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the roots of our modern world lie in the civilization of mesopotamia which saw the development of the first urban society and the invention of writing the cuneiform texts reveal the technological and social innovations of sumer and babylonia as surprisingly modern and the influence of this fascinating culture was felt throughout the near east early mesopotamia

gives an entirely new account integrating the archaeology with historical data which until now have been largely scattered in specialist literature

this book provides an overview of social life in ancient mesopotamia bringing together leading experts to survey key social domains of daily life as well as major non dominant social groups it serves as a point of entry to the current research in this field

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urban history starts in ancient mesopotamia in this volume marc van de mieroop examines the evolution of the very earliest cities which for millennia inspired the rest of the ancient world the city determined every aspect of mesopotamian civilization and the political and social structure economy literature and arts of mesopotamian culture cannot be understood without acknowledging their urban background urban history starts in ancient mesopotamia the earliest known cities developed there as the result of long indigenous processes and for millennia the city determined every aspect of mesopotamian civilization marc van de mieroop examines urban life in the historical period investigating urban topography the role of cities as centres of culture their political and social structures economy literature and the arts he draws on material from the entirety of mesopotamian history from c 3000 to 300 bc and from both babylonia and assyria arguing that the mesopotamian city can be regarded as a prototype that inspired the rest of the ancient world and shared characteristics with the european cities of antiquity

there have been few studies in ancient near eastern archaeology that have concentrated on domestic buildings with little existent information about houses this represents a serious

lacuna in the knowledge of mesopotamian culture considering the importance of the house in society as the main space of social dynamics this book addresses this gap analysing the characteristics and the variations of mesopotamian houses in the third millennium which represents a critical period for early urbanization it identifies common aspects and differences and relates those characteristics to the socio economical history of the period to broaden the understanding of this interesting period in mesopotamian culture to examine variations and use of space seven sites were analysed from north tell melebiya titris höyük and tell taya central khafajah and tell asmar and south mesopotamia tell abu salabikh and shuruppak for a total number of 68 house plans several aspects have been investigated such as the size of households the evidence of wealth the concept of privacy and the role of women in society the database of houses collected in this book also offers a reference for other sites to analyse houses and households

in her book the author offers readers a compact guide to the religion of the peoples living in the region of the tigris and euphrates rivers from the beginning of the bronze age to the time of alexander the great and darius iii drawing on extant texts artifacts and architecture schneider uncovers both an intriguing pantheon of deities including marduk ishtar and many others and the complex fluid and highly ritualized religious experience of the people who spent their lives serving and appeasing them

the greek name mesopotamia means land between the rivers the romans used this term for an area that they controlled only briefly between 115 and 117 a d the land between the euphrates and tigris rivers from the south anatolian mountains ranges to the persian gulf it comprises the civilizations of sumer and akkad third millennium b c as well as the later babylonian and assyrian empires of the second and first millennium although the history of mesopotamia in the strict sense of the term only begins with the inscriptions of sumerian rulers around the 27th century b c the foundations for mesopotamian civilization especially the beginnings of irrigation and the emergence of large permanent settlements were laid much earlier in the fifth and fourth millennium the second edition of the historical dictionary of mesopotamia defines concepts customs and notions peculiar to the civilization of ancient mesopotamia from adult adoption to ziggurats this is accomplished through a chronology an introductory essay a bibliography appendixes and hundreds of cross reference dictionary entries on religion economy society geography and important kings and rulers

the book is a study of the emergence of market economy with modern economic institutions in the early civilizations of mesopotamia and ancient egypt from the third and early second millennium b c e the study covers the sumerian old assyrian and old babylonian periods the economic analysis is based on institutional economics theory and the data on the old assyrian period is based on the work of many scholars that transliterated translated and studied many of the 23 000 documents of the old assyrian traders found in old kanesh in central turkey the book includes chapters on the institutions of property rights the markets and means of exchange the organization and finance of trade and enforcement institutions from the judicial social and political systems in addition it gives a detailed analysis of the early means of exchange money like the use of volume measure of barley and weight measure of copper and silver in sumer various instruments establishing property rights such as kuduru border stones seals and inserted cones in walls detailed analysis of the communication system and its components and the description of the modern financial instruments used to include for example limited partnerships
