essential forward looking overview of today's most pressing international issue

global environmental politics provides a fully up to date and comprehensive introduction to the most important issues dominating this fast moving

field going beyond the issue of climate change the textbook also introduces students to the pressing issues of desertification trade in hazardous waste biodiversity protection whaling acid rain ozone depletion water consumption and over fishing importantly the authors pay particular attention to the interactions between environmental politics and other governance issues such as gender trade development health agriculture and security

there is persuasive evidence suggesting we are on the brink of human induced ecological disaster that could change life on earth as we know it there is also a general consensus among scientists about the pace and extent of global ecological decay including a realisation that humans are central to causing the global socio ecological crisis this new epoch has been called the anthropocene considering the many benefits that constitutional environmental protection holds out in domestic legal orders it is likely that a constitutionalised form of global environmental law and governance would be better able to counter the myriad exigencies of the anthropocene this book seeks to answer this central question from the perspective of the anthropocene what is environmental constitutionalism and how could it be extrapolated to formulate a global framework in answering this question this book offers the first systematic conceptual framework for global environmental constitutionalism in the epoch of the anthropocene

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
