aujourd'hui the purpose of this book is to encourage an exchange of views
between philosophers and historians interested in the overlap between
contemporary philosophy and theory of historical practice

the present publication is a continuation of two earlier series of chronicles
philosophy in the mid century firenze 1958 59 and contemporary philosophy
firenze 1968 edited by raymond klibansky as with the earlier series the present
chronicles purport to give a survey of significant trends in contemporary
philosophi cal discussion the time space covered by the present series is
approximately 1966 1978 the need for such surveys has i believe increased
rather than decreased over the last years the philosophical scene appears for
various reasons more complex than ever before the continuing process of
specialization in most branches the emergence of new schools of thought
particularly in philosophical logic and the philosophy of language the
convergence of interest though not necessarily of opinion of different traditions
upon certain prob lems and the increasing attention being paid to the history
of philosophy in discussions of contemporary problems are the most important
contributory factors surveys of the present kind are a valuable source of
knowledge of this complexity and may as such be of assistance in renewing
the understanding of one s own philosophical problems the surveys it is to be
hoped may also help to strengthen the socratic element of modern philosophy

the dialogue or kommunikationsgemeinschaft so far four volumes have been prepared for the new series the present chronicles in philosophy of science vol 2 follow the chronicles in the philosophy of language and philosophical logic vol

the series miscellanea mediaevalia was founded by paul wilpert in 1962 and since then has presented research from the thomas institute of the university of cologne the cornerstone of the series is provided by the proceedings of the biennial cologne medieval studies conferences which were established over 50 years ago by josef koch the founding director of the institute the interdisciplinary nature of these conferences is reflected in the proceedings the miscellanea mediaevalia gather together papers from all disciplines represented in medieval studies medieval history philosophy theology together with art and literature all contribute to an overall perspective of the middle ages

this special issue of labyrinth is the second part of a diptych dedicated to the eminent french philosopher fran ois laruelle in honor of his 80th anniversary the included essays deal with the origins of laruelle s non philosophy in ravaillon s understanding of metaphysics the question of religious pluralism the non philosophical mystique and the rehabilitation of heresis the analogies and differences of laruelle s non philosophy to iamblichus or martin heidegger the contributors to this issue are vincent le john m allison eleni lorandou stanimir panayotov ameen mettawa david bremner and yvanka b raynova

this volume offers a critical analysis and illustration of the challenges and promises of stateless law thought pedagogy and approaches to governance that is understanding and conceptualizing law in a post national condition from common civil and international law perspectives the collection focuses on the definition and role of law as an academic discipline and hybridity in the practice and production of law with contributions by a diverse and international group of scholars the collection includes fourteen chapters written in english and three in french confronting the transnational challenge posed to the traditional theoretical and institutional structures that underlie the teaching and study of law in the university the seventeen authors of stateless law evolving boundaries of a discipline bring new insight to the ongoing and crucial conversation about the future shape of legal scholarship education and practice that is emblematic of the early twenty first century this collection is essential reading for academics institutions and others involved in determining the future roles responsibilities and education of jurists as well as for academics interested in law sociology political science and education

the articles in this book display the originality and creativity of eros and eris and their important role in the history of our culture particularly in the history

of philosophy and its role in today's systematic philosophy although these contributions to a hermeneutical phenomenology in this compilation are organized in a linear chronological order treating homer hesiod plato aristotle augustine bonaventure thomas aquinas cusanus kant hegel schelling nietzsche husserl heidegger and levinas they all carry out their own hermeneutical movement in the history of philosophy on the basis of a commitment with out life here and now and a thematic professional interest among the contributors are r bernasconi j colette j f courtine l dupr  kl d sing j greisch j kockelmans p j labarri re and g jarczyk e levinas al lingis j l marion o p ggeler w richardson p ricoeur j sallis m theunissen and s ijsseling

this book addresses five main topics of metaphysics in its first section formal objects and truth makers tropes properties and predicates varieties of relations and the notion of explanation in metaphysics the second part of this volume focuses on the history of philosophy with an emphasis on austrian philosophy the ideas of bolzano wittgenstein locke and bergson amongst others are explored in the papers presented here this is the first volume in a two volume set that originates from papers presented to professor kevin mulligan covering the subjects that he contributed to during his career including ontology mind and value history and philosophy of mind and philosophy of language this volume contains thirty two chapters written by researchers from across europe north america and north africa these papers cover topics in metaphysics ranging from lehrer and tolliver's discussion of truth and tropes to johansson's defence of the distinction between thick and thin relations and persson and sahl n's presentation of the difficulties inherent in applying the concept of explanation in metaphysics papers on the history of philosophy include a look at bolzano's formative years and his conception of mathematics de libera examines brentano's adverbial theory of judgment and fisette traces the history of the philosophical society of the university of vienna in the late 19th and early 20th century marion contests the trendy pragmatist accounts that lump wittgenstein and heidegger together and there are analyses of locke and bergson's work amongst the many papers presented here this volume contains three chapters in french and one in spanish the second volume of this set looks at ethics values and emotions epistemology perception and consciousness as well as philosophy of mind and philosophy of language

this book is the result of a three day conference held in april 2014 at the university of montreal canada discussing the relevance of the work of hegel and marx in today's world particularly with regard to the ecological economic political and anthropological crisis facing humanity accordingly the book an

exploration of the specific nature of the crisis we face both in our everyday lives and in the realm of theory however if indeed the necessity of a proper critique *kritikos* is intimately linked to a state of crisis *krisis* the conceptual frame necessary to produce such a critique may itself be in crisis among the vast number of critical oppositions to contemporary capitalism what are the keys available to understand the present forms of human conditions alienation and exploitation controversies and divisions among the different tendencies within the critical tradition tend to highlight the point that there is also a theoretical crisis which prevents a proper diagnosis of the actual crisis and prevents in turn a proper plan of action from being established looking back to marx and hegel allowed a return if not to the sources at least to two unavoidable influences among the various critical approaches to capitalism be it with or against hegel and or marx the criticisms of modernity post modernity and capitalism cannot neglect the shadows of these thinkers both marx's and hegel's philosophical sociological and political enterprises must be linked historically to the will to diagnose and solve what they saw as the most important crises of their own time from in hegel's case the spiritual crisis which followed the advent of modernity and its accompanying turmoil to the social and political crisis caused by capitalism and the advent of a new industrial society in marx's case both intellectual ventures are at every turn haunted by the notion of crisis this book will appeal to anyone interested in hegel's and marx's philosophical and political theories not only does it provide the historical context necessary to understand properly the relation between marx and hegel but it also places the relevance of their teachings for the contemporary reader in perspective

this book confronts the history and legitimacy of western universalism in the form of conversations it documents thinking in process about how new forms of universality after hegemonic universalism can be thought and practised bringing into play their practices and theories the interlocutors of universalism e lay their own traces of a minor universality situated in the troubling present
