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the 2007 manifesto in favour of a littérature monde en français has generated new debates in both francophone and postcolonial studies praised by some for breaking down the hierarchical division between french and francophone literatures the manifesto has been criticized by others for recreating that division through an exoticizing vision that continues to privilege the publishing industry of the former colonial metropole does the manifesto signal the advent of a new critical paradigm destined to render obsolescent those of francophone and or postcolonial studies or is it simply a passing fad a glitzy but ephemeral publicity stunt generated and promoted by writers and

publishing executives vis a vis whom scholars and critics should maintain a skeptical distance does it offer an all embracing transnational vista leading beyond the confines of postcolonialism or reintroduce an incipient form of neocolonialism even while proclaiming the end of the centre periphery divide in addressing these questions leading scholars of french francophone and postcolonial studies from around the globe help to assess the wider question of the evolving status of french studies as a transnational field of study amid the challenges of globalization

this work offers for the first time a complete list of all books published wholly or partially in the french language before 1601 based on twelve years of investigations in libraries in france the united kingdom the united states germany the netherlands and elsewhere it provides an analytical short title catalogue of over 52 000 bibliographically distinct items with reference to surviving copies in over 1 600 libraries worldwide many of the items described are editions and even complete texts fully unknown and re-discovered by the project french vernacular books is an invaluable research tool for all students and scholars interested in the history culture and literature of france as well as historians of the early modern book world for vols iii iv please go to french books iii iv

writerly identities in beur fiction and beyond explores the beur banlieue literary and cultural field from its beginnings in the 1980s to the present it examines a set of postcolonial bildungsroman novels by azouz begag farida belghoul leïla sebbar saïd mohamed rachid djaïdani and mohamed razane in these novels the central characters are authors who struggle to find self identity and a place in the world through writing and authorship the book thus explores the different ways all these novels relate the process of becoming to the process of writing neither is straightforward as the author characters struggle to put their lives into words settle upon a genre of writing and adopt an authorial persona each chapter of writerly identities in beur fiction and beyond focuses on a given author's own relationship to writing before assessing his or her use of the author character as a proxy in so doing the study as a whole explores a set of literary questions genre textual authority reception and engages them against the backdrop of socio-cultural challenges facing contemporary french society these include debates on education cultural literacy diversity and equal opportunity and the banlieue environment finally it argues in relation to the authors and novels in question for the particular relevance of rooted and vernacular cosmopolitanism which suggests both that exploration of the world must begin at home and that stories are crucial for such explorations

gaullism 1972 is a historical analytical study of the social and political movement of gaullism examining its political philosophy and practice and its originator charles de gaulle starting with an analysis of de gaulle's philosophy and the background of the third republic the book traces the development of gaullism during the war years and the fourth republic details the founding of the fifth republic and its foreign and domestic policy and examines the problems that came to a dramatic crystallization in the riots of may 1968

this book reconsiders authorship by the descendants of north african immigrants to france by consulting how these authors novels have been discussed and promoted in the national audio visual media

professional groups and their contributions to nation building comparisons between the various political and cultural policies of the mandatory powers and the formation and practice of le savoir colonial by contemporary ethnographers officials physicians and teachers the volume will be of interest to historians of imperialism and of the twentieth century middle east

the book mainly investigates the challenges that confront france s unique dual system of higher education in facing internationalization and the recruitment of international students this book focuses on the development of the institutional strategies in two groups of higher education institutions university and grande École in responding to the opportunities and stresses of both europe s bologna process and globalization the research data presents in this book was collected from four local institutions two grandes Écoles and two universities one of each focusing on the social sciences and the other on natural sciences and technology interviews with major stakeholders in the institutions including personnel from international offices faculty researchers and international students were adopted as principal methods for data collection the thematic organization of the findings in each chapter covers views from three levels of stakeholders and interprets the results within theoretical frames such as institutional theories world system theory international academic relationship theory and branding theory readers will find this book both practical and innovative in four key ways firstly in knowledge diffusion revealing the mysterious veil of the unique french dual higher education system secondly in new knowledge production exploring a new subject of research and filling the blanks from previous studies of the two groups of institutions thirdly in presenting new interesting sights into current reforms in frances s higher education and how far principles of path dependency will ensure strong continuities with the past as against a tendency to homogenization in response to pressures from europeanization and global ranking systems finally in exploring the dimension of interculturality and the interplay between researcher s identity and research process

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
