easter island a world heritage site is still after over 50 years since thor heyerdahl s work on the island a fascinating area to explore and learn about a culture that has only remnants remaining while documenting a marine ecology still mostly unknown easter island scientific exploration into the world s environmental problems in microcosm presents the research results from three years of interdisciplinary expeditions to easter island the primary objectives were to investigate the effects of human population growth on the ecology of the island and to discover whether any dramatic climatic changes such as a prolonged el niño could have disrupted the island s fragile ecosystem the interdisciplinary scientific team were mainly researching the paleontology archaeology climatology and geophysics of the island this book now brings together the results of the three expeditions identifies new areas of research and hopefully will continue to inspire aspiring scientists to revisit this amazing island to explore and demystify this timeless enigma of human history

an incredibly detailed account of indigenous lifeways during the initial rounds of european exploration in south central north america several hundred tribes of native americans were living within or hunting and trading across the present day borders of texas when cabeza de vaca and his shipwrecked companions washed up on a gulf coast beach in 1528 over

the next two centuries as spanish and french expeditions explored the state they recorded detailed information about the locations and lifeways of texas s native peoples using recent translations of these expedition diaries and journals along with discoveries from ongoing archaeological investigations william c foster here assembles the most complete account ever published of texas s native peoples during the early historic period ad 1528 to 1722 foster describes the historic native peoples of texas by geographic regions his chronological narrative records the interactions of native groups with european explorers and with native trading partners across a wide network that extended into louisiana the great plains new mexico and northern mexico foster provides extensive ethnohistorical information about texas s native peoples as well as data on the various regions animals plants and climate accompanying each regional account is an annotated list of named indigenous tribes in that region and maps that show tribal territories and european expedition routes a very useful encyclopedic regional account of the europeans and native peoples of texas who encountered one another during the relatively unexamined two hundred years before the spanish occupation of texas and the french establishment of louisiana southwestern historical quarterly

among the dead sea scrolls psalms are found in no less than thirty nine manuscripts this groundbreaking volume presents the first comprehensive study of these scrolls by making available a wealth of primary data and investigating the main issues that arise the first part provides information which many scholars will find enormously helpful such as descriptions of the manuscripts listings of variant readings a synopsis of superscriptions and indices of contents of all the psalms scrolls the second part investigates the issues some of which are relevant to the book of psalms itself e g stabilization in two distinct stages while others focus upon 11qpsa the largest psalms scroll e g part of an edition of the book of psalms and one involves the relation of these manuscripts to the septuagint psalter

early spanish voyages to the strait of magellan by sir clements r markham is a masterful reconstruction of one of the most daring and dramatic chapters in maritime history the sixteenth century spanish attempts to navigate the perilous waters at the tip of south america drawing upon rare manuscripts official reports and journals preserved in the archives of seville and madrid markham brings to life the courage ambition and tragedy of the explorers who followed in magellan s wake in their search for empire and glory the book chronicles the voyages of loaysa sarmiento and other forgotten captains whose ships braved the furious storms and labyrinthine channels of patagonia markham s meticulous research transforms these little known expeditions into vivid epics of endurance and

following his participation in james cook s circumnavigation in hms endeavour 1768 71 joseph banks developed an extensive global network of scientists and explorers his correspondence shows how he developed effective working links with the british admiralty and with the generation of naval officers who sailed after cook volume 5 letters 1798 1801

although it was 1806 when lewis and clark returned to st louis after their journey across the country it was not until 1905 that they were celebrated as national heroes in the footsteps of lewis and clark examines how public attitudes toward their explorations and the means of commemorating them have changed from the production of the lewis and clark exposition in 1905 to the establishment of the lewis and clark national historic trail in 1978 and the celebrations of the expedition s bicentennial from 2003 through 2007 the first significant stirrings of national public interest in lewis and clark coincided with the beginning of a nationwide fascination with transcontinental automobile touring americans began to reconnect with the past and interact with the history of western expansion by becoming a new breed of frontier explorer via their cars as a result early emphasis on local plaques and monuments yielded to pageants reenactments and ultimately attempts to retrace the route promoting conservation and recreation along its length wallace g lewis details the ingenuity that inspired the establishment of the lewis and clark national historic trail opening a window to how america reimagines recreates and remembers its own past in the footsteps of lewis and clark will appeal to both scholarly and armchair historians interested in the western frontier as experienced by both lewis and clark and those retracing their steps today
