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fourteen poignant stories depicting african american life in washington d c by the pulitzer prize winning author of the known world the nation s capital that serves as the setting for the stories in edward p jones s prize winning collection lost in the city lies far from the city of historic monuments and national politicians jones takes the reader beyond that world into the lives of african american men and women who work against the constant threat of loss to maintain a sense of hope from the girl who raised pigeons to the well to do career woman awakened in the night by a phone call that will take her on a journey back to the past the characters in these stories forge bonds of community as they struggle against the limits of their city to stave off the loss of family friends memories and ultimately themselves critically acclaimed upon publication lost in the city introduced jones as an undeniable talent a writer whose unaffected style is not only evocative and forceful but also filled with insight and poignancy

an inspiring collection of interviews with some of today s hottest authors

perhaps the brevity of short fiction accounts for the relatively scant attention devoted to it by scholars who have historically concentrated on longer prose narratives the geographies of african american short fiction seeks to fill this gap by analyzing the ways african american short story writers plotted a diverse range of characters across multiple locations small towns a famous metropolis city sidewalks a rural wooded area apartment buildings a pond a general store a prison and more in the process these writers highlighted the extents to which places and spaces shaped or situated racial representations presenting african american short story writers as cultural cartographers author kenton rambsy documents the variety of geographical references within their short stories to

show how these authors make cultural spaces integral to their artwork and inscribe their stories with layered and resonant social histories the history of these short stories also documents the circulation of compositions across dozens of literary collections for nearly a century anthology editors solidified the significance of a core group of short story authors including james baldwin toni cade bambara charles chesnutt ralph ellison zora neale hurston and richard wright using quantitative information and an extensive literary dataset the geographies of african american short fiction explores how editorial practices shaped the canon of african american short fiction

many scholars and activists argue that the practice of racialization and the belief in race are necessary because even if race is not real racism is while such an approach might help lessen some effects of racism it inevitably strengthens the very foundation of racism as sheena michele mason argues in the raceless antiracist fighting racism by ignoring or upholding the idea of race and the practice of racialization is like trying to stop a flood by dousing it with water to end racism particularly antiblack racism we must question acknowledge and translate race as an integral part of racism itself in presenting her case for charting a future without racism mason weaves insights from philosophy sociology statistics biology history and literary studies she presents a map which she refers to as the togetherness wayfinder for how to discuss teach identify and

stop the causes and effects of racism without hardening any of its components with this guide we can end the idea of race and the practice of racialization and start to navigate more effectively toward a post racist world

originally published in 1995 this book gathers together eleven full length essays on important american short story sequences of the twentieth century the introduction by j gerald kennedy elucidates problems of defining the genre cites notable instances of the form such as sherwood anderson s *winesburg ohio* and explores the implications of its modern emergence and popularity subsequent

essays discuss illustrative works by such figures as Henry James, Jean Toomer, Ernest Hemingway, Richard Wright, William Faulkner, Eudora Welty, J. D. Salinger, John Cheever, John Updike, Louise Erdrich, and Raymond Carver. While examining distinctive thematic concerns, each essay also considers implications of form and arrangement in the construction of composite fictions that often produce the illusion of a fictive community.

In Race and Masculinity in Southern Memory by Matthew Mace Barbee explores the long history of Richmond, Virginia's iconic Monument Avenue as a network of important memorials to Confederate leaders located in the former capitol of the Confederacy. Monument Avenue has long been central to the formation of public memory in Virginia and the U.S. South. It has also been a site of multiple controversies over what, who, and how Richmond's past should be commemorated. This book traces the evolution of Monument Avenue by analyzing public discussions of its memorials and their meaning. It pays close attention to the origins of Monument Avenue and the first statues erected there, including memorials to Robert E. Lee and Jefferson Davis. Barbee provides a detailed and focused analysis of the evolution of Monument Avenue and public memory in Richmond from 1948 to 1996, through the Civil Rights Movement and the Civil War Centennial, and up to the memorial to Arthur Ashe erected in 1996. An African American native of Richmond, Ashe was an international tennis champion and advocate for human rights. The story of how a monument to him ended up in a space previously reserved for statues of Confederate leaders helps us understand the ways Richmond has grappled with its past, especially the histories of slavery, Jim Crow, and Civil Rights.

Violence Against Black Bodies argues that black deaths at the hands of police are just one form of violence that black and brown people face daily in the Western world. Through the voices of scholars from different academic disciplines, this book gives readers an opportunity to put the cases together and see that violent

deaths in police custody are just one tentacle of the racial order a hierarchy which is designed to produce trauma and discrimination according to one's perceived race and ethnicity
