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during his lifetime john f kennedy created a dazzling image that has been sustained since his assassination in 1963 this book examines how kennedy succeeded in using his military service in world war ii his literary efforts his sex appeal his family and other attributes and achievements to develop such a potent image it also explores the roles played by joseph and jackie kennedy in bolstering his appeal probably no other figure in history has created such a positive impression on people throughout the world today than kennedy this book seeks to explain how this happened and to consider the extent to which the image conformed to the reality of the man

the young president who brought vigor and glamour to the white house while he confronted cold war crises abroad and calls for social change at home john fitzgerald kennedy was a new kind of president he redefined how americans came to see the nation s chief executive he was forty three when he was inaugurated in 1961 the youngest man ever elected to the office and he personified what he called the new frontier as the united states entered the 1960s but as alan brinkley shows in this incisive and lively assessment the reality of kennedy s achievements was much more complex than the legend his brief presidency encountered significant failures among them the bay of pigs fiasco which cast its shadow on nearly every national

security decision that followed but kennedy also had successes among them the cuban missile crisis and his belated but powerful stand against segregation kennedy seemed to live on a knife s edge moving from one crisis to another cuba laos berlin vietnam mississippi georgia and alabama his controversial public life mirrored his hidden private life he took risks that would seem reckless and even foolhardy when they emerged from secrecy years later kennedy s life and his violent and sudden death reshaped our view of the presidency brinkley gives us a full picture of the man his times and his enduring legacy

john robert and ted kennedy s individual stories can be seen as essentially one each successive brother striving to fulfill the interrupted promise of the brother before the closing of ted kennedy s chapter in america s political and cultural life means that for the first time perhaps the real measure of the kennedy legacy can finally be taken this is a story of a brotherhood in three acts act i is john f kennedy s presidency as seen from ted s front row seat act ii is robert kennedy s five brief years as the family standard bearer including his tenure in the senate with his brother ted and the memorable 82 day presidential campaign that redefined the kennedy legacy act iii is ted s 40 plus years in the senate as keeper of the flame how did the brothers pass the torch to each other what have the three brothers left us collectively and who carries the torch forward now the kennedy legacy compellingly answers these questions and much more

In a mere one thousand days Jacqueline Bouvier Kennedy created an entrancing public persona that has remained intact for more than a half century. Even now, long after her death in 1994, she remains a figure of enduring and endearing interest. Yet while innumerable books have focused on the legends and gossip surrounding this charismatic figure, Barbara Perry's is the first to focus largely on Kennedy's White House years, portraying a first lady far more complex and enigmatic than previously perceived. Noting how Jackie's celebrity and devotion to privacy have for years precluded a more serious treatment, Perry's engaging and well-crafted story illuminates Kennedy's immeasurable impact on the institution of the first lady. Perry vividly illustrates the complexities of Jacqueline Bouvier's marriage to John F. Kennedy and shows how she transformed herself from a reluctant political wife to an effective, confident presidential partner. Perry is especially illuminating in tracing the first lady's mastery of political symbolism and imagery along with her use of television and state entertainment to disseminate her work to a global audience by offering the White House as a stage for the arts. She had a profound impact on the nation's psyche and cultural life. Meanwhile, her fashionable clothes and glamorous hairdos stood in stark contrast to the dowdiness of her predecessors and the drab appearances of communist leaders' spouses. Never before or since have a first lady and her husband sparkled with so much hope and vigor on the stage of American public life. Perry's deft narrative captures all of that and more, even as it also insightfully depicts Jackie's struggles to preserve her own identity amid the pressures of an institution she changed forever. Grounded on the author's painstaking research into previously overlooked or unavailable archives at the Kennedy Library and elsewhere, as well as interviews with Jacqueline Kennedy's close associates, Perry's work expands and enriches our understanding of a remarkable American woman.

From very early on in his career, John F. Kennedy's allure was more akin to a movie star than a presidential candidate. Why were Americans so attracted to Kennedy in the late 1950s and early 1960s? His glamorous image, good looks, cool style, tough-minded rhetoric, and sex appeal, as Steve Watts argues, JFK was tailor-made for the cultural atmosphere of his time. He benefited from a crisis of manhood that had welled up in postwar America when men had become ensnared by bureaucracy, softened by suburban comfort, and emasculated by a generation of newly aggressive women. Kennedy appeared to revive the modern American man as youthful and vigorous, masculine and athletic, and a sexual conquistador. His cultural crusade involved other prominent figures, including Frank Sinatra, Norman Mailer, Ian Fleming, Hugh Hefner, Ben Bradlee, Kirk Douglas, and Tony Curtis, who collectively symbolized masculine regeneration. JFK and the masculine mystique is not just another standard biography of the youthful president; by examining

kennedy in the context of certain books movies social critiques music and cultural discussions that framed his ascendancy watts shows us the excitement and sense of possibility the optimism and aspirations that accompanied the dawn of a new age in america

to truly understand the dynamics and magic of the kennedy family one must understand their passion for sailing and the sea many families sail together but the kennedys relationship with victura the 25 foot sloop purchased in 1932 stands apart throughout their brief lives joe jr jack and bobby spent many hours racing victura lack of effort in a race by one of his sons could infuriate joseph p kennedy and joe jr and jack ranked among the best collegiate sailors in new england likewise eunice emerged as a gifted sailor and fierce competitor the equal of any of her brothers the kennedys believed that jack s experience sailing victura helped him survive the sinking of his pt boat during world war ii in the 1950s glossy life magazine photos of jack and jackie on victura s bow helped define the winning kennedy brand jack doodled sketches of victura during oval office meetings and it s probable that his love of seafaring played a role in his 1961 decision to put a man on the moon an enterprise he referred to as spacefaring ted loved victura as much as any of his siblings did and with his own children and the children of his lost brothers as crew he sailed into his old age past the shoals of an ebbing career and into his eventual role as the lion of the senate in victura james w graham charts the progress of america s signature twentieth century family dynasty in a narrative both stunningly original and deeply gripping this true tale of one small sailboat is an invaluable contribution to our understanding of the great story of the kennedys
