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how creative freedom race class and gender shaped the rebellion of two visionary artists postwar america experienced an unprecedented flourishing of avant garde and independent art across the arts artists rebelled against traditional conventions embracing a commitment to creative autonomy and personal vision never before witnessed in the united states paul lopes calls this the heroic age of american art and identifies two artists miles davis and martin scorsese as two of its leading icons in this compelling book lopes tells the story of how a pair of talented and outspoken art rebels defied prevailing conventions to elevate american jazz and film to unimagined critical heights during the heroic age of american art where creative independence and the unrelenting pressures of success were constantly at odds davis

and scorsese became influential figures with such modern classics as kind of blue and raging bull their careers also reflected the conflicting ideals of and contentious debates concerning avant garde and independent art during this period in examining their art and public stories lopes also shows how their rebellions as artists were intimately linked to their racial and ethnic identities and how both artists adopted hypermasculine ideologies that exposed the problematic intersection of gender with their racial and ethnic identities as iconic art rebels art rebels is the essential account of a new breed of artists who left an indelible mark on american culture in the second half of the twentieth century it is an unforgettable portrait of two iconic artists who exemplified the complex interplay of the quest for artistic autonomy and the expression of social identity during the heroic age of american art

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the great art hoax exposes the real fakery and hypocrisy of the art world how art is manufactured and marketed how the pathology of private possession drives up the price and how false art is hyped as true art to the tune of millions of dollars jon huer demonstrates convincingly that what the art market deals as art need not be art at all

in 1910 pablo picasso began a series of 11 decorative paintings intended for the brooklyn residence of american artist collector and critic hamilton easter field this publication is the

first in depth examination of this commission which despite never being completed offers new insights into a little known chapter in picasso s art that coincided with a critical moment in the development of cubism based on new research including letters and archival material from both picasso and field this book shows how the unrealized commission challenged picasso to move beyond easel painting and adapt cubist forms to an immersive aesthetic experience authors investigate the progression of cubist ideas and show how picasso used easter field s proposal as a place of experimentation by both subverting and paying homage to decorative painting traditions published to coincide with celebration picasso marking the fiftieth anniversary of the artist s death this compact volume provides a compelling look at what might have been as well as a fascinating portrait of art and patronage in the early twentieth century

with a bracing mix of fresh research incisive reportage and personal candor hall uncovers the causes and effects of society s bias against shortness and reveals how short people can and do thrive in spite of this insidious bigotry

this anthology provides a single volume overview of the essential theoretical debates in the anthropology of art drawing together significant work in the field from the second half of the

twentieth century it enables readers to appreciate the art of different cultures at different times advances a cross cultural concept of art that moves beyond traditional distinctions between western and non western art provides the basis for the appreciation of art of different cultures and times enhances readers appreciation of the aesthetics of art and of the important role it plays in human society

federico fellini professed a desire to create an entire film made of immobile pictures in this study hava aldouby uses this quotation as a launching point to analyze fellini s films as sequences of pictures that draw extensively on art history and particularly painting as a reservoir of visual imagery aldouby employs an innovative pictorial approach that allows her to uncover a wealth of visual evocations overlooked by fellini scholars over the years federico fellini painting in film painting on film sheds light on the intertextual links between fellini s films and the works of various artists from velazquez to francis bacon by identifying references to specific paintings in his films using new archival evidence from fellini s private library brought to light for the first time here aldouby draws out fellini s in depth knowledge of art history and his systematic employment of art historical allusions

a sophisticated treatment of major ideas in art and philosophy this text presents a clear and coherent account of the nature of painting

it s fitting that alice b toklas wife and literary impresario of gertrude stein should be the subject of a biography and this is a good one sensitive and lively it s clear from this portrait that through her possessive affection she not only had a dominant influence on stein s life but for good or ill on her highly idiosyncratic prose with her acid tongue shrewd judgment vitality and intense loyalty she was a fairly remarkable person in her self publishers weekly linda simon writes beautifully of alice s early years in california of her polish jewish family of her growing alienation from her surroundings and gravitation toward artists of her awareness of the isolating burden homosexuality would force on her entertaining thoroughly researched and well written with a clear gaze fixed on undistorted truth saturday review a study that shows toklas as she must have been not miss stein s obedient shadow but a multifaceted and complex creature with her own tastes and standards her story is an emotionally stirring experience washington post book world linda simon in her preface to this bison book edition calls alice b toklas a woman who through a mixture of determination and good luck invented a new narrative for her life at a time when options for women were few simon is the author of thornton wilder his world 1979 good writing 1988 and other books she is now working on a biography of william

a mural renaissance swept the united states in the 1930s propelled by the new deal federal art project and the popularity of mexican muralism perhaps nowhere more than in new york city murals became a crucial site for the development of abstract painting artists such as stuart davis arshile gorky willem de kooning and lee krasner created ambitious works for the williamsburg housing project floyd bennett field airport and the 1939 world s fair modernism for the masses examines the public murals realized and unrealized of these and other abstract painters and the aesthetic controversy political influence and ideological warfare that surrounded them jody patterson transforms standard narratives of modernism by reasserting the significance of the 1930s and explores the reasons for the omission of the mural s history from chronicles of american art beautifully illustrated with the artists murals and little known archival photographs this book recovers the radical idea that modernist art was a vital part of everyday life

