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the complete cambridge history of latin america presents a large scale authoritative survey of latin america s unique historical experience from the first contacts between the native american indians and europeans to the present day colonial spanish america is a selection of chapters from volumes i and ii brought together to provide a continuous history of the spanish empire in america from the late fifteenth to the early nineteenth centuries the first three chapters deal with conquest and settlement and relations

between spain and its american empire the final six with urban development mining rural economy and society including the formation of the hacienda the internal economy and the impact of spanish rule on indian societies bibliographical essays are included for all chapters the book will be a valuable text for both students and teachers of latin american history

volume 13 of the handbook of middle american indians published in cooperation with the middle american research institute of tulane university under the general editorship of robert wauchope 1909 1979 constitutes part 2 of the guide to ethnohistorical sources the guide has been assembled under the volume editorship of the late howard f cline director of the hispanic foundation in the library of congress with charles gibson john b glass and h b nicholson as associate volume editors it covers geography and ethnogeography volume 12 sources in the european tradition volume 13 and sources in the native tradition volumes 14 and 15 the present volume contains the following studies on sources in the european tradition published collections of documents relating to middle american ethnohistory by charles gibson an introductory survey of secular writings in the european tradition on colonial middle america 1503 1818 by j benedict warren religious chroniclers and historians a summary with annotated bibliography by ernest j burrus s j bernardino de sahuagún by luis nicolau d olwer howard f cline and h b nicholson antonio de herrera by manuel ballesteros gaibrois juan de torquemada by josé alcina franch francisco javier clavigero by charles e ronan s j charles etienne brasseur de bourbourg by carroll edward mace hubert howe bancroft by howard f cline eduard georg seler by h b nicholson selected nineteenth century mexican writers on ethnohistory by howard f cline the handbook of middle american indians was assembled and edited at the middle american research institute of tulane university with the assistance of grants from the national science foundation and under the sponsorship of the national research council committee on latin american anthropology

this book is part of an encyclopedia set concerning the environment archaeology ethnology social anthropology ethnohistory linguistics and physical anthropology of the native peoples of mexico and central america the guide to ethnohistorical sources is comprised of volumes 12 15 of this set volume 13 presents a look at pre columbian mesoamerican from a combined historical and anthropological viewpoint using official ecclesiastical and government records from the time

annually published since 1930 the international bibliography of historical sciences ibohs is an international bibliography of the most important historical monographs and periodical articles published throughout the world which deal with history from the earliest to the most recent times the works are arranged systematically according to period region or historical discipline and within this classification alphabetically the bibliography contains a geographical index and indexes of persons and authors

the story of seville's archive of the indies reveals how current views of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries are based on radical historical revisionism in spain in the late 1700s the invention of the colonial americas is an architectural history and media archaeological study of changing theories and practices of government archives in enlightenment spain it centers on an archive created in seville for storing spain's pre 1760 documents about the new world to fill this new archive older archives elsewhere in spain spaces in which records about american history were stored together with records about european history were dismembered the archive of the indies thus constructed a scholarly apparatus that made it easier to imagine the history of the americas as independent from the history of europe and vice versa in this meticulously researched book byron ellsworth hamann explores how building layouts systems of storage and the arrangement of documents were designed to foster the creation of new knowledge he draws on a rich collection of eighteenth century architectural plans descriptions models document catalogs and surviving buildings to present a literal materially precise account of archives as assemblages of spaces humans and data assemblages that were understood circa 1800 as capable of actively generating scholarly innovation

this volume gathers together recent research from leading scholars specializing in the history of collecting american southern art collections both public and private contain rich and representative holdings of renaissance and baroque art which remain understudied compared to the collections bracketing the east and west coasts of the united states this anthology considers how these works of art were acquired for both prominent public and private collections how they have been curated and displayed in exhibitions and how they have also been preserved historically individual essays address a variety of art media representative of the early modern period in europe and the americas case studies of specific works of art collections and collectors address the broad geographic scope of southern collections inclusive of washington dc the carolinas georgia alabama louisiana arkansas and texas

