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selección de aproximadamente cincuenta cuentos de autores nórdicos de nuestro siglo traducidos por especialistas de cada uno de los cinco países una breve introducción presenta a cada cultura representada por un cuento de cada uno de los autores más significativos del siglo xx

se podría pensar que vincular la obra maestra cien años de soledad de gabriel garcía márquez con cuestiones teológicas sería una locura sin embargo en la novela del colombiano como lo señalara joaquín marco en su estudio introductorio a cien años de soledad aparecen abundantes elementos religiosos propios de la liturgia católica que sugieren que no se trata de una simple casualidad al contrario todo parece que dichas referencias se dan con toda intención en el presente trabajo ernesto garcía uranga toma su lupa y emprende una búsqueda de las referencias a dogmas y devociones católicos presentes en cien años de soledad usando como aval a la teología histórica para justificar sus argumentos el investigador se da a la tarea de demostrar que el novelista sudamericano desmitifica de una manera deliberada por medio de la parodia ciertos dogmas y devociones impuestos a los creyentes católicos por el magisterio de la iglesia en este ensayo de ninguna manera se sugiere que dichos dogmas y devociones deben ser eliminados de la cultura religiosa católica en su lugar garcía uranga deja en claro que según lo entiende la verdadera finalidad de la desmitificación que lleva a cabo gabriel garcía márquez en cien años de soledad es la de conferir a los mencionados dogmas y devociones una interpretación más humana y menos divina a la luz de la justicia social pues en su forma actual carecen de verdadero significado para el piadoso católico y lo que es aún más grave no encuentran apoyo en las sagradas escrituras se requiere dice el autor de este estudio citando al decano de la teología moral católica profesor bernard haring de un luto por parte de la iglesia de la cabeza y sus miembros por tantas doctrinas falsas que son constantemente reafirmadas de lo contrario si el vaticano continúa haciendo gala de su terquedad anteponiendo el derecho canónico a los evangelios para la conducción de la iglesia se expone a que muchos católicos simplemente le den la espalda de ahí que sea imprescindible remata el estudioso que la iglesia entienda como lo puntualiza leonardo boff que el espíritu de la modernidad no se orienta por la autoridad sino por la participación en estos momentos de cambio las ovejas rehúsan permanecer quietas en su redil ya no se les puede obligar a que crean ciegamente de ahí que se da por sentado que los seres humanos libres como indica mary e hines tienen el derecho a razones claras por las cuales se les exige creer

señalada como catedral gótica del lenguaje este clásico del siglo xx es el enorme y espléndido tapiz de la saga de la familia buendía en la mítica aldea de macondo un referente imprescindible de la vida y la narrativa latinoamericana

muchos años después frente al pelotón de fusilamiento el coronel aureliano buendía había de recordar aquella tarde remota en que su padre lo llevó a conocer el hielo macondo era entonces una aldea de veinte casas de barro y cañabrava construidas a la orilla de un río de aguas diáfanas que se precipitaban por un lecho de piedras pulidas blancas y enormes como huevos prehistóricos el mundo era tan reciente que muchas cosas carecían de nombre y para mencionarlas había que señalarlas con el dedo con estas palabras empieza la novela ya legendaria en los anales de la literatura universal una de las aventuras literarias más fascinantes de nuestro siglo millones de ejemplares de cien años de soledad leídos en todas las lenguas y el premio nobel de literatura coronando una obra que se había abierto paso boca a boca como gusta decir al escritor son la más palpable demostración de que la aventura fabulosa de la familia buendía iguarán con sus milagros fantasías obsesiones tragedias incestos adulterios rebeldías descubrimientos y condenas representaba al mismo tiempo el mito y la historia la tragedia y el amor del mundo entero pablo neruda dijo el quijote de nuestro tiempo éditeur

presents a collection of critical essays about marquez s one hundred years of solitude

from the popol vuh to postmodernism imagery of the natural world has played an important role in latin american literature in contrast to the rise of ecocritical scholarship in anglophone literary studies latin american literary ecocriticism has been slower to take root this volume of eleven essays seeks to advance the ecocritical conversation among latin americanists furthering insight into the relationship between humans and their environments the essays address regions as diverse as patagonia and the chihuahua desert

with this latest installment nelly sfeir v de gonzalez has completed her trilogy of bibliographies on gabriel garcia marquez born in colombia in 1927 garcia marquez has become one of the most outstanding and influential novelists of the 20th century he has received numerous awards including the 1982 nobel prize for literature his work has generated an enormous amount of scholarship and his writings are part of the curricula taught in most american colleges and universities this third volume presents a comprehensive annotated bibliography of books articles and non print materials by and about garcia marquez published between 1992 and 2002 the first part consists of primary sources by garcia marquez while the second part brings together entries for secondary sources including reviews

discusses the theory of the origin and evolution of the latin american narrative and the emergence of the modern novel

this book details the immense impact that jorge luis borges has had on the thinking and writing of the twentieth century and how many have misunderstood that impact it highlights how his symbols techniques parody irony and artful ambiguity in his fiction essays and poems force us to question what we can know with certainty what is real and what is dream and who we are and thus define what has become the core of the postmodern vision the book explores borges distinctly latin american postmodern pluralism it details how this pluralism has informed the postmodern discussions of the self love history feminism and politics and has influenced writers in the u s and latin america throughout it argues that the argentine writer avoids the nihilism and chaos of a radical relativism that many have come to associate with postmodernism rather his vision affirms values and a search for positive knowledge mark frisch is associate professor in the department of modern languages and literatures at duquesne university

