the problem this project attempts to solve is to develop a workable moral education in light of the clash between religious forms of moral education and u s supreme court decisions concerning them the concept of story and storytelling has been suggested as a unifying focus for disparate prescriptions for moral education several recent approaches to moral storytelling have been proposed the approaches of william bennett nel noddings and herbert kohl are among those which have attempted to combine moral education and storytelling within the last decade bennett is identified with other theorists whose primary concern is the moral content of a story noddings is identified as a process theorist whose primary concern is the process of moral storytelling not the content kohl is identified as a reflection theorist whose approach challenges tradition in the hope of creating a more moral society each one of these three approaches attempts to provide a comprehensive program of moral education but they fall short of that goal the purpose of this project then is to construct a storytelling moral education program that improves upon earlier approaches using the three levels of moral thinking posited by r m hare a three level approach to moral storytelling is proposed the intuitive critical and meta ethical levels of moral thinking that hare refers to are used to frame a new three level approach to moral storytelling the three level approach combines content process and reflection into a unified prescription for moral education thus a more comprehensive plan for moral education through storytelling is developed one that respects traditional forms of moral education while remaining within the parameters set by the u s supreme court

postmodernism's critics often accuse the movement of being dangerously amoral because of its apparent wariness of concepts such as truth ethics and justice stories of the middle space explores the possibility of postmodernism with a conscience and examines a variety of british and canadian postmodern fiction to show how twentieth century critical theory can be brought into fruitful dialogue with a faith based perspective highlighting the wide variety of ethical

concerns considered by writers such as timothy findley thomas king carol shields julian barnes a s byatt and salman rushdie deborah bowen makes the case for a new category of postmodern realism and shows how contemporary stories about the real and the good are constructed applying theoretical insights from emmanuel levinas and mikhail bakhtin bowen investigates categories of postmodern realism such as magic realism parody and metafiction while laying the groundwork for christian readings of a medium that is often perceived as largely irreligious an illuminating study of well known contemporary writers stories of the middle space is a critically nuanced and methodologically innovative work that reads the postmodern from a faith based perspectives to create new literary insights deborah bowen addresses the ethical concerns of a wide variety of postmodern fiction from a faith based perspective that engages with the decentred discourses of post structuralism she suggests that a focus on the middle space between language and the world not only provides new insights into the construction of the real and the notion of a good story but also resituates the possibility of christian reading in a largely post christian era book jacket

the endless wars of the seventeenth century took their toll in the lives of millions of soldiers and crushing taxes to legitimize war europe s rulers turned to the church o god we praise you te deum laudamus was sung in the churches of france and sweden to celebrate victory in battle it was a way of thanking god but also an opportunity for congregations to learn what had happened and an occasion for festivities in the story of war the historian anna maria forssberg applies a narrative and ritual perspective to the te deum looking at specific wars such as the thirty years war and at themes such as peace and enmity this is a unique comparative study of war propaganda in early modern times and how it defined the roles of ruler and ruled alike there were national differences but ultimately all war stories were highly selective bloody defeat and uneventful everyday life were glossed over what mattered were spectacular victories and royal glory yet in the end the war stories peddled in both sweden and france were profoundly challenged by the crisis of 1709

gunn sets out his aim in this book to foster a fresh understanding of the narrative about david in 2 samuel and 1 kings commonly known as the succession narrative by arguing for its fuller appreciation of its nature as a story gunn reviews the different hypotheses on the genre of the so called court history succession narrative and concludes that the purpose of this story is to entertain the work is to be considered primarily artistic and literary and the rhetorical devices in the story are reliant on traditional motifs and devices

first published in 1956 this is a history of california s official state gold rush ghost town which was designated a national historic landmark in 1961 and in 1962 became bodie state historic park the account is written by ella m cain a native of bodie whose father in law james s cain and family owned much of the land the town is situated upon and had hired caretakers to protect and to maintain the town s structures following its decline in 1914 bodie deserved and sustained its reputation of being the most lawless the wildest and toughest mining camp the far west has ever known ella m cain

for many reasons some of which are obvious to the least thoughtful the history of switzerland is peculiarly interesting and not least so to english speaking peoples in the first place the

playground of europe is every year visited by large numbers of british and americans some of whom indeed are familiar with almost every corner of it then to the anglo saxon race the grand spectacle of a handful of freemen nobly struggling for and maintaining their freedom often amidst enormous difficulties and against appalling odds cannot but be heart stirring to the citizen of the great american republic a study of the constitution of the little european republic should bring both interest and profit a constitution resembling in many points that of his own country and yet in many other respects so different and few readers of whatever nationality can we think peruse this story without a feeling of admiration for a gallant people who have fought against oppression as the swiss have fought who have loved freedom as they have loved it and who have performed the well nigh incredible feats of arms the switzers have performed and as sir francis o adams and mr cunningham well point out in their recently published work on the swiss confederation as a study in constitutional history the value of the story of the development of the confederation can hardly be over estimated few of the existing accounts of swiss history which have appeared in the english language go back beyond the year 1291 a d the date of the earliest swiss league and of course switzerland as a nation cannot boast of an earlier origin but surely some account should be given of the previous history of the men who founded the league for a country which has been occupied at different periods by lakemen helvetians and romans where alamanni burgundians and franks have played their parts where charlemagne lived and ruled and charles the bold fought where the great families of the zaerings the kyburgs and savoy struggled and whence the now mighty house of habsburg sprang and domineered all this before 1291 a country with such a story to tell of its earlier times we say should not have that story left untold accordingly in this volume the history of the period before the formation of the confederation has been dwelt upon at some little length it should be mentioned too that in view of the very general interest caused by the remarkable discovery of the swiss lake settlements a few years ago a chapter has been devoted to the subject

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
