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fabricating modern societies education bodies and minds in the age of steel edited by karin priem and frederik herman offers new interdisciplinary and transnational perspectives on the history of industrialization and societal transformation in early twentieth century luxembourg the individual chapters focus on how industrialists addressed a large array of challenges related to industrialization borrowing and mixing ideas originating in domains such as corporate identity formation mediatization scientification technological innovation mechanization capitalism mass production medicalization educationalization artistic production and social utopia while competing with other interest groups who pursued their own goals the book looks at different focus areas of modernity and analyzes how humans created mediated and interacted with the technospheres of modern societies contributors klaus dittrich irma hadzalic frederik herman enric novella ira plein françoise poos karin priem and angelo van gorp

making modern lives looks at how young people shape their lives as they move through their secondary school years and into the world beyond it explores how they develop dispositions attitudes identities and orientations in modern society based on an eight year study consisting of more than 350 in depth interviews with young australians from diverse backgrounds the book reveals the effects of schooling and of local school cultures on young people s choices future plans political values friendships and attitudes toward school work and sense of self making modern lives uncovers who young people are today what type of identities and inequalities are being formed and reformed and what processes and politics are at work in relation to gender class race and the framing of vocational futures

investigates how architecture technology politics and urban planning came together in french architect victor baltard s creation of the central markets of paris presents a case study of the historical process that produced modern paris between 1840 and 1870

since its early days of mass production in the 1850s the sewing machine has been intricately connected with the global development of capitalism andrew gordon traces the machine s remarkable journey into and throughout japan where it not only transformed manners of dress but also helped change patterns of daily life class structure and the role of women as he explores the selling buying and use of the sewing machine in the early to mid twentieth century gordon finds that its history is a lens through which we can examine the modern transformation of daily life in japan both as a tool of production and as an object of consumer desire the sewing machine is entwined with the emergence and ascendance of the middle class of the female consumer and of the professional home manager as defining elements of japanese modernity

the papers assembled here share the dual conviction that 1 understanding the lineaments of japanese modernity entails an appreciation of the specific forms of distinctions discriminations and exclusions constitutive of it 2 that the socio economic political fractures increasingly visible under conditions of late modernity reveal the precarious nature of the making of modernity in japan bringing together a group of critical intellectuals mostly based in japan with long standing political commitments to groups emblematic of modern japan s constitutive outside inorities migrants foreigners victims of the fukushima disaster welfare recipients among others this collection of essays aims to draw attention to processes of making and unmaking that constellate japanese modernity unlike previous attempts however devoted to destabilizing positivist culturalist approaches to a post war miracle japan via a critical post structural theoretical vocabulary and episteme the essays gathered here aim principally to examine traces of the making of modern japan in the fissures and displacements visible at sites of modernity s unmaking deploying a range of theoretical approaches rather than a commitment to any single framework the essays that follow aim to locate contemporary japan and the ravages of its modernity within a wider critical discourse of modernity

the little known stories of the people responsible for what we know today as modern medical ethics in making modern medical ethics robert baker tells the counter history of the birth of bioethics bringing to the fore the stories of the dissenters and whistleblowers who challenged the establishment drawing on his earlier work on moral revolutions and the history of medical ethics robert baker traces the history of modern medical ethics and its bioethical turn to the moral insurrections incited by the many unsung dissenters and whistleblowers african american civil rights leaders jewish americans harboring holocaust memories feminists women and anglo american physicians and healthcare professionals who were veterans of the world wars the cold war and the vietnam war the standard narrative for bioethics typically emphasizes the morally disruptive medical technologies of the latter part of the twentieth century such as the dialysis machine the electroencephalograph and the ventilator as they created the need to reconsider traditional notions of medical ethics baker however tells a fresh narrative one that has historically been neglected e g the story of the medical veterans who founded an international medical organization to rescue medicine and biomedical research from the scandal of nazi medicine and also reveals the penalties that moral change agents paid e g the stubborn bureaucrat who was demoted for her insistence on requiring and enforcing research subjects informed consent analyzing major statements of modern medical ethics from the 1946 1947 nuremberg doctors trials and nuremberg code to a patient s bill of rights making modern medical ethics is a winning history of just how respect and autonomy for patients and research subjects came to be codified
