wherever the european has trod death seems to pursue the aboriginal so wrote charles darwin in 1836 though there has been considerable discussion concerning their precise demographic impact reflected in the articles here there is no doubt that the arrival of new diseases with the europeans such as typhus and smallpox had a catastrophic effect on the indigenous population of the americas and later of the pacific in the americas malaria and yellow fever also came with the slaves from africa themselves imported to work the depopulated land these diseases placed europeans at risk too and with some resistance to both disease pools africans could have a better chance of survival also covered here is the controversy over the origins of syphilis while the final essays look at agricultural consequences of the european expansion in terms of nutrition both in north america and in europe

this book provides a conceptually organized framework to understand the phenomenon of biological invasions at the anthropocene global scale most advances toward that aim have been provided from north american and european researchers with fewer contributions from australia and south africa here we fill the void from the neotropics focusing on the research experience in south american countries with a strong emphasis on argentina and chile the text is divided into two parts the first half comprises self contained chapters providing a conceptual bibliographic and empirical foundation in the field of invasion biology from an anthropocene perspective the second half reviews the ecology biogeography and local impacts in south america of exotic species groups european rabbit eurasian wild boar canadian beaver north american mink and holarctic freshwater fishes which are shown to be useful models for case studies of global relevance

south american camelids llamas alpacas vicuñas and guanacos are receiving increased interest not only in south america but also on a worldwide scale they possess some unique features such as their fine fibre and healthy meat and their high adaptivity to many climatic regions across the world apart from the important productive aspects their physical attractiveness and friendly temperament also makes them popular as pet animals there are still many gaps in the scientific literature with regard to south american camelids in part this gap can be diminished by this collection of papers which brings the experience of both european and south american researchers working together the main themes considered in this book are the following nutrition and feeding meat production and the meat market ecology fibre production and the fibre market animal breeding animal health and pathology and socio economical aspects the particular advantages of south american camelids for the sustainable use of fragile ecosystems with native pastures are also outlined south american camelids research is aimed at scientists and animal breeders as well as students studying veterinary animal and applied biological sciences it can be of further reference to farmers and traders of fibre and meat products please note that most articles are written in spanish
