providing the latest information on preventive diagnostic and therapeutic aspects of tuberculosis and aids this is the only book to place a major emphasis on the increasing coexistence of these two life threatening diseases in individuals edited by outstanding scientists in the field this ready reference is divided into three main sections covering immunology and vaccination strategies drugs and clinical issues timely reading for microbiologists virologists bacteriologists immunologists and pathophysiologists as well as for the pharmaceutical and biotechnological industries

due to the interrelated impacts of tuberculosis and hiv diseases the who has recognised that additional interventions are urgently needed to support the directly observed treatment dots strategy for tb control tackling tb should include tackling hiv as the most potent force driving the tb epidemic whilst tackling hiv should include tackling tb as the leading killer of people living with hiv aids this publication sets out a framework for tb hiv treatment in the western pacific region which carries up to one third of the global tb burden drawing upon the who global framework and building upon the strengths of individual national tb and aids programmes in the region

the global fund to fight aids tuberculosis and malaria was created in 2001 to increase funding to tackle three of the world's most devastating diseases it has approved 14.1 billion for programmes in 150 countries provided aids treatment for 3.3 million people anti tuberculosis treatment for 8.6 million people and 230 million insecticide treated nets for the prevention of malaria the uk is the global fund's third highest donor and ministers had committed over a year ago to increase funds to it but this money has not yet been delivered nor the amount of the increase confirmed the committee is concerned by the delay in delivering funds and is calling for the uk to increase its contribution to the global fund significantly over and above the current 384m pledge for 2012 to 2015 subject to reform the committee says that the g20 meeting in mexico provides a good opportunity for the uk to announce new funds but only if conditions are met and uk taxpayers money is adequately safeguarded the global fund has had a difficult year with financial problems corruption scandals and the resignation of its director confidence in the fund was affected with some countries temporarily suspending payments and the global fund had to cancel a round of grants totalling some 930m however the mps say that the global fund has made good progress under its new management to reform the organisation's structures and financial risk monitoring in may 2012 the global fund announced some 630 million in new funds

this manual is designed for health professionals working in high hiv and tb prevalence countries it summarises the characteristics of both diseases and their interactions it concentrates particularly on the problems of diagnosis and management both in adults and children and summarises the other hiv related illnesses the clinician might encounter
