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born in adwa tigray ethiopia a semi rural town with limited infrastructure but rich in history and culture assefa wondim inherited his parents legacy and used it to mold his children zantai my life story describes among others his birthplace ancestry upbringing and how he raised his children including how he viewed education for his children his goals for them the style of his parental control his commitment to meeting his children s needs and his involvement in his children s lives and activities also the opportunities and challenges he encountered in life are described in the book this book may bring nostalgia to those whose upbringing was in adwa the history geography culture and their school life in that beautiful town it may also give the young generation an insight into what adwa looked like in the 1950s through the early 1970s

biographies are not just for celebrities normal people s lives your own in fact can be much more fascinating and interesting the aim of this book is to help you celebrate your life and those who are special to you taken a step at a time maybe just writing a few episodes of your life you will see that writing your life story is not as daunting as it first appears indeed it can be great fun you need have no writing experience at all writing at its best is simply speaking on paper

runner ron jones was one of the all time greats of welsh athletics with 28 welsh sprint records 12 welsh titles and four commonwealth games to his name he captained the british athletics team at the 1968 olympics before going on to become the first chief executive of an english soccer club

konrad zuse is one of the great pioneers of the computer age he created the first fully automated program controlled freely programmable computer using binary floating point calculation it was operational in 1941 he built his first machines in berlin during the second

world war with bombs falling all around and after the war he built up a company that was taken over by siemens in 1967 zuse was an inventor in the traditional style full of phantastic ideas but also gifted with a powerful analytical mind single handedly he developed one of the first programming languages the plan calculus including features copied only decades later in other languages he wrote numerous books and articles and won many honors and awards this is his autobiography written in an engagingly lively and pleasant style full of anecdotes reminiscences and philosophical asides it traces his life from his childhood in east prussia through tense wartime experiences and hard times building up his business after the war to a ripe old age and well earned celebrity

i dedicate this book to my father and mother without them i would not have become the person i am i was born in 1938 to a wonderful set of parents my mother and father were people who gave of themselves they instilled so many virtues in me that i am very thankful for to my family who had to put up with me through the good times and the bad to everyone that i have met along the way while i was following my life s path and most of all to god whose help has given me the desire for knowledge and the courage to follow my heart without that i would not have accomplished the things i ve done

from time to time we all tend to wonder what sort of story our life might comprise what it means where it is going and whether it hangs together as a whole in the stories we are william lowell randall explores the links between literature and life and speculates on the range of storytelling styles through which people compose their lives in doing so he draws on a variety of fields including psychology psychotherapy theology philosophy feminist theory and literary theory using categories like plot character point of view and style randall plays with the possibility that we each make sense of the events of our lives to the extent that we weave them into our own unfolding novel as simultaneously its author narrator main character and reader in the process he offers us a unique perspective on features of our day to day world such as secrecy self deception gossip prejudice intimacy maturity and the proverbial art of living first published in 1995 this second edition of the stories we are includes a new preface and afterword by the author that offer insight into his argument and evolution as a scholar as well as an illuminating foreword by ruthellen josselson

from the moment mathell givens was born in 1952 in illinois god began sending angels in this heartfelt autobiography givens narrates her life story and describes the angels who rescued her during her times of need beginning at birth givens path was not an easy one but she credits both her faith in god and the angels in her life for her blessed existence today in angels in my life givens details the many painful hurdles she s overcome from being preyed upon by a pedophile as a young girl to experiencing a teen pregnancy dealing with an unfaithful spouse raising three boys as a single mother and coping with an array of health problems but through all of her trials and tests givens has remained steadfast and true in her devotion to god a personal testament to god s saving grace angels in my life tells an inspirational story of faith and love

according to the centers for disease control and prevention 17.5 million americans suffer from clinical depression each year more than 132,000 people will consider suicide as a way out of depression and over 30,000 of them will succeed the author became a statistic of the first two categories and was miraculously saved from the third ironically he was reborn to a new reality through the intervention of a terminally ill friend as he wrote his school aged son a desperate suicide letter consequently the note changed course and became this book the author describes his decent and climb from depression to his son in heartbreaking detail from his childhood in the tough streets of philadelphia to his battle with cancer the deaths of his sister mother and two best friends all in a relatively short period of time what makes this book unique are the strategically intertwined positive lessons that were learned while facing these tragic life altering events these lessons appropriately named life lessons are heartfelt loving messages from a father to his son illustrating what the author believes to be the truths of life and what is truly important to him today
