this book attacks the conventional wisdom that bureaucrats are bunglers and the system can't be changed michael barzelay and babak armajani trace the source of much poor performance in government to the persistent influence of what they call the bureaucratic paradigm a theory built on such notions as central control economy and efficiency and rigid adherence to rules rarely questioned the bureaucratic paradigm leads competent and faithful public servants as well as politicians unwittingly to impair government's ability to serve citizens by weakening misplacing and misdirecting accountability how can this system be changed drawing on research sponsored by the ford foundation harvard university program on innovations in state and local government this book tells the story of how public officials in one state minnesota cast off the conceptual blinders of the bureaucratic paradigm and experimented with ideas such as customer service empowering front line employees to resolve problems and selectively introducing market forces within government the author highlights the arguments government executives made for the changes they proposed traces the way these changes were implemented and summarizes the impressive results this approach provides would be bureaucracy busters with a powerful method for dramatically improving the way government manages the public's business generalizing from the minnesota experience and from similar efforts nationwide the book proposes a new paradigm that will reframe the perennial debate on public management with its carefully analyzed ideas real life examples and closely reasoned practical advice breaking through bureaucracy is indispensable to public managers and students of public policy and administration

this book explores contemporary and historical examples of bureaucratic discretion to describe a continuum of resistance to authoritative directives by hierarchical superiors resistance ranges from blind obedience or complete nonresistance to street level opposition in between these extremes however are minimal compliance and resistance sanctioned by immediate superiors although politicians may pass legislation the subject of bureaucratic implementation or lack thereof remains an area of vital concern grounded in administrative theory beginning with woodrow wilson s seminal discussion of the virtue of adopting a businesslike approach to american governing and emphasizing the power of street level bureaucrats the aim of this book is to expand awareness of the potentially dangerous power of insulated bureaucrats

in this work of intellectual history the author identifies four transformations in federal government that followed the new deal the rise of the administrative state the erosion of federalism the ascendance of the modern presidency and the development of modern judicial review he then considers how schools of conservative thought traditionalists neoconservatives libertarians straussians responded to each transformation

during the early 1990s the department of justice used its voting rights act power to object to racially unfair redistricting laws to force states to maximize minority congressional districts the results were dramatic congressional black caucus membership swelled from 25 to 38 and nine new hispanic congresspersons were sworn in only three years later the maximization strategy lay in ruins the courts forced many of the new minority districts to be redrawn and the judiciary reserved especially harsh criticism for the department cunningham examines and analyzes how the department came to adopt the maximization strategy he explores the bureaucratic culture of the division s voting section its history and the interaction of its progressive career staff with more conservative political appointees the division works amidst a vibrant interest group environment with civil rights advocates the state and political parties eager for influence cunningham shows how that influence contest was won by the civil rights groups how their preferred interpretations of fair redistricting and discriminatory purpose were adopted by the division and how their chosen districting models were forced upon states by the division he examines the effect the department has had on federalism representation and its own impaired credibility with the judiciary finally he suggests how the division might resurrect its damaged reputation for balanced enforcement an important study for scholars students and public policy makers involved with civil rights public administration and public law
