an encyclopedia of tennessee genealogy acklen's bible records and marriage bonds is one of the foremost tennessee source books in print it consists almost entirely of records of births marriages and deaths plus marriage licenses of dickson knox lebanon and wilson counties sections devoted exclusively to marriages generally run chronologically giving exact dates and full names of brides and grooms the bible records however offer the most substantial evidence of family connections and in the manner of such records are actually organic family records listing names and dates of birth marriage and death through several generations depending of course on the extent to which a particular bible was handed on in the family and kept up to date the work is complemented by a surname index of nearly 15 000 entries

carter county was formed in 1796 by the general assembly of north carolina it was created out of the eastern part of washington county an early county originally formed in 1777 the watauga settlement was located in present day carter county at the time of the creation its eastern boundary was the north carolina line its northwestern boundary was sullivan county to and its northern boundary was washington county va

the author traces his lashbrook ancestors back seven generations and his taylor ancestors back through eight generations william lashbrooke the author s 5th great grandfather who was born on 17 october 1717 in meeth in devon england immigrated to the u s from devonshire in 1738 as a bonded passenger criminal on a ship named forward isaac taylor the author s 6th great grandfather who was born on 8 october 1710 in county antrim northern ireland immigrated to the u s from ireland around 1741 details on children and grandchildren are included when known the author also includes facts about the times and places where they lived as well as weaving their life stories into local history when he believes it will

add value details on living persons is limited or intentionally excluded extensive references are included as footnotes and an all name index lists each person along with page numbers where they are found

dr nathaniel edens hyder 1849 1904 intended to write a history of carter county for young people in 1903 a number of his articles did appear in the local newspaper but due to a premature death he did not reach his goal adding to his research and notes mildred kozsuch has compiled an interesting fact filled volume with an index of more than 2000 names numerous photographs accompany the anecdotes observations and transcriptions of historic documents a special section at the end of the volume contains brief sketches of carter county communities and families
