general is but a single factor in the total scheme of human and divine purposes and that whatever the technique of satisfying the wealth interest may prove to be the place of that interest in the whole harmony of human relations has to be established by a calculus in whose equations the formulas of economic technique are merely subordinate terms all of this was understood by smith s friend dugald stewart and it was uttered by him with sufficient clearness more than a century ago it may assist our own insight to recall some of his words 1 the foregoing very imperfect hints appear to me to form not only a proper but in some measure a necessary introduction to the few remarks i have to offer on mr smith s inquiry as they tend to illustrate a connection between his system of commercial politics sic and those speculations of his earlier years in which he aimed more professedly at the advancement of human improvement and happiness it is this view of political economy that can alone render it interesting to the moralist and can dignify calculations of profit and loss in the eye of the philosopher mr smith has alluded to it in various passages of his work but he has nowhere