a companion to latin american literature and culture the work contains a wealth of information that must surely provide the basic material for a number of study modules it should find a place on the library shelves of all institutions where latin american studies form part of the curriculum reference review in short this is a fascinating panoply that goes from a reevaluation of pre columbian america to an intriguing consideration of recent developments in the debate on the modern and postmodern summing up recommended choice a companion to latin american literature and culture reflects the changes that have taken place in cultural theory and literary criticism since the latter part of the twentieth century written by more than thirty experts in cultural theory literary history and literary criticism this authoritative and up to date reference places major authors in the complex cultural and historical contexts that have compelled their distinctive fiction essays and poetry this allows the reader to more accurately interpret the esteemed but demanding literature of authors such as jorge luis borges mario vargas llosa octavio paz and diamela

elit key authors whose work has defined a period or defied borders as in the cases of sor juana inés de la cruz césar vallejo and gabriel garcía márquez are also discussed in historical and theoretical context additional essays engage the reader with in depth discussions of forms and genres and discussions of architecture music and film this text provides the historical background to help the reader understand the people and culture that have defined latin american literature and its reception each chapter also includes short selected bibliographic guides and recommendations for further reading

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this comprehensive reconstruction and interpretation of louise and walter arensberg s groundbreaking collection of modern and pre columbian art takes readers room by room wall by wall object by object through the couple s los angeles home in which their collection was displayed following the armory show of 1913 louise and walter arensberg began assembling one of the most important private collections of art in the united states as well as the world s largest private library of works by and about the philosopher sir francis bacon by the time louise and walter died in 1953 and 1954 respectively they had acquired some four thousand rare books and manuscripts and nearly one thousand works of art including world class specimens of cubism surrealism and primitivism the bulk of marcel duchamp s oeuvre and hundreds of pre columbian objects these exceptional works filled nearly all available space in every room of their house including the bathrooms the arensbergs have long had a central role in the histories of modernism and collecting but images of their collection in situ have never been assembled or examined comprehensively until now presenting new research on how the arensbergs acquired pre columbian art and featuring never before seen images hollywood arensberg demonstrates the value of seeing the arensbergs collection as part of a single vision framed by a unique domestic space at the heart of hollywood s burgeoning artistic scene this publication has been generously supported by furthermore a program of the j m kaplan fund

in the hands of the state music is a political tool the banda de música del estado de oaxaca state band of oaxaca bme a civil organization nearly as old as the modern state of oaxaca itself offers unique insights into the history of a modern political state in the inevitable bandstand charles v heath examines the bme s role as a part of popular political culture that the state of oaxaca has deployed in an attempt to bring unity and order to its domain the bme has always served multiple functions it arose from musical groups that accompanied military forces as they trained and fought today it performs at village patron saint days and at mexico s patriotic celebrations propagating religions both sacred and civic it offers education in the ways of liberal democracy to its population once largely illiterate and finally it provides respite from the burdens of life by performing at strictly diversionary functions such as serenades and sunday matinees in each of these government sanctioned roles the bme serves to unify educate and entertain the diverse and fragmented elements within the state of oaxaca thereby mirroring the historical trajectory of the state of oaxaca and the nation of mexico from the pre hispanic and spanish colonial eras to the nascent mexican republic from a militarized and fractured young nation to a consolidated postrevolutionary socialist state and from a predominantly catholic entity to an ostensibly secular one

the metropolitan museum s preeminent collection of early colonial furniture is expertly documented in this long awaited publication it covers the full spectrum of furniture forms made during the 17th and early 18th centuries from chairs and other seating to tables boxes various types of chests and cupboards and desks each of the 141 objects is thoroughly described with detailed information on provenance construction condition inscriptions dimensions and materials photographed anew in color for this volume each piece is explicated in terms of the styles and craftsmanship of the period and is evaluated in light of comparative pieces in public and private collections throughout the country one appendix contains photographic details of construction and decorative elements and another has drawings of joints and moldings

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
