this collection of ten critical essays is the first scholarly criticism of haiku by sonia sanchez who has exemplified herself for six decades as a major figure in the black arts movement a central activist in civil rights and women s movements and an internationally known writer in american literature sanchez s haiku as an integral and prominent part of contemporary african american poetry have expressed not only her ideas of nature beauty and harmony but also her aesthetic experience of music culture and love aesthetically this experience reflects a poetic mind which has helped the poet to shape or reimage her poetic spirit

the poetry of sonia sanchez is full of power and yet always clean and uncluttered it makes you wish you had thought those thoughts felt those emotions and above all expressed them so effortlessly and so well chinua achebe only a poet with an innocent heart can exorcise so much pain with so much beauty isabel allende a lion in literature s forest maya angelou a dazzling selection of poems from one of the most beloved american poets whose distinctive verse resonates around the globe few poets in history have possessed the irrepressible humanity and abundant positivity that characterise sonia sanchez s astonishing body of work energetic infectious and rich with sonic exuberance sanchez s poems have radically

transformed the direction of american poetry over the past six decades and have been an inspiration to readers around the world whether it s her iconic haiku rhythmic ballads or devastating elegies sanchez s lyric luminous and lovely as chandeliers thrums with a profound generosity and an international consciousness rendering all of life s agony and ecstasy this volume pulls from across sanchez s diverse repertoire to showcase the multiplicities of the poet s voice the profound and personal the firebrand and socially conscious the playful and formally dextrous and the musical to celebrate her as one of the world s most skilled and versatile poets of the past half century

winner gish prize for lifetime achievement a representative collection of the life work of the much honored poet and a founder of the black arts movement spanning the 4 decades of her literary career gathering highlights from all of sonia sanchez s poetry this compilation is sure to inspire love and community engagement among her legions of fans beginning with her earliest work including poems from her first volume homecoming 1969 through to 2019 the poet has collected her favorite work in all forms of verse from haiku to excerpts from book length narratives her lifelong dedication to the causes of black liberation social equality and women s rights is evident throughout as is her special attention to youth in poems addressed to children and young adults as maya angelou so aptly put it sonia sanchez is a lion in literature s forest when she writes she roars and when she sleeps other creatures walk gingerly

haiku other arts and literary disciplines investigates the genesis and development of haiku in japan and determines the relationships between haiku and other arts such as essay writing painting and music as well as the backgrounds of haiku such as literary movements philosophies and religions that underlie haiku composition by analyzing the poets who played major roles in the development of haiku and its related genres these essays illustrate how japanese haiku poets and american writers such as emerson and whitman were inspired by nature especially its beautiful scenes and seasonal changes western poets had a demonstrated affinity for japanese haiku which bled over into other art mediums as these chapters discuss

in 1965 dudley f randall founded the broadside press a company devoted to publishing distributing and promoting the works of black poets and writers in so doing he became a major player in the civil rights movement hundreds of black writers were given an outlet for their work and for their calls for equality and black identity though broadside was established on a minimal budget randall s unique skills made the press successful he was trained as a librarian and had spent decades studying and writing poetry most importantly randall was totally committed to the advancement of black literature the famous and relatively unknown sought out broadside including such writers as gwendolyn brooks margaret walker mae jackson lance jeffers etheridge knight sonia sanchez nikki giovanni audre lorde and sterling d plumpp his story is one of battling to promote black identity and equality through literature and thus lifting the cultural lives of all americans

the essays in this collection address the relationship between children and cultural memory in texts both for and about young people the collection overall is concerned with how cultural memory is shaped contested forgotten recovered and re circulated sometimes in opposition to dominant national narratives and often for the benefit of young readers who are assumed not to possess any prior cultural memory from the innovative development of school libraries in the 1920s to the role of utopianism in fixing cultural memory for teen readers it provides a critical look into children and ideologies of childhood as they are represented in a broad spectrum of texts including film poetry literature and architecture from canada the united states japan germany britain india and spain these cultural forms collaborate to shape ideas and values in turn contributing to dominant discourses about national

and global citizenship the essays included in the collection imply that childhood is an oft imagined idealist construction based in large part on participation identity and perception childhood is invisible and tangible exciting and intriguing and at times elusive even as cultural and literary artifacts recreate it children and cultural memory in texts of childhood is a valuable resource for scholars of children s literature and culture readers interested in childhood and ideology and those working in the fields of diaspora and postcolonial studies

there are deep black nationalist roots for many of the images and ideologies of contemporary racial justice efforts this collection reconsiders the black aesthetic and the revolutionary art of the black arts movement bam forging connections between the recent past and contemporary social justice activism focusing on black literary and visual art of the black arts movement this collection highlights artists whose work diverged from narrow definitions of the black aesthetic and black nationalism adding to the reanimation of discourses surrounding bam this collection comes at a time when today s racial justice efforts are mining earlier eras for their iconography ideology and implementation as numerous contemporary activists ground their work in the legacies of mid twentieth century activism and adopt many of the grassroots techniques it fostered this collection remembers and re envisions the art that both supported and shaped that earlier era it furthers contemporary conversations by exploring bam s implications for cultural and literary studies and its legacy for current social justice work and the multiple arts that support it

beginning with a deceptively simple question what do we mean when we designate behaviors values or forms of expression as black evie shockley s renegade poetics teases out the more complex and nuanced possibilities the concept has long encompassed she redefines black aesthetics descriptively resituating innovative poetry that has been marginalized because it was not recognizably black and avant garde poetry dismissed because it was back cover

this soul reading of the gospel is influenced by three elements analytical archetypal psychology which reorients psychology to the study of the soul african american cultural experience which is often characterized as soul and reader response criticism which emphasizes that the reading of a text is shaped by the reader s psychological and social location after a brief methodological discussion portions of the fourth gospel are read soulfully book jacket

the feminist avant garde in american poetry offers a historical and theoretical account of avant garde women poets in america from the 1910s through the 1990s and asserts an alternative tradition to the predominantly male dominated avant garde movements elisabeth frost argues that this alternative lineage distinguishes itself by its feminism and its ambivalence toward existing avant garde projects she also thoroughly explores feminist avant garde poets debts and contributions to their male counterparts

by an expert contributor and provides a brief biography a discussion of major works a survey of the author's critical reception and primary and secondary bibliographies literature students will value this book for its exploration of african american literature while social studies students will appreciate its examination of social issues through literature african american women writers have made an enormous contribution to our culture many of these authors wrote during the harlem renaissance a particularly vital time in african american arts and letters while others have been especially active since the 1970s an era in which works by african american women are adapted into films and are widely read in book clubs literature by african american women is important for its aesthetic qualities and it also illuminates the social issues which these authors have confronted this book conveniently surveys the lives and works of african american women writers included are alphabetically arranged entries on more than 150 african american women novelists poets playwrights short fiction writers autobiographers essayists and influential scholars some of these figures such as toni morrison and gloria naylor are among the most popular authors writing today while others have been largely neglected or are recently emerging each entry provides a biography a discussion of major works a survey of the writer's critical reception and primary and secondary bibliographies the encyclopedia closes with a selected general bibliography students and general readers will welcome this guide to the rich achievement of african american women literature students will value its exploration of the works of these writers while social studies students will appreciate its examination of the social issues these women confront in their works
