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this is the first english language work devoted to the avignon society which ranks as one of the most remarkable and influential initiatic societies in europe between 1779 and 1807 influenced by the burgeoning strand of illuminist high degree freemasonry the avignon society nevertheless developed a unique culture that incorporated strands of western esotericism within a millenarian framework

since glasnost began russia s most eminent historians have taken advantage of new archival access and the end of censorship and conformity to reassess and reinterpret their history through this process they are linking up with russia s great historiographic tradition while producing work that is fresh and modern in the emperors and empresses of russia renowned russian historians tell the story of the

romanovs as complex individual personalities and as key institutional actors in russian history from the empire builder peter i to the last tsar nicholas ii these portraits are contributions to the writing of history partaking neither of wooden ideologisation nor of naive romanticisation

this definitive anthology gathers stories essays memoirs excerpts from novels and poems by more than 130 jewish writers of the past two centuries who worked in the russian language it features writers of the tsarist soviet and post soviet periods both in russia and in the great emigrations representing styles and artistic movements from romantic to postmodern the authors include figures who are not widely known today as well as writers of world renown most of the works appear here for the first time in english or in new translations the editor of the anthology maxim d shrayer of boston college is a leading authority on jewish russian literature the selections were chosen not simply on the basis of the author's background but because each work illuminates questions of jewish history status and identity each author is profiled in an essay describing the personal cultural and historical circumstances in which the writer worked and individual works or groups of works are headnoted to provide further context the anthology not only showcases a wide selection of individual works but also offers an encyclopedic history of jewish russian culture this handsome two volume set is organized chronologically the first volume spans the nineteenth century and the first part of the twentieth century and includes the editor's extensive introduction to the jewish russian literary canon the second volume covers the period from the death of stalin to the present and each volume includes a corresponding survey of jewish russian history by john d klier of university college london as well as detailed bibliographies of historical and literary sources

john fennell's history of thirteenth century russia is the only detailed study in english of the period and is based on close investigation of the primary sources his account concentrates on the turbulent politics of northern russia which was ultimately to become the tsardom of muscovy but he also gives detailed attention to the vast southern empire of kiev before its eclipse under the tatars the resulting study is a major addition to medieval historiography an essential acquisition for students of russia itself and a book which decisively fills a vast blank on the map of the european middle ages for medievalists generally

the reign of alexander i was a pivotal moment in the construction of russia's national mythology this work examines this crucial period focusing on the place of the russian nobility in relation to their ruler and the accompanying debate between reform and the status quo between a russia old and new and between different visions of what russia could become drawing on extensive archival research and placing a long neglected emphasis on this aspect of alexander i's reign this book is an important work for students and scholars of imperial russia as well as the wider napoleonic and post napoleonic period in europe

this comprehensive and original survey of russian theater in the twentieth century and into the twenty first encompasses the major productions of directors such as meyerhold stanislavsky tovostonogov dodin and liubimov that drew from russian and world literature it is based on a close analysis of adaptations of literary works by pushkin dostoevsky gogol blok bulgakov sholokhov rasputin abramov and many others the modern russian stage is the result of more than two decades of research as well as the author s professional experience working with the russian director yuri liubimov in moscow and london the book traces the transformation of literary works into the brilliant stagecraft that characterizes russian theater it uses the perspective of theater performances to engage all the important movements of modern russian culture including modernism socialist realism post moderninsm and the creative renaissance of the first decades since the soviet regime s collapse

making russians is an innovative study dealing with russian nationalities policy in lithuania and belarus in the aftermath of the 1863 uprising the book devotes most attention to imperial confessional and language policy for in russian discourse at that time it was religion and language that were considered to be the most important criteria determining nationality the account of russian nationalities policy presented here differs considerably from the assessments usually offered by historians from east central europe primarily because the author provides a more subtle description of the aims of imperial nationalities policy rejecting the claim that the russian authorities consistently sought to assimilate members of other national groups at the same time the interpretation this study offers opens a discussion with western and russian historians especially those who lay heavy emphasis on discourse analysis this study asserts that the rhetoric of officials and certain public campaigners was influenced by a concept of political correctness which condemned all forms of ethnic denationalisation a closer look at the implementation of discriminatory policy allows us to discern within russian imperial policy more attempts to assimilate or otherwise repress the cultures of non dominant national groups than it is possible to appreciate simply by analysing discourse alone