since its publication in 1967 one hundred years of solitude has sold well over 10 million copies and earned its author gabriel garcía márquez a host of awards including the nobel prize for literature in 1982 the novel has brought about co

this book outlines a pentecostal theology of praxis while also providing a concrete example of how such a theology is fleshed out by investigating various elements of pentecostal and liberation theologies and highlighting various similarities and differences between the two camps john mark robeck constructs a framework through which a pentecostal theology of praxis might be observed taking a step further he offers a case study of three pentecostal churches in el salvador as an example of how such a theology is lived out robeck examines the lives of the pastors of these congregations the engagement of these congregations in activities of social engagement that serve to bring about various forms of liberation as well as the participation of the congregations and their communities in transformative actions which serve to bring about real change

drawing on extensive research in the spanish national archive alejandro herrero olaizola examines the role played by the censorship apparatus of franco s spain in bringing about the latin american literary boom of the 1960s and 1970s he reveals the negotiations and behind the scenes maneuvering among those involved in the spanish publishing industry converging interests made strange bedfellows of the often left wing authors and the staid officials appointed to stand guard over francoist morality and to defend the supposed purity of castilian spanish between these two uneasily allied groups circulated larger than life real world characters like the barcelona publisher carlos barral and the all powerful literary agent carmen balcells the author details the fascinating story of how novels by mario vargas llosa guillermo cabrera infante gabriel garcía márquez and manuel puig achieved publication in spain and in doing so reached a

worldwide market this colorful account underpins a compelling claim that even the most innovative and aesthetically challenging literature has its roots in the economics of the book trade as well as the institutions of government and the exigencies of everyday politics and ideology

gabriel garcía márquez is latin america's most internationally famous and successful author and a winner of the nobel prize his oeuvre of great modern novels includes *one hundred years of solitude* and *love in the time of cholera* his name has become closely associated with magical realism a phenomenon that has been immensely influential in world literature this companion first published in 2010 includes new and probing readings of all of garcía márquez's works by leading international specialists his life in colombia the context of latin american history and culture key themes in his works and their critical reception are explored in detail written for students and readers of garcía márquez the companion is accessible for non spanish speakers and features a chronology and a guide to further reading this insightful and lively book will provide an invaluable framework for the further study and enjoyment of this major figure in world literature

this handbook offers a comprehensive examination of gabriel garcía márquez's life oeuvre and legacy the first such work since his death in 2014 it incorporates ongoing critical approaches such as feminism ecocriticism marxism and ethnic studies while elucidating key aspects of his work such as his caribbean colombian background his use of magical realism myth and folklore and his left wing political views thirty two wide ranging chapters cover the bulk of the author's writings giving special attention to the global influence of garcía márquez

this collection includes ten articles by different authors that offer in depth readings of the novel among the topics examined are myth magic women western imperialism and the media the book also includes a 1982 interview with the author

this volume of essays constitutes a critical reappraisal of a front rank world author gabriel garcía márquez its principal objective is to reflect the breadth and variety of critical approaches to literature applied to a single corpus of writing here the major novels including *love in the times of cholera* 1986 and a selection of his short fiction are considered

this book offers discussion and analysis of the subtle writing of nobel laureate gabriel garcía márquez a traditionalist who draws from classic western texts a modernist committed to modernizing the conservative literary tradition in colombia and latin america an internationally recognized major writer of the 1960s boom the key figure in popularizing what has

been called magic realism and finally a modernist who has occasionally engaged in some of the strategies of the postmodern the author demonstrates that García Márquez is above all a committed and highly accomplished modernist fiction writer who has successfully synthesized his political vision in his writing and absorbed a vast array of cultural and literary traditions drawing on García Márquez's interviews with Williams and others over the years the book also explores the importance of the non literary the presence of oral tradition and the visual arts thus providing a more complete insight into García Márquez's strategies as a modernist with heterogeneous aesthetic interests as well as an understanding of his social and political preoccupations Raymond Leslie Williams is professor of Latin American literature at the University of California Riverside

contemporary research on Caribbean literature displays a rich variety of themes literary and cultural categories forms genres languages still the concept of a unified Caribbean literary space remains questionable depending upon whether one strictly limits it to the islands enlarges it to adopt a Latin American perspective or even grants it inter American dimensions this book is an ambitious tentative to bring together specialists from various disciplines neither just French Spanish English or comparative studies specialists nor strictly Caribbean literature specialists but also theoreticians cultural studies scholars historians of cultural translation and of intercultural transfers the contributions tackle two major questions what is the best possible division of labor between comparative literature cultural anthropology and models of national or regional literary histories how should one make use of transversal concepts such as memory space linguistic awareness intercultural translation orature or hybridization case studies and concrete projects for integrated research alternate with theoretical and historiographical contributions this volume is of utmost interest to students of Caribbean studies in general but also to anyone interested in Caribbean literatures in Spanish English and French as well as to students in comparative literature cultural studies and transfer research

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
