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a reporter for the los angeles times once noted that i love lucy is said to be on the air somewhere in the world 24 hours a day that lucy s madcap antics can be watched anywhere at any time is thanks to television syndication a booming global marketplace that imports and exports tv shows programs from different countries are packaged bought and sold all over the world under the watch of an industry that is extraordinarily lucrative for major studios and production companies in global tv denise d bielb and c lee harrington seek to understand the machinery of this marketplace its origins and history its inner workings and its product management in so doing they are led to explore the cultural significance of this global trade and to ask how it is so remarkably successful despite the inherent cultural differences between shows and local audiences how do culture specific genres like american soap operas and latin telenovelas so easily cross borders and adapt to new cultural surroundings why is the nanny whose gum chewing star is from queens new york a smash in italy importantly bielby and harrington also ask which kinds of shows fail what is lost in translation considering such factors as censorship and other such state specific policies what are the inevitable constraints of crossing over highly experienced in the field bielby and harrington provide a unique and richly textured look at global

television through a cultural lens one that has an undeniable and complex effect on what shows succeed and which do not on an international scale

be better prepared for significant responsibilities and decision making in world affairs with this in mind they founded the council on foreign relations in other words a group of elites created a government independent of our elected government diplomats financiers generals and lawyers created their own government in 1921 which continues to operate and circumvent our elected government to this very day readers will learn from this book that the council on foreign relations the establishment the deep state and the shadow government are all one and the same their goal is a corporate controlled one world government and it appears as if the majority of our representatives are serving them many americans are just recently becoming aware of and thus concerned with the establishments green new deal and are totally unaware that it is already the law of the land via executive order no 12852 in 1993 president bill clinton damned the united states with the creation of the president s council on sustainable development which is the original title for the green new deal

this is the first book to comprehensibly describe how technology has shaped society and the environment over the last 200 years it will be useful for researchers as a textbook for graduate students for people engaged in long term policy planning in industry and government for environmental activists and for the wider public interested in history technology or environmental issues

from the conflicts over the north american free trade agreement nafta and the world trade organization to concern over illegal immigration and debates over the official status of the english language politicians and citizens have been reconsidering fundamental questions about american society s role in a changing global arena applying concepts derived from the study of international and comparative politics edward s cohen offers a systematic analysis of the impact of globalization on united states domestic politics focusing on the obvious issue of trade and the less obvious areas of immigration and language policy cohen demonstrates that globalization is both the cause and result of a new relationship between the government corporations and citizens within the united states globalization has led to the formation of new political divisions and coalitions and has caused deepening conflicts over the purposes and goals of american politics the outcome of these conflicts cohen argues will determine the future of american political life showing that globalization has transformed the priorities and responsibilities of sovereign states rather than hastening their demise the book will interest politicians policymakers and students looking for a discussion of globalization that is grounded in the recent political history of the united states

opportunity is the hidden factor that explains why so many solutions proposed for today s problems will fall far wide off the mark conventional and expensive proposals to solve many of the critical issues of our times including energy climate change commoditization the demographic inversion population and conflict will almost certainly go far astray if the element of opportunity is disregarded conventional forecasts still take no account of what we know about opportunity uncertainty and risk changing circumstances inevitably create unforeseen opportunities the error is compounded when policies lock societies into large commitments that fail to respect intrinsic uncertainty or unseen feedback effects the author is an expert in the use of options theory and decision analysis in technology investment these analytical tools are applied to the large issues of our times in this book the desire for energy independence halting climate change the commoditization of industry graying societies and the resolution of human conflict while disastrous policy prescriptions are hardly new to history modern societies are doing far too little to use what they now know

recognition of these basic errors will create competitive advantage for individual investors businesses and nations smart enough to avoid the pitfalls of the accepted wisdom dr boer s principles of opportunity 1 keep the investment at risk low while the uncertainties are still high 2 the information needed to evaluate risk is the top priority 3 things change maintain your options and postpone large commitments 4 break the investment process into a series of stages each with an exit option 5 when risk is reasonable large investments can be considered and options can be converted to assets

culture how to make it work in a world of hybrids offers a compelling and original way to think about promoting connections across human differences in our global society this book provides a fresh vision for the core anthropological concept of culture one attuned to our contemporary global society where people receive hybrid cultural influences from many places in many ways providing a stimulating look at one of the most basic topics in social science it is written without academic jargon is rich in humor and is replete with provocative examples making it accessible to undergraduate students in anthropology and other social sciences as well as to scholars and non academic readers in fields where the fostering of intercultural or as this book argues inter hybrid communications is vital michael agar explores two meanings of culture culture as a label for the beliefs and practices of a specific group and culture as marking the boundary between modern humans and our ancestors together with the rest of the animal kingdom although this book acknowledges that that boundary has changed to a slippery slope by looking back at the emergence of language and culture through a broad range of the social and natural sciences those human universals that make connections across human differences possible as well as those that constrain that ability are identified this book concludes with a discussion of social perspective taking as a promising approach toward the development of a shared languaculture by any group of diverse hybrid humans who need to work together to accomplish whatever task is at hand
