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over the past four decades east and southeast asia have seen a proliferation of heritage sites and remembrance practices which commemorate the region s bloody conflicts of the period 1931 45 remembering asia s world war two examines the origins dynamics and repercussions of this regional war memory boom the book analyzes the politics of war commemoration in contemporary east and southeast asia featuring contributions from leading international scholars the chapters span china japan malaysia hong kong and singapore covering topics such as the commemoration of the japanese military s comfort women system forms of dark tourism or commemorative pilgrimages e g veterans tours to wartime battlefields and the establishment and evolution of various war related heritage sites and museums case studies reveal the distinctive trajectories of new and newly discovered forms of remembrance within and across national boundaries they highlight the growing influence of non state actors over representations of conflict and occupation as well as the increasingly interconnected and transnational character of memory making taken together the studies collected here demonstrate that across much of asia the public commemoration of the wars of 1931 45 has begun to shift from portraying them as a series of national conflicts with distinctive local meanings to commemorating the conflict as a common pan asian or even global experience focusing on non textual vehicles for public commemoration and considering both the local and international dimensions of war commemoration within remembering asia s world war two will be a crucial reference for students and scholars of history memory studies and heritage studies as well as all those interested in the history politics and culture of contemporary asia

although there is no universally accepted definition of the term land grabbing ordinary people whose livelihoods are adversely affected by land grabbing know exactly what it is it involves the physical capture and control of land and homes including the usurpation of the power to decide how and when these will be used and for what purposes with little or no prior consultation or compensation to the displaced communities this thought provoking book defines land grabbing and examines aspects of the land grabs phenomenon in seven asian countries researched and written by country specific legal scholars the book provides unique perspectives on how and why land grabbing

is practised in china india pakistan cambodia malaysia myanmar and indonesia and explores the surprising role that law plays in facilitating and legitimizing land grabs in each country in contrast to most of the literature which law focuses on foreign investors rights under international law here the focus is on domestic laws and legal infrastructures finding that asian states need to move beyond existing regimes that govern land to a regime that encourages more equitable land rights allocation and protection of stakeholders rights the book urges further research in the nexus between the use of law to facilitate development land grabs in asia is the first book to explore land grabbing in multiple jurisdictions in asia as such it will appeal to students and scholars of law and development law and society and international relations as well as being essential reading for development policy makers and government ministers

this publication presents a comprehensive discussion on the impact of the global financial crisis 2008 2009 on certain asian economies at different levels of analysis showcasing cross country regression computable general equilibrium modeling and microeconomic modeling for bangladesh indonesia pakistan the philippines and viet nam using different measures of remittances cross country regression analyses suggest that a 10 increase in remittances leads to a 3 4 rise in real gross domestic product per capita at the same time the analyses show that remittances exert a negative impact on aggregate poverty moreover these money transfers from abroad exert important impacts on the macroeconomy that include improving external current accounts alleviating debt burdens appreciation of domestic currencies and moderating inflation

this sophisticated book by internationally renowned theorist zaki laidi tackles the problem of individual identity in a rapidly changing global political environment he argues that it is increasingly hard to find meaning in our ever expanding world especially after the collapse of political ideologies such as communism with the breakup of countries such as the former yugoslavia it is clear that people are now looking to old models like nationalism and ethnicity to help them forge an identity but how effective are these old certainties in a globalized world in a permanent state of flux
