widely regarded as america s most important chief justice john marshall influenced our constitutional political and economic development as much as any american he handed down landmark decisions on judicial review federal state relations contracts corporations and commercial regulation during a thirty four year tenure that encompassed five presidencies a second war of independence the demise of the first american party system and the advent of jacksonianism and market capitalism this is the first interpretive study of marshall s early life that emphasizes the formative influences on him before he joined the court by that time his character and attitudes were fully formed through his childhood in the virginia gentry his service in the state militia and continental army and his work as a prominent lawyer a federalist and a diplomat drawing heavily on marshall s own writings this study views his pre supreme court life as a cumulative experience that formed the identity and value system that he brought to bear on his experiences as chief justice robarge examines marshall s social and political education in the unique milieu of late 18th century virginia for its own intrinsic interest as well as for its relationship to his profound contribution to the court the events and situations that shaped marshall s personality and attitudes directly influenced his leadership style they also had a deep impact upon his efforts to establish an independent judiciary to unify the nation through territorial expansion and a legal common market and to revive the moribund federalist party as a balance to the dominant republicans led by the cousin he detested thomas jefferson

by the time of the american revolution the college of william and mary was already into its eighth decade as the academic source of what the new nation would become and how it would relate to the larger world its land had been surveyed by george washington and its first honorary degree had been given to ben franklin it would go on to educate two signers of the declaration of independence three american presidents and three justices of the supreme court chartered by british royalty in 1693 the college retains that connection to its roots into the 21st century remarkably through history the college of william and mary was and remains a public university one of 16 in the commonwealth of virginia at a time in american history when the 18th century thought and practice of thomas jefferson has become part of the contemporary conversation the college from which he graduated in 1762 continues to pursue his simple notion that worth and genius be sought from every condition of life

volume one presents documents that establish the structure of the supreme court and recount the official record of the court s activity during its first decade it serves as an introduction and reference tool for the subsequent volumes in the series

george washingtons inauguration in april 1789 marked the beginning of government under the new united states constitution what few americans realize is that there had been a fully functioning national government prior to 1789 it was called the continental congress and it was in every respect the first american republic 1774 1789 it began on september 5 1774 when elected delegates from eleven of the american colonies first assembled in philadelphia surprisingly that first american republic is most often dismissed in textbooks and popular history as a failed attempt at self government and yet it was during that fifteen year period that the united states won the war against the strongest empire on earth established organized government as far west as the mississippi river built alliances with some of the great powers of europe and transformed thirteen separate entities into a national confederation when the continental congress initially met in 1774 its very first order of business was to elect one of its own members to serve as president he functioned as head of state much as the presidents of germany and italy do today he signed all official documents received all foreign visitors and represented the emerging nation at official events and through extensive correspondence while congress retained all other executive legislative

and judicial functions the president even presided over its deliberations eventually a house carriage and servants were provided for the president as a sign of national pride and respect in all fourteen distinguished individuals were chosen by their peers for this unique and awesome responsibility they were the giants of their age men of power wealth and experience who often led their new nation through extremely difficult days largely on the strength of their character for far too long they have been lost to history this is their story

people with only a slight interest in history will enjoy these fascinating short and easy to understand stories serious history buffs will like these lesser known episodes not the stories we've heard a million times for example try to find anyone who knows about the attempted slave insurrection in Fairfax County Virginia with Mary Lincoln's spending habits who knew that Abraham Lincoln actually saved an enormous percentage of his presidential salary a slave honored in Virginia with a monument the history of Lee Highway which opened with great fanfare in 1923 as a 3 000 mile road from Washington DC to San Diego a story about the Little River Turnpike the second oldest turnpike in America built partly by slaves and captured Hessian soldiers you'll read about two Civil War ships that collided in the Potomac River victims included wounded soldiers wives and one soldier's six year old son you'll read a great account of the massive Civil War corruption you'll learn about the disastrous condition of the Treasury sound familiar during the Revolutionary War the government tried everything including a lottery to get the country afloat in a sea of red ink but the most fascinating story may be about the Revolutionary War soldier who faked his own desertion to defect to the enemy with the highly secretive mission of going behind enemy lines to capture and return for trial the worst traitor in American history Benedict Arnold but you never heard of this story there are many other stories in this eclectic heavily researched manuscript there's a story about the Christmas Truce in World War One about long forgotten holidays in Virginia about the retrocession which sent an area of Washington back to Virginia in 1846 and about the impeachment of a Supreme Court Justice it happened only once and more

political developments in georgia have always been baffling to those who did not live there this work picks up the story of the evolution of georgia political parties where the author left it in his first book politics on the periphery factions and parties in georgia 1783 1806 1986 carrying the story through 1845 by which date parties in georgia actually mirrored those at the national level it is a complicated story involving among other things the legacy of the yazoo land fraud the development of political parties on the national level and especially the presence of the creek and cherokee tribes in georgia during a period when white georgians were bent on expanding the culture of cotton it is an unlovely story but by the mid 1840s parties in georgia finally resembled those in other parts of the nation though if one looked closely at their principles questions remained
