originating from a small group of bible students who met under charles taze russell s leadership and grew into an international society to which the second leader

joseph franklin rutherford and gave the name jehovah s witnesses two world wars shaped watch tower attitudes to civil government armed conflict and medical innovations such as blood transfusion as well as to mainstream churches the twenty first century has seen some important changes in the watch tower organization and coverage is given to changes in organizational structure its use of the world wide and its major relocation from brooklyn to warwick this updated second edition of historical dictionary of jehovah s witnesses contains a chronology an introduction and an extensive bibliography the dictionary section has over 300 cross referenced entries on key concepts themes and people relating to jehovah s witnesses this book is an excellent resource for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about jehovah s witnesses

this book first published in 1956 is the first authoritative comprehensive account of the worldwide activities of jehovah s witnesses it traces their origins and development and a special section covers the founding organization and development of the movement in great britain

originating from a small group of bible students led by charles taze russell in the 1870s the watch tower society grew into an international society after russell s death in 1916 franklin rutherford was named his successor and gave the society a new name jehovah s witnesses the a to z of jehovah s witnesses shows how world war i ii influenced watch tower attitudes to civil government armed conflict and medical innovations like blood transfusion as well as to mainstream churches and the development of jehovah s witnesses door to door evangelism the theme of prophecy the doctrine of the 144 000 end time calculations armageddon and the witnesses denial of hell are all considered in the a to z of jehovah s witnesses which contains a chronology an introductory essay a bibliography and 250 cross referenced dictionary entries relating to key people and concepts

emily b baran offers a gripping history of how a small american based religious community the jehovah s witnesses found its way into the soviet union after world war ii survived decades of brutal persecution and emerged as one of the region s fastest growing religions after the soviet union s collapse in 1991 in telling the story of this often misunderstood faith baran explores the shifting boundaries of religious dissent non conformity and human rights in the soviet union and its successor states soviet jehovah s witnesses are a fascinating case study of dissent beyond urban intellectual nonconformists witnesses who were generally rural poorly educated and utterly marginalized from society resisted state pressure to conform they instead constructed alternative communities based on adherence to religious principles established by the witnesses international center in brooklyn new york the soviet state considered witnesses to be the most reactionary of all underground religious movements and used extraordinary measures to try to eliminate this threat yet witnesses survived while the soviet system did not after 1991 they faced continuing challenges to their right to practice their faith in post soviet states as these states struggled to reconcile the proper limits on freedom of conscience with european norms and domestic concerns dissent on the margins provides a new and important perspective on one of america s most understudied religious movements

what would happen if i accepted an invitation to bible study from jehovah s witnesses what would attending a kingdom hall meeting involve and if i invited door knocking witnesses into my home this book introduces jehovah s witnesses without assuming prior knowledge of the watch tower organization after outlining the society s origins and history the book explains their key beliefs and practices by taking the reader through the process of the seeker who makes initial contact with witnesses and progresses to take instruction and become a baptized member the book then explores what is involved in being a witness congregational life lifestyle

rites of passage their understanding of the bible and prophetic expectations it examines the various processes and consequences of leaving the organization controversies that have arisen in the course of its history and popular criticisms discussion is given to the likelihood of reforms within the organization such as its stance on blood transfusions the role of women and new methods of meeting and evangelizing in response to the covid 19 pandemic

this is the first major study of the enigmatic religious society by examining the jehovah s witnesses dramatic recent expansion andrew holden reveals the dependency of their quasi totalitarian movement on the physical and cultural resources have brought about the privatization of religion the erosion of community and the separation of fact from faith

isis allthings felt numb as she gripped the arms of her airline seat she was catapulting herself and her four year old daughter into the unknown away from her religion five year marriage and the country she had settled in bavaria at age thirty two isis was on a courageous journey to begin a new life in her native country england where she rebelled against every belief and lie she had been taught since childhood in a compelling true story isis leads others into her past as she analyses the vulnerability that led to her mother s recruitment into the jehovah s witnesses after describing her own absorption into this secretive organization at the age of ten and subsequent life as a full time minister she divulges how personal sacrifices eventually led to her hard won freedom as a free spirit

while millions of americans were defending liberty against the nazis liberty was under vicious attack at home one of the worst outbreaks of religious persecution in u s history occurred during world war ii when jehovah s witnesses were intimidated beaten and even imprisoned for refusing to salute the flag or serve in the armed forces determined to claim their first amendment rights jehovah s witnesses waged a tenacious legal campaign that led to twenty three supreme court rulings between 1938 and 1946 now shawn peters has written the first complete account of the personalities events and institutions behind those cases showing that they were more than vindication for unpopular beliefs they were also a turning point in the nation s constitutional commitment to individual rights peters begins with the story of william gobitas a jehovah s witness whose children refused to salute the flag at school he follows this famous case to the supreme court where he captures the intellectual sparring between justices frankfurter and stone over individual liberties then he describes the aftermath of the court s ruling against gobitas when angry mobs savagely assaulted jehovah s witnesses in hundreds of communities across america judging jehovah s witnesses tells how persecution much of it directed by members of patriotic organizations like the american legion touched the lives of witnesses of all ages why the justice department and state officials ignored the witnesses pleas for relief and how the aclu and liberal clergymen finally stepped forward to help them drawing on interviews with witnesses and extensive research in aclu archives he examines the strategies that beleaguered witnesses used to combat discrimination and goes beyond the familiar supreme court rulings by analyzing more obscure lower court decisions as well by vigorously pursuing their cause the witnesses helped to inaugurate an era in which individual and minority rights emerged as matters of concern for the supreme court and foreshadowed events in the civil rights movement like the classics gideon s trumpet and simple justice judging jehovah s witnesses vividly narrates a moving human drama while reminding us of the true meaning of our constitution and the rights it protects
