Structure and Organisation Here youll examine how the writer structures the text to build suspense reveal information gradually or create a particular impact on the reader Consider the use of paragraphs sentence length and chronological order or lack thereof

Writers Purpose and Audience These questions require you to understand the writers intention to inform persuade entertain etc and how they tailor their writing to engage a specific audience

2 Comparing and Contrasting Some questions might ask you to compare the writers style in different sections of the extract or compare Touching the Void with another text

Howto Section Answering Language Analysis Questions Lets say a question asks Analyse how Simpson uses language to describe his physical and emotional state after falling into the crevasse

Step 1 Identify Key Quotations Select powerful phrases that vividly portray his physical and emotional state For example My leg was screaming a searing pain shot up my leg despair clawed at me

Step 2 Analyse the Language Techniques My leg was screaming Personification the leg is given human qualities emphasizing the intensity of the pain a searing pain shot up my leg Imagery the vivid verb searing and the dynamic imagery create a sense of intense sharp pain despair clawed at me Personification again despair is given the active role of attacking him suggesting its overwhelming nature

Step 3 Explain the Effect Explain how these techniques impact the reader For example The personification of his leg screaming emphasizes the unbearable pain he endures drawing the reader into his suffering The vivid imagery of searing pain creates a powerful sensory experience for the reader making the pain feel visceral and real

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can theology still operate in the void of post theism in attempting to answer this question agnosis examines the concept of the void itself tracing a history of nothingness from augustine through kierkegaard and nietzsche to bataille and derrida and dialoguing with japan s kyoto school philosophers it is argued that neither augustinian nor post hegelian metaphysics have given a satisfactory understanding of nothingness and that we must look to an experience of nothingness as the best ground for future religious life and thought

in this landmark volume blanchot sustains a dialogue with a number of thinkers whose contributions have marked turning points in the history of western thought and have influenced virtually all the themes that inflect the contemporary literary and philosophical debate today blanchot waits for us still to come to be read and reread i would say that never as much as today have i pictured him so far ahead of us jacques derrida
