the limits of dream focuses on what we currently know of the human central nervous system cns examining the basic sciences of neurochemistry neuroanatomy and cns electrophysiology as these sciences apply to dream then reaching beyond basic science to examine the cognitive science of dreaming including the processes of memory the perceptual interface and visual imagery building on what is known of intrapersonal cns processing the book steps outside the physical body to explore artificially created dreams and their use in filmmaking art and story as well as the role of dreaming in creative process and creative madness the limits of our scientific knowledge of dream frame this window that can be used to explore the border between body and mind what is known scientifically of the cognitive process of dreaming will lead the neuroscientist the student of cognitive science and the general reader down different paths than expected into an exploration of the fuzzy and complex horizon between mind and brain the clearest presentation of research and philosophy currently available relating to the mind brain interface discusses the cognitive processes of dreaming utilized in film and artificial intelligence describes the functioning of dream in the creative process

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reportedly the prophet muhammad told his followers that after he was gone prophecy would come only through true dreams based on this and other statements early muslims created what might be called a theology of dreams dreams were regarded as an important means used by god to guide the faithful especially after the cessation of koranic revelation however since these dreams were often symbolic they required interpretation and early muslims wrote numerous manuals dedicated to deciphering their meaning utilizing manuscripts preserved in middle eastern mosques and libraries this book offers the first comprehensive account of the early muslim tradition of dream interpretation in addition to describing how and when the tradition developed author john c lamoreaux discusses the social context in which dream interpretation arose and its role in the intellectual life of the time he demonstrates that early

muslims considered dream interpretation a fully orthodox theological discipline one sanctioned both by the koran and the example of the prophet muhammad

dodson reads the dreams in the gospel of matthew 1 18b 25 2 12 13 15 19 21 22 27 19 as the authorial audience this approach requires an understanding of the social and literary character of dreams in the greco roman world dodson describes the social function of dreams noting that dreams constituted one form of divination in the ancient world and looks at the theories and classification of dreams that developed in the ancient world he then moves on to demonstrate the literary dimensions of dreams in greco roman literature this exploration of the literary representation of dreams is nuanced by considering the literary form of dreams dreams in the greco roman rhetorical tradition the inventiveness of literary dreams and the literary function of dreams the dreams in the gospel of matthew are then analyzed in this social and literary context it is demonstrated that matthew s use of dreams as a literary convention corresponds to the script of dreams in other greco roman narratives this correspondence includes the form of the matthean dreams dreams as a motif of the birth topos 1 18b 25 the association of dreams and prophecy 1 22 23 2 15 23 the use of the double dream report 2 12 and 2 13 15 and dreams as an ominous sign in relation to an individual s death 27 19 an appendix considers the matthean transfiguration as a dream vision report