provides the first systematic study of geometry and topology of locally symmetric rank one manifolds and dynamics of discrete action of their fundamental groups in addition to geometry and topology this study involves several other areas of mathematics from algebra of varieties of groups representations and geometric group theory to geometric analysis including classical questions from function theory

this book sets out to present the polish russian conflict the way the elite of russian society saw it one of its chief research topics is the interaction between russian public opinion the policy the empire pursued on its uncompliant subjects and the impact the polish conflict had on the evolution of russian political ideas and movements a major issue it addresses is the reaction of russian society its diverse political factions and social and philosophical trends and their relationship to the polish national movement and the effect of the polish question on their evolution research in numerous archives and manuscript collections in russia poland ukraine lithuania played a fundamental role in the work for this book this

book was originally published in polish as fatalna sprawa kwestia polska w rosyjskiej mysli politycznej kraków arcana 2000 it was awarded the klio prize a prestigious polish award for the best monograph on a historical subject this english translation is an abridged version about 1/3 of the book's original size

studies in particular monastic revivals in the 19th and 20th centuries as epitomized by trinity sergius

this fascinating book contains information on over 2 300 ancient western philosophers from abammon to zoticus covering the period from the seventh century bc to the seventh century ad it brings together the extremely well known and the thoroughly obscure those already familiar with ancient philosophy will find it an invaluable and handy work of reference with a breadth of coverage that far exceeds any other single volume work on the subject those new to the subject will find it a useful introduction the ideas of the major thinkers are summarised and an historical overview of ancient philosophy allows them to be placed in their proper context the book also provides useful background reading for anyone interested in the ancient world who wants to find out more about its intellectual life a minimum of philosophical jargon ensures its accessibility to a wide audience as in ancient histories of philosophy there is also a modest amount of gossip

key dimensions of dostoevskii's writing and life are explored in this collection of specially commissioned essays contributors examines topics such as dostoevskii's relation to folk literature money religion the family and science the essays are well supported by supplementary material including a chronology of the period and detailed guides to further reading altogether the volume provides an invaluable resource for scholars and students

lists citations with abstracts for aerospace related reports obtained from world wide sources and announces documents that have recently been entered into the nasa scientific and technical information database

literary theory flourished in central and eastern europe throughout the twentieth century but its relation to western literary scholarship is complex this book sheds light on the entangled histories of exchange and influence both within the region known as central and eastern europe and between the region and the west the exchange of ideas between scholars in the east and west was facilitated by both personal and institutional relations both official and informal encounters for the longest time however intellectual exchange was thwarted by political tensions that led to large parts of central and eastern europe being isolated from the west a few literary theories nevertheless made it into western scholarly discourses via exiled scholars some of these scholars such as mikhail bakhtin become widely known in the west and their thought was transposed onto new western cultural contexts others such as olga freidenberg were barely noticed outside of russian and poland this volume draws attention to the schools circles and concepts that shaped the development of theory in central and eastern europe as

well as the histoire croisée the history of translations transformations and migrations that conditioned its relationship with the west

certain aspects of american popular culture had a formative influence on early soviet identity and aspirations traditionally soviet russia and the united states between the 1920s and the 1940s are regarded as polar opposites on nearly every front yet american films and translated adventure fiction were warmly received in 1920s russia and partly shaped ideals of the new soviet person into the 1940s cinema was crucial in propagating this new social hero while open admiration of american film stars and heroes of literary fiction in the soviet press was restricted from the late 1920s onwards many positive heroes of soviet socialist realist films in the 1930s and 1940s were partially a product of soviet americanism of the previous decade some of the new soviet heroes in films of the 1930s and 1940s possessed traits noticeably evocative of the previously popular american film stars such as douglas fairbanks pearl white and mary pickford others cinematically represented the contemporary trope of the russian american an ideal worker exemplifying the stalinist marriage of russian revolutionary sweep with american efficiency russian americans in soviet film analyses the content reception and underlying influences of over 60 soviet and american films the book explores new territory in soviet cinema and soviet american cultural relations it presents groundbreaking archival research encompassing soviet audience surveys soviet film journals and reviews memoirs and articles by soviet filmmakers and scripts among other sources the book reveals that values of optimism technological skill efficiency and self reliance perceived as quintessentially american were incorporated into new soviet ideals through channels of cross cultural dissemination resulting in cultural synthesis

based on exclusive personal interviews with alexander solzhenitsyn joseph pearce s biography of the renowned russian dissident provides profound insight into a towering literary and political figure

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