male bodies unmade explores white men s disunified physicality in modern and contemporary art while attending to erotic polysemy that questions the visual ethos of occidental patriarchy art historian jongwoo jeremy kim s approach is informed by his own status as an immigrant a polyglot queen drawn to extravagant fantasies of misbehaving bodies that are in truth foreign territories colonies of misbelief in six case studies focusing on configurations of irrational anatomy and horny self extinction this book celebrates the lessons and pleasures of disrupting art history s hegemonically western narratives

recent decades have seen photography s privileged relationship to the real come under question spurred by the postmodern critique of photography in the 1980s and the rise of digital technologies soon thereafter scholars have been asking who and what built this understanding of the medium in the first place photography and doubt reflects on this interest in photography s referential power by discussing it in rigorously historical terms how was the understanding of photographic realism cultivated in the first place what do cases of staged and manipulated photography reveal about that realism s hold on audiences across the medium s history have doubts about photography s testimonial power stimulated as much knowledge as its realism edited by sabine t kriebel and andrés mario zervigón photography and doubt is the first multi authored collection specifically designed to explore these questions its 13 original essays illustrated with 73 color images explore cases when the link between the photographic image and its referent was placed under stress and when photography was as attuned to its myth making

capabilities as to its claims to authenticity photography and doubt will serve as a valuable resource for students and scholars in art history visual and media studies philosophy and the history of science and technology

jesus was not depicted on the cross until the early fifth century since then this scene has been painted or carved in sharply differing ways with the aid of over thirty full page plates the passion in art explores the historical contexts and theologies that led to such differing depictions because the first christians saw the crucifixion and resurrection of jesus as different aspects of a unified victory over sin and death scenes of the passion are juxtaposed with some of the resurrection which again are highly varied in what they do and do not show this is the first book to consider the passion as portrayed in the whole sweep of christian history each picture is considered both from the point of view of its context and its theological standpoint spanning the centuries the images reproduced and discussed include scenes from the passion of christ in the catacombs of domitilla mosaics in ravenna the rabbula crucifixion and resurrection the crucifixion plaque from metz the gero crucifix cimabue s crucifix giotto s noli me tangere piero della francesca s resurrection the isenheim altarpiece caravaggio s supper at emmaus rembrandt s christ on the cross chagall s white crucifixion contemporary paintings by stanley spencer graham sutherland nicholas mynheer and many more works of great acclaim

europa has long imagined itself as the centre of the universe although its precise geographical cultural and social terrains have always been amorphous exploring the fear and fascination associated with the continent as an allegory hamid dabashi considers europa to be a historically formed barricade against the world frantz fanon s assessment that europa is literally the creation of the third world is still true today but in more than one sense for the colonial has always been embedded in the capital and the capital within the colonial as the condition of coloniality shifts so have the dividing lines between coloniser and colonised and this shift calls for a reappraisal of our understanding of nationalism xenophobia and sectarianism as the dangerous indices of the emerging worlds as the far right populists captivate minds across europa and brexit upsets the balance of power in the european union this book from a major scholar of postcolonial thought is a timely and transformative intervention

personal glimpse of one of the most fascinating figures in contemporary world literature interviewer fernando sorrentino an argentinian writer and anthologist is endowed with literary acumen sensitivity urbanity and an encyclopedic memory of jorge luis borges work in his prologue borges jokes that sorrentino knows his work much better than i do borges wanders from nostalgic reminiscence to literary criticism and from philosophical speculation to political pronouncements his thoughts on literature alone run the gamut from the bible and homer to ernest hemingway and julio cortázar we learn that dante is the writer who has impressed borges most that borges considers federico garcía lorca to be a second rate poet and that he feels adolfo bioy casares is one of the most important authors of this century borges dwells lovingly on buenos aires too from the preface for seven afternoons the teller of tales preceded me opening tall doors which revealed unsuspected spiral staircases through the national library s pleasant maze of corridors in search of a secluded little room where we would not be interrupted by the telephone the borges who speaks to us in this book is a courteous easy going gentleman who verifies no quotations who does not look back to correct mistakes who pretends to have a poor memory he is not the terse jorge luis borges of the printed page that borges who calculates and measures each comma and each parenthesis sorrentino and translator clark m zlotchew have included an appendix on the latin american writers mentioned by borges

kitasono katue was a leading avant garde literary figure first in japan and then throughout the world from the 1920s to the 1970s in his long career kitasono was instrumental in creating japanese language work influenced by futurism dadaism and surrealism before world war ii and in contributing a japanese voice to the international avant garde movement after the war this critical biography of kitasono examines the life poetry and poetics of this controversial and flamboyant figure including his wartime support of the japanese state using kitasono as a window on japanese literature in the twentieth century john solt analyzes the relationship of japanese writers to foreign literary movements and the influence of japanese writers on world literature
