making them indispensable They are not set off by commas Example The student who cheated on the exam failed the course Removing who cheated on the exam changes the meaning entirely Its not just any student who failed but specifically the one who cheated B Nonrestrictive Clauses These clauses add extra information about the noun they modify but this information is not essential to the sentences core meaning They are set off by commas Example My dog who is a golden retriever loves to play fetch The information about the dogs breed is extra the sentences core meaning My dog loves to play fetch
