È a bullet misses its target in sarajevo a would be austrian painter gets into the viennese academy lord halifax becomes british prime minister in 1940 instead of churchill seemingly minor twists of fate on which world shaking events might have hinged alternative history has long been the stuff of parlor games war gaming and science fiction but over the past few decades it has become a popular stomping ground for serious historians the historian richard j evans now turns a critical slightly jaundiced eye on a subject typically the purview of armchair historians the book's main concern is examining the intellectual fallout from historical counterfactuals which the author defines as "alternative versions of the past in which one alteration in the timeline leads to a different outcome from the one we know actually occurred" Ó what if britain had stood at the sidelines during the first world war what if the wehrmacht had taken moscow the author offers an engaging and insightful introduction to the genre while discussing the reasons for its revival in popularity the role of historical determinism and the often hidden agendas of the counterfactual historian most important evans takes counterfactual history seriously looking at the insights pitfalls and intellectual implications of changing one thread in the weave of history a wonderful critical introduction to an often overlooked genre for scholars and casual readers of history alike

this provocative alternative history looks at wwii from a new angle what might have happened had the germans taken moscow in 1941 based on authentic history and real possibilities this unique speculative narrative plays out the dramatic and grotesque consequences of a third reich triumphant in this terrifyingly plausible scenario the germans fight their way into the ruins of moscow on september 30th 1941 and the soviet union collapses although russian resistance continues german ambition multiplies after this signal success they launch offensives in africa the mediterranean and the middle east hitler's armies assured of victory make their leader's dreams reality and allied hopes of recovery seem almost hopelessly doomed with a convincingly blend of

actual history and alternate events the moscow option is a chilling reminder that history might easily have been very different

drawing on more than a half century of research and teaching dennis showalter presents a fresh perspective on the german army during world war i showalter surveys an army at the heart of a national identity driven by yet also defeated by warfare in the modern age which struggled to capitalize on its victories and ultimately forgot the lessons of its defeat exploring the internal dynamics of the german army and detailing how the soldiers coped with the many new forms of warfare showalter shows how the army's institutions responded to and how germany itself was changed by war detailing the major campaigns on the western and eastern fronts and the forgotten war fought in the middle east and africa this comprehensive volume examines the army's operational strategy the complexities of campaigns of movement versus static trench warfare and the effects of changes in warfare

a new york times bestseller a new york times book review notable book of 2017 a dual biography of winston churchill and george orwell who preserved democracy from the threats of authoritarianism from the left and right alike both george orwell and winston churchill came close to death in the mid 1930 s orwell shot in the neck in a trench line in the spanish civil war and churchill struck by a car in new york city if they d died then history would scarcely remember them at the time churchill was a politician on the outs his loyalty to his class and party suspect orwell was a mildly successful novelist to put it generously no one would have predicted that by the end of the 20th century they would be considered two of the most important people in british history for having the vision and courage to campaign tirelessly in words and in deeds against the totalitarian threat from both the left and the right in a crucial moment they responded first by seeking the facts of the matter seeing through the lies and obfuscations and then they acted on their beliefs together to an extent not sufficiently appreciated they kept the west s compass set

toward freedom as its due north it s not easy to recall now how lonely a position both men once occupied by the late 1930 s democracy was discredited in many circles and authoritarian rulers were everywhere in the ascent there were some who decried the scourge of communism but saw in hitler and mussolini men we could do business with if not in fact saviors and there were others who saw the nazi and fascist threat as malign but tended to view communism as the path to salvation churchill and orwell on the other hand had the foresight to see clearly that the issue was human freedom that whatever its coloration a government that denied its people basic freedoms was a totalitarian menace and had to be resisted in the end churchill and orwell proved their age s necessary men the glorious climax of churchill and orwell is the work they both did in the decade of the 1940 s to triumph over freedom s enemies and though churchill played the larger role in the defeat of hitler and the axis orwell s reckoning with the menace of authoritarian rule in animal farm and 1984 would define the stakes of the cold war for its 50 year course and continues to give inspiration to fighters for freedom to this day taken together in thomas e ricks s masterful hands their lives are a beautiful testament to the power of moral conviction and to the courage it can take to stay true to it through thick and thin churchill and orwell is a perfect gift for the holidays

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
