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in the eighteenth century the alps became the subject of a new view of nature which crystallized in the sublime oscillating between fear and fascination this sensual experience triggered a thrilling borderline experience travelers ventured to the mountain world full of longing and projected a variety of different dreams onto the wild nature that had yet to be explored to what extent has the sublime influenced architecture in the alps from the early days of tourism to the present prompted by this question the author analyzes alpine architecture in its historical context and offers a critical assessment of contemporary tourism this is a book that inspires us to reflect on the future of building in the alps and on our relationship with nature

never before had the garden to fulfil so many demands as it does today it is a refuge from digitalised life and acts as a bridge to nature as a man made place where plants grow it is cultivated and untamable at the same time while for centuries the gardener's ambition was to control and subjugate nature today it serves more as a place for retreat a possible surrogate for wilderness a habitat for animals or it fulfils the dream of self sufficiency in this book landscape architects sociologists architects artists philosophers and historians illuminate different aspects of the garden in the anthropocene in six chapters the garden as a place of community garden as art garden as a place of enchantment and rapture opening up questions of what garden as a model could stand for

contemporary architecture in switzerland is influenced by peter zumthor and herzog de meuron recipients of the swiss pritzker prize as well as a number of other prominent architects the book presents 25 buildings in switzerland designed by 16 influential swiss architects the range covers high density urban developments through to rural sites in the alpine environment with examples of traditional craftsmanship and materials and modern construction technology and engineering large format photographs illustrate the buildings proportions materials and details four authors analyze the swiss building culture and its high architectural quality from an insider's and an outsider's point of view in a detailed interview peter zumthor explains his approach to architectural design

a disused power station is converted into a cultural centre an old barn is made into a residential house all around us we encounter buildings whose original purpose has rendered them obsolete and which now offer space for new uses the construction and building requirements confronting the architect are as varied and individual as the buildings themselves this publication examines a wide range of realized examples highlighting successful and innovative solutions from the rehabilitation of preserved monuments to the renovation or renewal of existing buildings from the reuse of a gothic monastery or the former industrial buildings of fiat lingotto to the renovation of structures made of pre cast concrete panels introductory essays by specialist authors examine the economical technical historical aspects of the topic and the projects presented are documented fully with illustrations plans and details which have been specially produced by the editorial department of detail

chronicling the last radical architectural group of the twentieth century nat narrative architecture today who emerged from the architectural association at the start of the 1980s

this book explores the group's work which echoed a wider artistic and literary culture that drew on the specific political social and physical condition of 1980s London. It traces Nats identification with a particular stream of post punk postmodern expression a celebration of the abject an aesthetic of entropy and a do it yourself provisionality. Nats has most often been documented in reference to Nigel Coates the instigator of Nats which has led to a one sided one dimensional record of Nats place in architectural history. This book sets out a more detailed contextual history of Nats told through photographs drawings and ephemera restoring a truer polyvocal narrative of the group's ethos and development.

the enclosed garden or hortus conclusus is a place where architecture and landscape come together it has a long and varied history ranging from the early paradise garden and cloister the botanic garden and giardini segreto the kitchen garden and as a stage for social display the enclosed garden has continued to develop into its many modern forms the city retreat the redemptive garden the deconstructed building as awareness of climate change becomes increasingly important the enclosed garden which can mediate so effectively between interior and exterior provides opportunities for sustainable design and closer contact with the natural landscape by its nature it is ambiguous is it an outdoor room or captured landscape is it architecture or garden kate baker discusses the continuing relevance of the typology of the enclosed garden to contemporary architects by exploring influential historical examples and the concepts they generate alongside some of the best of contemporary designs brought to life with vivid photography and detailed drawings taken primarily from britain the mediterranean japan and north and south america she argues that understanding the potential of the enclosed garden requires us to think of it as both a design and an experience captured landscape provides a broad range of information and design possibilities for students of architectural and landscape design practising architects landscape designers and horticulturalists and will also appeal to a wider audience of all those who are interested in garden design this second edition of captured landscape is enriched with new case studies throughout the book the scope has now been broadened to include an entirely new chapter concerning the urban condition with detailed discussions on issues of ecology sustainability economy of means well being and the social pressures of contemporary city life

key modern architects provides an accessible and thought provoking introduction to the work of the most significant architects of the modern era fifty short chapters introduce fifty key architects from le corbusier to aldo van eyck to zaha hadid exploring their most influential buildings and developing a critique of each architect s work within a broader cultural and historical context the selection represents the most influential architects working from 1890 to the present those most likely to be taught on survey courses in modern architectural history along with some lesser known names with an equal claim to influence emphasis is placed on a critical and interpretative approach allowing the student to position each architect in a cultural and intellectual context quickly and easily artistic technical social and intellectual developments are brought to the fore built and unbuilt projects writings and influences this approach brings to light the ideology behind architectural work offering insights into each architect s working practice helps students to develop a critical approach to understanding modern architectural history one chapter per architect meaning chapters may be read individually as a concise resource for the study of an architect or together as a coherent book length history of the whole period of modern architecture chapters are supported by boxed lists of each architect s most significant projects along with suggestions for further reading as a springboard to further study and research combining the clarity and accessibility of a textbook with in depth reading and a critical approach key modern architects provides an invaluable resource for both the classroom and for independent study in architectural and art history
